

Updates



- New MI nonprofit organization created in November 2024; 501c3 application pending at the federal level.
- Board of Directors was approved in October 2024:
 - DI, NEMCOG, NEMCSA, and Pulse of the WE Upjohn Institute in Kalamazoo are founding members and each have seats and alternates on the board
 - Officers: Gloria Brooks, President/Treasurer; Maria Ortiz Borden, Secretary
 - Members: Lisa Bolen, NEMCSA; Melissa Chambers, NEMCOG
 - Alternates: Frances Ommani, NEMCSA; Doug Baum, NEMCOG; Kathy Szenda Wilson, Pulse

Updates



- Launched a fundraising plan to build the Child Care Back Office
 - Meeting with community and private foundations across the state of Michigan – positive feedback about the concept and funding potential
 - Submitted 2 funding requests and received \$25,000 in January 2025
 - MI-LEAP has new grant opportunity for childcare initiatives lead by EDOs in collaboration with the MEDC; requests pending as of 3/11/25 for funding starting 4/1/25

Next Steps



- Recruited locally and nationally for a CEO
 - Offer pending to experienced childcare business owner with expertise in back-office services administration

- Identify childcare business owners to participate in MSO pilot projects
 - Test back-office services
 - No cost to childcare businesses to participate

MANAGED SERVICE ORGANIZATION (MSO) DEFINED

- Independent entity that provides outsource, administrative services, e.g. finance, accounting, information technology, human resources, etc.
- Originally started in the Health Care sector as a solution to increase access to low cost health care in underserved areas.
- Has expanded to other industries based upon success.

WHAT SERVICES WILL BE AVAILABLE?

Enrollment Management

Enrollment/onboarding, waitlist creation, optimal child enrollment maintenance, and enrollment outreach.

Tax Preparation

Quarterly estimated tax payments, annual tax returns, and tax strategy.

Core Accounting & Financial Dashboards

Bookkeeping, accounting support, financial dashboards and reporting, and per child-care costs.

Crisis Management

Policies and procedures development and support, incident support, and crisis communication support.

License Management

Management and support of existing childcare licenses, inspection support, and new center license support.

Business Software Management

Optimal usage and configure of business management software including master contracts and discounted pricing.

Grant Writing Workshop Results:

10- individuals

10- businesses

50- non-profits representatives from 27 different non-profit organizations

43- Government representatives from 22 separate entities (Schools, Public Safety, and other Government Agencies)

Total of 114 participants in seven workshops

Grants applied for to date:

30 grants submitted totaling \$7,538,497.

Grants awarded to date:

22 grant awards totaling \$2,280,997.

Range of funded grant projects

- \$500 Cleanup equipment from Great Lakes Great Responsibility
- \$250,000 PKL Cares Food Pantry from Consmers Energy Foundation
- \$750,000 for Trailhead Market Place from Labor and Economic Opportunity
