Boolaroo—Warners Bay and Booragul Parishes At the time of publication, there are no weekend masses in the parishes of Boolaroo/Warners Bay and Booragul.

Status of Weekend Masses at time of printing. As many would know, Government regulations have allowed Churches to have 50 people present for religious services up until the 1st July. So due to the number of people who normally attend our Masses on a weekend, we are still not able to "open up" for this weekend's (27th & 28th June) masses. Bishop Bill Wright has continued the dispensation from the obligation to attend weekend Mass to all parishioners.

Status of Weekend Masses from 1st July. Government authorities have indicated that from the 1st July religious services may accommodate 100+ people at their services BUT the 4 square metre rule will apply still. This then means that we can accommodate only the number of people based on the square metre size of our Churches divided by 4. It doesn't quite work out like that, given the actual pews and seats present in the Churches and how they are arranged.

Under the proposed conditions from the 1st July (that is for us, from the weekend of the 4/5 July), we will 'give it a go' at opening for 60 people present for the 5:30pm Saturday night mass and approximately 110 people present for the Sunday morning and the Sunday evening Masses at Warners Bay. As is understood at this time, everyone who would be present would be required to sign in, note their phone number, have their name(s) ticked off, use sanitiser and be directed to allocated seating.

NOW HERE'S THE PROBLEM!!! People will have to pre register by email or phone from Tuesday (from 9:00am) before the weekend of the 4/5 July and no later than the Thursday NOON and subsequently the same process will apply

for **each** weekend after that!! REGISTRATION DETAILS AND A FORM TO REGISTER ARE ON THE WEBSITE UNDER "BULLETINS"

Quite probably, it might be a bit of a raffle but as we go on Fr Brian will try to ensure that everyone gets a chance. Under these arrangements we couldn't accommodate people who simply "turn up".

Return of Weekday Masses. We have been able to trial a weekday Mass schedule. The first weeks have gone fairly well and there has been some learning about the process! Obviously, a number of conditions apply in reference to Social Distancing, sanitising, taking of names and phone numbers etc. The timetable is:

9:00am at St Michael's Booragul. Tuesday

Wednesday 9:00am at Our Lady Help of Christians Boolaroo.

Thursdav 9:30am at St Mary's Warners Bay.

Those who attend weekday Masses, who are registered volunteers, can assist, in the fulfilling of the conditions, by being monitors.

It is very important to note that all parishioners who are at risk, the elderly, those with compromised health and those who are sick, feeling unwell etc. are encouraged seriously to consider refraining from attending Mass at this time.
