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General Information / Entering Information

- Entries will open at 12 pm MST on Monday, August 11, 2025.
- Entries will close at 6 pm sharp MST on Friday, September 5, 2025.
- The requirement to qualify for riding at the Canadian National Finals is six (6) sanctioned shows attended in the 2025 season.
- Nationals Declaration Form **MUST BE FILLED OUT to ride National Finals (one per rider)**.
- Entries are entered through www.penning.ca
- Any changes to team entries, stalling, or camping must be received through email at ctcpaoffice@gmail.com. Changes received through text message, Facebook, or any other social media platform will not be answered or administrated.
- Incorrect entries / changes will cost \$30.00 per team to fix from the opening entry date, until August 22, 2025. The rider making the change will be charged the fee.
- Incorrect entries / changes after August 22, 2025, up to September 5, 2025, will cost \$60.00 each. The rider making the change will be charged for this fee.
- Once a class has started, no changes will be allowed unless there is a medical emergency. All replacements for medical emergencies must be approved in advance by the Show Management.
- Entrants will be sent individual invoices in advance for their entry fees/extras via email. When you enter online, please ensure you submit your contact information under entries/submit rider contact info so invoicing can be sent.
- Notify the CTCPA Office with any address changes to ensure correct delivery.

Payment Information

- **Payments must be received by Wednesday, September 17, 2025.** All payments received after this date will be charged a \$100.00 late fee. If entry fees have not been received by September 24, 2025, the teams will be canceled immediately.
- A \$50.00 Administration Fee will be charged for all returned cheques. If we receive an NSF Cheque, you will be required to submit a certified cheque within 72 hours, or your teams will be canceled and no reimbursements will be given to the other teammates.
- A credit card fee of 3% will be charged for transactions. Please note this change is for payment by credit card only.
- Order of Go Copies \$3.00, available at the show office.
- As teams are entered, they can be viewed online through www.penning.ca.
- Final "Order of Go's" will be posted on the Website after all payments have been received. You can visit www.canadianpenning.com to view the Spare Rider List to look for teammates or put your name on the list.

- All payout cheques can be picked up Monday at the completion of the show, cheques not picked up in person will be mailed out after the show.

Show Rules

- All CTCPA Rules apply to this show as found on the website [Rules/Bylaws](#)
- Abuse of any staff member, volunteer, judges or board members will not be tolerated. Incidents of abuse will result in a warning and/or an immediate disqualification from the event and forfeiture of all monies paid.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct by a team and/or rider may result in disqualification. Unsportsmanlike conduct is defined as abuse of one's horse or cattle, excessive use of foul language, intoxication in the arena or on the grounds or any other conduct felt to be detrimental to the sport of team penning. Abuse of one's horse may include but is not limited to excessive jerking, spurring, whipping, slapping or kicking or riding a horse that is visibly lame, sick or emaciated.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct may also be levied against a rider showing disrespect, physical, verbal, or written abuse to a Judge, Line Official or Show Management. Any rider who shows disrespect to those parties will be given an unsportsmanlike conduct penalty and will be disqualified for that day of competition and all entry fees for the day will be forfeited.
- This rule is to be enforced by the presiding Judge and/or Show Management. CTCPA reserves the right to suspend any rider from competing in the balance of the show and further, will review the offense to determine if further suspension is required.
- All riders must display their CTCPA saddle rating tags. Tags must be visible on saddles during all runs. Only one tag may be on the saddle. Replacements for lost, misplaced or forgotten rider tags can be purchased from the show office at a cost of \$5.00 each.
- The Calgary Stampede prohibits outside liquor from being brought into the Nutrien Western Event Centre.
- No motorized vehicles are allowed in the barns. No dogs are allowed in the Arena Building.

The CTCPA National Finals Committee reserves the right to amend/change any rule or regulation to the program at any time including but not limited to, number of teams allowed in a class, % back, distribution of payouts.

Show Event Details

Welcome all Penners! It's time to enter our 28th Annual National Finals Show!

- ☐ The show will run from October 9th to 13th, 2025, inclusive.
- ☐ Start time each day will be 8:00 am.
- ☐ The Third Annual CTCPA Hall of Fame Induction will occur Saturday, October 11th, 2025. Location TBD and will be announced via social media and email.
- ☐ Access & egress to the facility will be through the Nat Christie Gate. Map for entrance will be attached to the back of this package.
- ☐ The show office will open from noon (12 pm) to six pm (6 pm) on Wednesday October 8th, 2025, and be open at seven (7 am) to two (2 pm) each day of the show.

Stalling

Note: The Pavilion stalls have already been spoken for CTCPA was offered a sponsorship for this area.

- ☐ Stalls will be available at \$200.00 each, in a first come, first serve nature, booked through penning.ca. Stalls will be booked by the time stamp given when placed online. No exceptions.
- ☐ Every effort is made to place horses as requested according to the date and time entered online. Unfortunately, the CTCPA is not always able to accommodate every request.
- ☐ Booking Stalls – If you want to be beside another competitor, please designate one person to enter all stalls for the group so that there is only 1 date and time entered. Please comment in penning.ca how many stalls you need.
- ☐ Tack Stalls are available for \$200.00 each.
- ☐ Stalls will have shavings which can be distributed to horse stalls from the aisle.
- ☐ Extra shavings are provided, please be reasonable, do not abuse this privilege.
- ☐ Respect your fellow competitors, keep stalls cleaned and aisles tidy.
- ☐ If you plan to stay over on the Monday night and need a stall, YOU MUST indicate numbers needed. If you do not indicate you need a Monday stall and end up staying a \$30.00 charge per stall will be applied to your account. If you did not indicate you need a stall, the Calgary Stampede will charge \$60.00 per stall, which will be applied to your account.
- ☐ All Monday stayovers will be in Barn H. If you are in the Main Barn and want to stay over Monday night, you must move your horse to Barn H by 10am MDT on Monday or request Barn H when you enter online so you won't have to move.
- ☐ The CTCPA has stall access only until Tuesday at 10am MDT at which time the next booked event starts to move in. You are required to move at or before this time, with no exceptions.

PLEASE NOTE: If you cancel one or more of your booked stalls or trailer parking after September 24, 2025, you will **NOT** be reimbursed. You can sell to another participant without the involvement of the CTCPA Office.

Camping

Note: Preference will be given to Sponsors over \$1000.00 for Infield camping spots.

- ☐ Camping parking is available for \$200.00. A camping pass includes one parking pass for unlimited in and out privileges to the Stampede Grounds.
- ☐ Parking is permitted after noon (12 pm) on Wednesday, October 8th, 2025. No camping is allowed prior to noon. No exceptions.
- ☐ Camping spots include power.
- ☐ Camping will also be available to the first 30 campers that wish to use generators in the infield, the cost will be \$150.00. Please note: Generator camping will be on the far south side in the infield.
- ☐ Camping will be assigned to each rider based on the date and time entered in www.penning.ca and will be posted prior to the show. You can book ONLY 5 camping spots per rider.
- ☐ If you are wanting to camp beside each other you MUST all show up at the same time or you will not be beside each other.
- ☐ Campers/Trailers/Living Quarters must be removed from the designated CTCPA parking area, at the Stampede Grounds by 08:30 am MDT, Tuesday, October 14th. No Exceptions!

Parking

- ☐ All parking is done through the Parkplus system through the City of Calgary.
- ☐ A one-time entry will be granted for loading and unloading.

Ride With The Pro's Raffle

- ☐ There are a total of ten (10) Runs in the Ride with the Pro's. Riders rated 1, 2, or 3 may purchase tickets to ride in the Ride With The Pro's class.
- ☐ Tickets are \$30.00 dollars each, or three (3) tickets for \$65.00. They may be purchased with entry submission on penning.ca, and additional purchases may be made at the show office.
- ☐ Each team will consist of 2 Pro rated riders (5 and above) and one lucky penner (rated 1, 2 or 3) that has been drawn from tickets purchased.
- ☐ Each team will be drawn during the All Pro All Draw Class Sunday Night, October 12th, 2025, and will consist of two 5, 6, 7, or 8 rated riders plus one lucky penner rider rated 1, 2 or 3 will be drawn from tickets sold for this event.
- ☐ There is no limit to the number of tickets a Penner may purchase, however, once a name is drawn to fill the Ride With The Pro's position, it may not be drawn again.
- ☐ Entrants must compete minimum of 3 times in either the Open Handicap, #10, #7 or #5 classes at the 2025 National Finals to be eligible to purchase tickets.
- ☐ All proceeds from tickets purchased will be in payouts to first place team only.

Calcutta Monday

The CTCPA is excited to offer an exciting Calcutta for the Ride With The Pro's class! This Calcutta will run immediately before the beginning of the finals Monday Afternoon!

- ☐ Pre-Register prior to the Calcutta event.
- ☐ Calcutta bidders are required to pay at the show or as soon as practicable.
- ☐ The Calcutta is an exciting in person, live auction event where people or groups are able to bid on the ride with the Pro's teams.
- ☐ 50% of the collected Calcutta will be awarded to the buyers of the winning team.
- ☐ 30% of the collected Calcutta will be awarded to the buyers of the second place team.
- ☐ 20% of the funds collected go towards the show producer and administration of the class.

Class Details

Teams in all classes, aside from the Junior Youth, are pen to advance.

Open Handicap

- ☐ Open Handicap is \$185 per rider.
- ☐ Open Handicap class riders may enter a maximum of five (5) times and there is a 0.50 second Handicap. If time warrants, an additional 6th team will be allowed in certain classes on the discretion of the board.
- ☐ After the first go, the top teams will return for the $\frac{1}{3}$ back. (If there are fewer than 100 teams, in the class the 2nd go will be a $\frac{1}{2}$ back)
- ☐ The top 20 teams after the 2nd go will advance to the semi-finals.
- ☐ The top 10 teams will advance to the finals.
- ☐ Teams will carry their accumulated times throughout the competition.

10 Class, 7 Class, 5 Class

- ☐ The 10 Class, 7 Class, and 5 Class is \$150.00 each per rider.
- ☐ You may enter each class up to five (5) times, in each of the # 10, #7 and # 5 classes. If time warrants, an additional 6th team will be allowed in certain classes on the discretion of the board.
- ☐ After the first go, the top teams will return for the $\frac{1}{3}$ back. (If there are fewer than 100 teams in the class the 2nd go will be a $\frac{1}{2}$ back)
- ☐ The top 20 teams after the 2nd go will advance to the semi-finals.
- ☐ The top 10 teams will advance to the finals.
- ☐ Teams will carry their accumulated times throughout the competition.

Open Shootout

- ☐ The Open Shootout is \$500 per rider.
- ☐ The Open Shootout will take a maximum of 60 entries. Each rider may enter five (5)

times with a minimum one rider change each time. Shootout will be aggregate time until the top 10 teams. Finals Top Ten will be clean slate, and teams select their cow number, and it will also be your order of go. Teams will be drawn at the Hall of Fame Banquet.

- ☐ If there is less than twenty-five (25) entries by entry deadline, the class will be cancelled.
- ☐ Entrants must compete a minimum of 3 times in either the Open Handicap, #10, #7 or #5 classes at the 2025 National Finals in order to be eligible to enter the Open Shootout Class, Ride with the Pros and All Pro All Draw Class.

Eight (8) Shootout

- ☐ The 8 Shootout is \$330.00 per rider.
- ☐ The 8 Shootout will take a maximum of 100 entries. Each rider may enter only twice (2 times). Shootout will be aggregate time until the top 10 teams. Finals Top Ten will be clean slate, and teams select their cow number, and it will also be your order of go.
- ☐ Entrants must compete a minimum of 3 times in either the Open Handicap, #10, #7 or #5 classes at the 2025 National Finals in order to be eligible to enter the 8 Shootout Class, Ride with the Pros and All Pro All Draw Class.
- ☐ Only the top 10 teams will receive payouts.

Century 150 Class

- ☐ The Century 150 Class is \$70.00 per rider.
- ☐ This class is for four riders that are 50 or older with one go and the top 10 moving to the Finals.
- ☐ Each individual rider must be at least 50 years old as of October 1, 2025
- ☐ Riders may enter two (2) times.
- ☐ Total class will be capped at 50 teams.
- ☐ Teams will be drawn prior to the class and drawn as evenly as possible.
- ☐ Entrants must compete a minimum of 3 times in either the Open Handicap, #10, #7 or #5 classes at the 2025 National Finals in order to be eligible to enter this class.
- ☐ Teams will carry their accumulated times throughout the competition.

All Pro Class

- ☐ The All Pro class is \$300.00 for three draw entries.
- ☐ This class is restricted to 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 rated riders only.
- ☐ First go, half back and top ten advancing to the finals Monday October 13th, 2025.
- ☐ If you are a 4, 5, 6, 7, or 8 entering the Open Shoot, out it is mandatory, you will be entered in the All Pro All Draw Class

- ☐ Entrants must compete a minimum of 3 times in either the Open Handicap, #10 or #7 classes at the 2025 National Finals in order to be eligible to enter this class.
- ☐ This class has unlimited entries.
- ☐ Teams will carry their accumulated times throughout the competition.

Ride with the Pros

- ☐ The Ride with the Pro's class is detailed above with tickets being sold to 1, 2, and 3 rated riders.
- ☐ This class is not handicapped, and teams will be drawn as an even draw.
- ☐ This class has 100% payback from the tickets sold for the event.
 - o 50% to novice and 25% to each pro.

Jr. Youth Class

- ☐ Jr. Youth entries are \$40.00 dollars each.
- ☐ Jr. Youth riders may enter up to two (2) times. All teams will be drawn.
- ☐ Each individual rider must be 12 years of age or under as of January 1st, 2025.
- ☐ Please provide in the comment with youth entry the name of the designated adult rider. If no adult rider is provided, we will match up with adult riders entered in the class. Every effort is made to match youth rider up with their adult rider for at least 1 run.
- ☐ Teams will have 2 full goes. The top 5 teams will advance to the Finals on Monday (depending on number of teams entered).
- ☐ Cash payouts will be awarded to the top 5 teams in the Finals (depending on number of teams entered).

Sr. Youth

- ☐ The Sr. Youth is \$60.00 per rider.
- ☐ Sr. Youth riders may enter up to two (2) times. All teams will be drawn.
- ☐ Each individual rider must be 13-16 years of age as of January 1st, 2025.
- ☐ After the first go, there will be a half back returning for the second go. You must pen cows to advance. The top 5 teams will advance to the Finals on Monday (depending on number of teams entered/qualified).
- ☐ Cash payouts will be awarded to the top 5 teams in the Finals (depending on number of teams entered/qualified).
- ☐ Teams will carry their accumulated times throughout the competition.
