A registration form must be completed for all children. This includes contact information and medical information. Consent forms are also included in the registration pack. Once your registration form received, we will do our best to accommodate your needs.

You will receive an invoice at the beginning of each month **in advance** payable by the end of that month.

Late fee payments & will have a £15.00 late payment charge.
