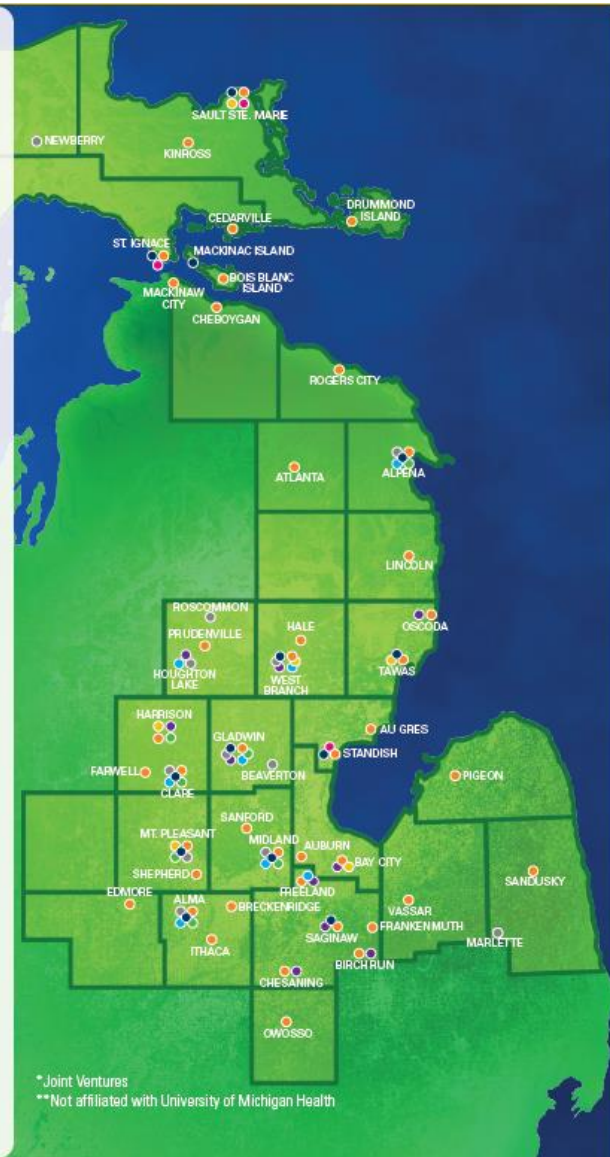

MyMichigan Medical Center Alma

This 107-bed teaching hospital provides Level III trauma care, 24/7 emergency care, as well as a full range of specialty services including heart and vascular care, cancer care, orthopedics, surgical services, maternity, mental health, and more.



MyMichigan Medical Center Gladwin

Located in Gladwin, this 25-bed critical access hospital features 24/7 emergency care and access to a full continuum of health care services.



MyMichigan Medical Center Mt. Pleasant

This 128,000-square-foot outpatient facility features a 24/7 Emergency Department, an outpatient surgery center, laboratory and imaging services, short stay beds, and more.



MyMichigan Medical Center Tawas*

This 47-bed acute inpatient hospital features 24/7 emergency and Level IV trauma care, a full range of specialty services, surgical services, maternity, infusion services, and more.



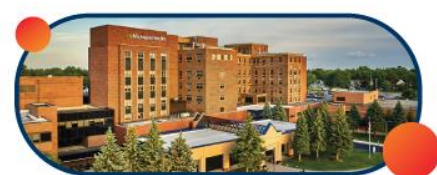
MyMichigan Medical Center Alpena

At 139 licensed beds, this hospital features a new, three-story patient tower featuring 60 private patient rooms, five operating rooms and eight labor and delivery rooms. In addition, a full range of specialty services, Level III trauma and 24/7 emergency care are offered.



Mackinac Island Medical Center*

Located on Mackinac Island, this facility provides 24/7 emergency care year-round, as well as primary care, X-ray and laboratory services.



MyMichigan Medical Center Saginaw*

This 268-bed acute care, teaching hospital provides Level II trauma care, 24/7 emergency care, as well as a full range of specialty services, and a comprehensive Stroke Center.



MidMichigan Community Health Services

MidMichigan Community Health Services is a federally-qualified rural community health center (FQHC) based in Houghton Lake that provides primary and specialty health care with an emphasis on access for the underserved.

Urgent Care, E2Care and Walk-In Care

MyMichigan Home Care provides home nursing, hospice care and more to help patients remain independent at home. Available in communities across our service area.



Mackinac Straits Hospital*

Located on a 16-acre campus in St. Ignace, this 15-bed hospital houses a rural health clinic, a 24/7 Emergency Department, a Fast Care Clinic, an outpatient surgery center, a six-bed infusion center, and a long-term care facility.



MyMichigan Medical Center Sault

The 49-bed hospital in Sault Ste. Marie specializes in high-quality, rural medicine and provides Level IV trauma care, 24/7 emergency care, as well as a full range of specialty services.



MyMichigan Medical Center Towne Centre*

This outpatient facility features a 24/7 Emergency Department, an outpatient surgery center, wound care and sleep centers, as well as specialty care, laboratory and imaging services.



MyMichigan Medical Center Clare

This 39-bed rural hospital provides 24/7 emergency and Level IV trauma care. Additionally, a full range of specialty services, outpatient care and urgent care are offered.



MyMichigan Medical Center Midland

This 324-bed teaching hospital, located on 225 acres of wooded campus, offers a broad range of primary care and specialty services, as well as 24/7 emergency and Level II trauma care.



MyMichigan Medical Center Standish*

Located in Standish, this 25-bed critical access hospital features a 29-bed skilled nursing facility, 24/7 emergency and Level IV trauma care, as well as a full range of specialty services.

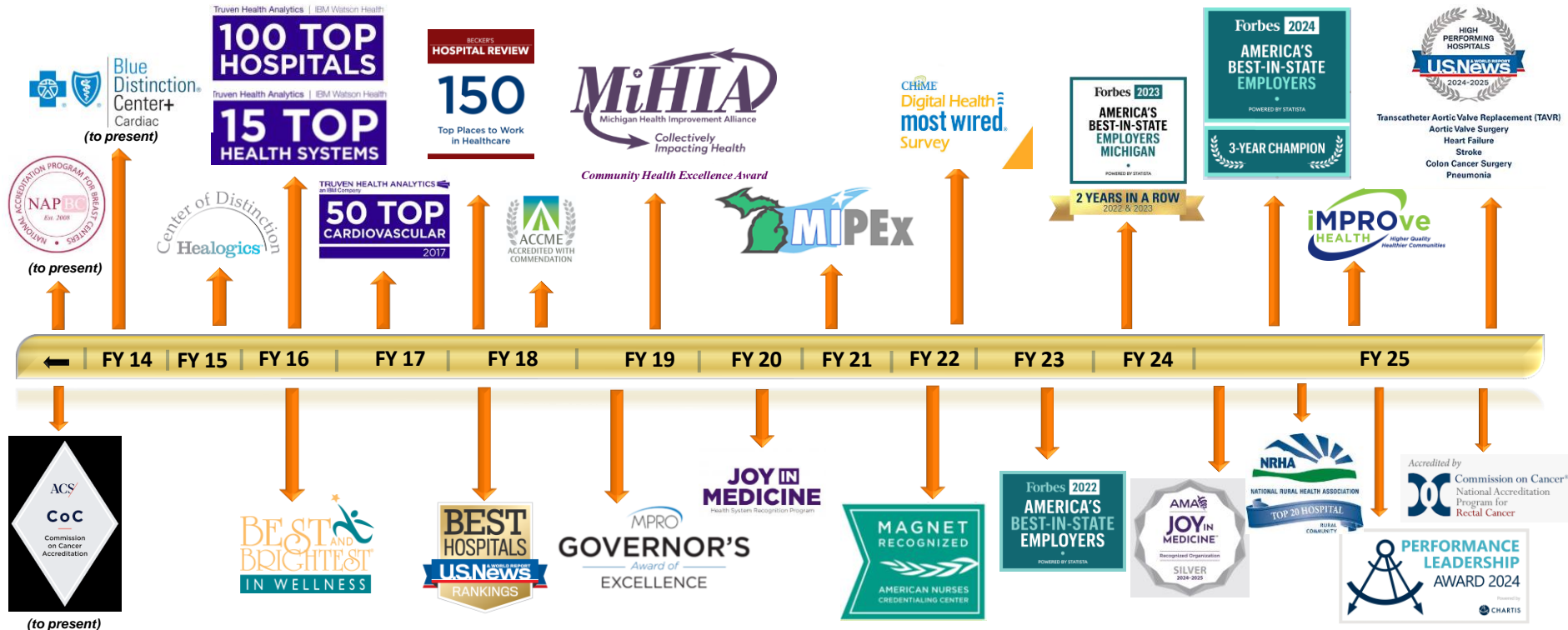

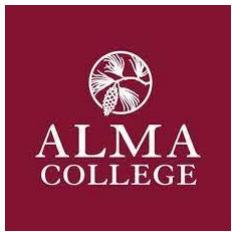
At 86 licensed beds, this acute care hospital features 24/7 emergency care, a full range of specialty services, maternity, surgical services, cancer care, and more.

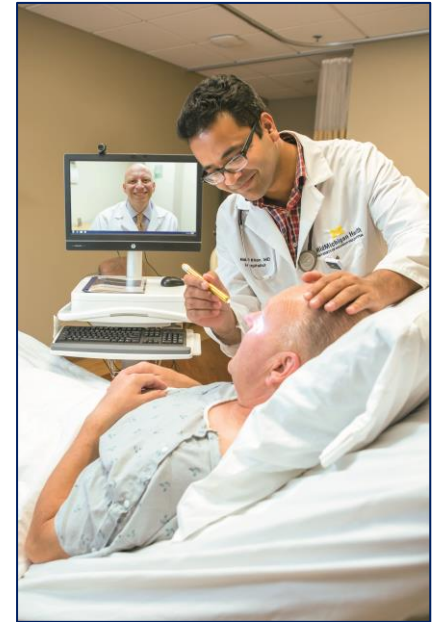

Tawas OB

- Rural programs will continue to become more challenging due to the decreased number of deliveries, increased portion of higher risk pregnancies, and physician shortage
- Population doesn't support the current number of programs within the geography
- Lowest level of deliveries in US in over 100 years
- This year approximately 140 deliveries.
- Closing delivery services over next 3-6 months.
- Still performing pre and post delivery OB, peds and GYN.
