WHY TAWAS BAY?

Proposed cruise ship docking area (future)



In 2010, Develop Iosco developed a study to evaluate the ability for the East Tawas Dock/State Harbor to support the mooring of Great Lakes cruise ships. The harbor provides for an excellent sheltered location for ships to harbor. Depths in the harbor range from approximately 20-25 feet at the entrance and 10-12 feet adjacent to the main pier and marina area.

Tendering The 2010 study expands to detail the modifications needed to support future cruise ship docking. At this time, cruise ships have the ability to tender passengers to shore at the Michigan DNR main dock as indicated in the image above. If Tawas Bay becomes a cruise destination, modifications will be prioritized to allow cruise ships to dock at the proposed area on the US Army Corp section, with permits easily obtained by either agency.

Walkability

Once on shore, patrons have access to the quaint walkable streets of downtown East Tawas, where there are dozens of shops, boutiques, bars, and restaurants. The public beach is also just steps away for easy relaxation and natural beauty. Our excursions to the East Tawas area including the natural wonders of the Huron National Forest will also be available for patrons to access straight from the dock.
