HIGH POINT

Youth Highpoint - Qualifying classes - All youth classes (MUST REGISTER)

Non Pro High Point - Qualifying classes - All non pro classes (MUST REGISTER)

Overall Halter High Point - The highest scoring halter horse of the show. This is taken from any breed halter class where both Judge# 1 International and #2 Australian have judged together. Derivative horses will have their total score divided by 5 to get an average score which will be added as a sixth score to align with the Purebred scoring system. In the event of a tie the Halter judge #1 international score will determine the winner. Multiple Class scores are not combined

A 10-point descending scale will be used for qualifying classes - 10 points for Diamond Champion, 9 points for Ruby Champion, 8 points for Emerald Champion. In classes with fewer than 10 entries the winner shall receive the point value equal to the number of horses in the class. (example 5 in class Diamond = 5 points, Ruby = 4 points, Emerald = 3 points.) Points for high point classes will be awarded as follows: High Point Award - 15 points, Runner up High Point - 12 points.

When there is a tie the rules are as follows: High Point award will be given to the competitor who has won the most championships; if the tie remains the Ruby championships will be counted, in the event that a tie still occurs the winner will be deemed by the competitor who has won the most first place awards where there is more than 5 competitors.
