Child Protection Sunday this Sunday affords an opportunity for the Diocese to complement the National Catholic Response with factual information on how we as faith communities actively participate in the safeguarding of children and vulnerable adults. As part of National Child Protection Week, the Diocese has developed interactive electronic noticeboards (called 'padlets') that will allow any interested parishioner to watch brief audio-visual presentations, review documents, look at images and get online advice from key agencies such as Family and Community Services and NAPCAN. You can access the padlet *Child Protection Week 2018 - Play Your Part* at https://padlet.com/ZimmermanServices/CPW_2018_Resources_for_Parishes_In_2017, at the launch of **Lina's Project**, Bishop Bill made a public commitment to an annual Day of Remembrance for those who have suffered abuse by members of the Church. The annual Day of Remembrance for survivors is on 16 September 2018. Bishop Bill will preside at 9.30am Mass in the Cathedral, and the liturgy that day will specifically remember and include survivors and their families.

Sacramental Program The preparation for the reception of the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Confirmation and First Holy Communion will be beginning a little sooner this year. Year 2 students at St Mary's have received applications and information to take home regarding the program.
