A Note From Our Kitchen

TRADITIONAL RECIPES • SCRATCH BAKING • A VERY SMALL KITCHEN

At the Heritage Tea Room, we celebrate traditional recipes, heritage cooking methods and food made from scratch.

That means our little kitchen is a busy working and baking kitchen where many common allergens and ingredients are used every day, including:

Tree Nuts • Gluten & Wheat • Dairy • Eggs • Fish & Seafood • Pork

Some ingredients may also appear where you might not expect them. For example, our traditional 400-year-old hot water crust is made with lard, and nuts may be used in baking, garnishes, sauces and other preparations.

PLEASE TELL US BEFORE YOU ORDER

If you have a food allergy, intolerance, dietary restriction or ingredient you must avoid, please tell your server before ordering — even if you have included it with your reservation.

We want the opportunity to understand your needs, check ingredients and take the appropriate precautions before preparing your food.

OUR MENU DESCRIPTIONS ARE NOT COMPLETE INGREDIENT LISTS

Our menus are written to describe our dishes—not to identify every ingredient, garnish, sauce or component used in their preparation.

Please never assume that an ingredient is absent simply because it is not listed on the menu.

A NOTE ABOUT CROSS-CONTACT

Because we prepare and bake everything in a small shared kitchen, common allergens are present and shared preparation and cooking areas are used.

While we take reasonable precautions when an allergy is brought to our attention, we cannot guarantee that any dish is completely allergen-free or free from cross-contact.

Please inform us of any allergies or dietary restrictions before ordering. Some requests may not be safely accommodated due to our shared kitchen environment.

Guests with severe or life-threatening allergies should speak with a server or manager before ordering.
