## There are no Weekday Masses or Liturgies due the Covid 19 crisis.

**Bishop Wright's letter regarding the Covid-19 virus crisis.** A copy of Bishop William Wrights Pastoral Letter confronting the Covid Virus is available on the parish Website under "Bulletins". Please see the following:

We have received advice from Bishop William Wright, Bishop of Maitland-Newcastle, regarding the impacts of the Covid-19 Virus crisis. In short, effective immediately, "the public celebration of Mass is suspended. The suspension applies to both Sunday Mass and weekday Mass.....All members of the faithful, other than priests, are dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. Members of the faithful should observe the holiness of Sunday by observing one of the options listed in the Appendix." (From the Bishop's Letter). The length of the suspension is indefinite. The parish Churches at Boolaroo and Warners Bay will be open for private visits between the hours of 9:30am and 1:00pm, Monday through to Friday inclusively and on Sunday from 10:30am to 5:00pm. The Church at Booragul will be open on Tuesdays from 9:30am – 12:30pm. We will see how those time parameters go.

As well, the Holy Week Liturgies and the Easter ceremonies have been cancelled. We will upload the complete bulletin (readings and notices) to our website by Thursday morning of each week. This is a peculiar time in which we are living and from my point of view, not celebrating Eucharist with the parish is a bitter pill to swallow.

**PS** Financially too, this time is going to be a difficult time for many, our parish is not an exception to that circumstance.
