☐ Spotlight: Writing a Strong Letter of Intent (LOI)

Some funders, like the A.A. Van Elslander Foundation, require a Letter of Intent (LOI) before inviting a full proposal. Think of the LOI as your first impression—it should clearly show why your project fits their mission.

Tips for a successful LOI:

- Be concise: Usually 1–2 pages is enough.
- Align with funder priorities: Mention how your project supports their focus areas (e.g., children, health, human services).
- Highlight impact: Share who will benefit and what outcomes you expect.
- Show capacity: Briefly note your track record or partnerships that ensure success.

A strong LOI increases your chances of being invited to submit a full application.
