Entry Fee: \$ 400.00

Ages 16 – 26 years old.

BEFORE THE EVENT:

- Fill out the Entry Form,
- Send a clear head and shoulders photo of yourself,
- Deposit \$400 into the Pageant of New Zealand's bank account,
- If you have a sponsor, you will need to fill in the Sponsorship Detail Form and send to us,
- Your sponsor must send us a business card to be placed in the program.
- Create yourself a Public Facebook Profile page called *YOUR NAME* – Face of Beauty Contestant 2019. You will use this page throughout your pageant journey.
- Commit to a one-day training session before the final event.
- Create a 60 sec video of yourself and send this to me. Introduce yourself, tell us where you are from, what your hobbies and interests are and why you are taking part in this pageant.

The Event:

The categories that will be judged are:

INTERVIEW – NATIONAL COSTUME – TALENT – SWIMWEAR - EVENING GOWN.

Interview:- wear blue jeans and a white shirt and dress it up with accessories.

National Costume:- How does the rest of the world see NZ? If you were not born in NZ, you are welcome to represent your birth country in this pageant. (Note: that should you win, you will need to represent NZ on the International Stage).

Talent:- a 2 minute segment and it can be dance, singing, poetry or mime – you are in charge of your own music and props – please try to get music to me prior to the event.

Swimwear:- can either be a bikini or a one piece – you may bring along a sarong if you wish.

Evening Gown:- a long gown to the floor and a colour and style that suits you.

What happens on the day?

You arrive at the venue at 9am, dressed in comfy gear. You will spend the whole day there until the show is finished. During the day, you will be interviewed by the judges, practice the opening number (dance), the walks and the talks, as well as be judged in your swimwear, talent and National Costume. There will be makeup artists and hairdressers there on the night. No one is allowed back stage to assist you in getting ready. THIS WILL BE RESTRICTED. Lunch and dinner will be provided. (Please let me know if you are vegetarian or have any food allergies). Bring all your gear, deodorant, jewelry, toothbrush, toothpaste, towel (if you want a shower), shoes, make-up you prefer.

What is in it for the Sponsor?

Your sponsor will receive advertising in the program and a mention on the evening. You will need to thank them on your Public Facebook Profile page, as well as a link will be put up on the Pageants of New Zealand website to either their website or Facebook page. Sponsors can also claim on their tax as a sponsorship and a tax receipt can be issued, if requested. Well worth \$400.00 for the advertising.

Sell your tickets:

Tickets are \$50 each and this includes finger snacks and tea at interval. There will be a cash bar available. You will be required to sell 6 tickets to your family and friends who want to come along and support you. Please let me know if you require more. Also, please let us know the week before if you haven't sold all 6 so that we can re-allocate them or sell them to the public.

What does your \$400 entry fee cover?

You receive entry into the competition, which includes lunch and dinner. Photos from the day, hair and makeup done for you, and the opportunity to represent New Zealand at the Face of Beauty International Final event in 2019.

What does the winner need to commit to?

As winner of this event, you will only be travelling to the Face of Beauty International Final in 2019. (Destination to be confirmed).

The Pageants of New Zealand will cover your entry fee and flights to the destination country. During your year of reign, prior to travelling to the final, you will need to commit to organizing two fundraisers. Money raised from these two events will go towards your trip to the final. All the money raised will need to be paid to the Pageants of New Zealand to go towards your trip. The first \$500 will be towards travelling expenses and the balance is for you to use, as you see fit. This money can be used for your own personal spending, bringing along a chaperone (if wanted), or an extended stay in the host country.

You will also be expected to attend the other events organized by the Pageants of New Zealand, and to assist at these events. Where possible, if you could attend other pageants organized in New Zealand as

a representative of the Pageants of New Zealand and the current Miss Face of Beauty NZ 2019. We will inform you of these events and dates as they become available.

Rules:

1. I am born female.
2. I shall not bring the competition into disrepute through my background or myself/family's unsportsmanlike behavior as this could lead to my disqualification.
3. No refund will be given once entered.
4. I have never been married, pregnant, nor had a child.
5. Contestants must never have posed for pornography film, photo, or movie.
6. Winner is the representative of New Zealand and should that competition be delayed or cancelled, then the Pageants of New Zealand have the right to send the winner to another international competition of their choice.
7. The decision of the Judges is final, and no written correspondence will be entered.
8. Each contestant will compete in Daywear, Swimwear, Talent, National Costume and Evening Gown.
9. The contestant must be of moral and good standard.
10. Contestant must have a NZ passport.
11. Pageants of New Zealand cannot take responsibility should any pageant we send our contestants to be cancelled in that year.
12. Contestant and Pageants of New Zealand must sign the agreement to complete the winner's eligibility.
13. Contestant must never contact the pageant to which she is going and must at all times, communicate with any queries to the Pageants of New Zealand.
14. Failure to comply with any of the above, could result in disqualification and if this is so then the sash and crown is returned to Pageants of New Zealand.
15. Should you be placed in the top three written permission must be obtained from the Pageants of New Zealand to enter another pageant in the same year or before the reign is complete.
