

FIELD RULES & POLICIES

#1 DUGOUTS

NO MORE THAN 3 PLAYERS ARE ALLOWED INSIDE THE DUGOUT AT ONE TIME, TO ENSURE PHYSICAL DISTANCE GUIDELINES ARE MET. IT'S RECOMMENDED THAT EACH PLAYER HAS THEIR OWN SPOT.

NOTE: WHEN PRACTICING TEAMS SHOULD UTILIZE BOTH DUGOUTS AND WARM UP ON BOTH FOUL LINES TO MAXIMIZE PLAYER DISTANCE.

HW FIELD 1: ALL OTHER PLAYERS MUST BE STATIONED AT A SPOT ALONG THE FENCE, THAT IS MARKED WITH PAINT ON THE FENCE EVERY 6 FEET

HW FIELD 3: PAINT GROUND EVERY 6 FEET, OR STATION PLAYERS BEHIND THE FENCE POST/SCREEN EVERY 6 FEET.

WILSON: PLAYERS ARE ALLOWED INSIDE THE DUGOUT (3 MAXIMUM). OTHERWISE, THEY SHOULD LINE UP ALONG THE FENCE ON 1ST BASE SIDE OR THE HILL ON THE 3RD BASE SIDE. THIS WILL BE MARKED BY SPRAY PAINT AT 6-FOOT INTERVALS.

COOLIDGE BASEBALL: 3 PLAYERS MAXIMUM IN EACH DUGOUT. AT THE THIRD BASE DUGOUT PLAYERS WILL BE STATIONED DOWN THE BACK FENCE/BACKSTOP AND ON THE FIRST BASE SIDE BEHIND THE BENCH (NEAR WOODS). THIS WILL BE MARKED BY PAINT IN 6-FOOT INTERVALS.

COOLIDGE SOFTBALL: 3 PLAYERS MAXIMUM IN EACH DUGOUT. AT THE FIRST BASE SIDE PLAYERS WILL BE STATION DOWN THE BACK SIDE OF THE FENCE AND BACKSTOP AREA. ON THE THIRD BASE SIDE DOWN THE DIRECTION OF BEHIND THE DUGOUT AND TOWARDS THE BASKETBALL COURT.

MURPHY FIELDS: 3 PLAYERS MAXIMUM IN EACH DUGOUT. DEPENDING ON THE FIELD SPACING WILL VARY. COACHES CAN USE THE EXTRA SPACE ALONG EACH SIDE LINE AREA TO STATION PLAYERS IN 6 FOOT INTERVALS

EAST: PLAYERS ARE ALLOWED INSIDE THE DUGOUT (3 MAXIMUM). OTHERWISE, THEY SHOULD LINE UP ALONG THE FENCE ON 1ST AND 3RD BASE SIDE. THIS WILL BE MARKED BY SPRAY PAINT AT 6-FOOT INTERVALS.

SARGENT: PLAYERS ARE ALLOWED INSIDE THE DUGOUT (3 MAXIMUM). OTHERWISE, THEY SHOULD BE POSITIONED BEHIND EACH DUGOUT TOWARDS THE BRICK WALL/HILL. THIS WILL BE MARKED AT 6-FOOT INTERVALS.

***ALL PLAYERS SHOULD HAVE A DESIGNATED AREA FOR THEIR EQUIPMENT, AND MUST USE THEIR OWN HELMET AND GLOVE. BATS/BASEBALLS CAN BE THE ONLY SHARED ITEM ON THE FIELD.**

#1A BATTING CAGES

ONE COACH AND ONE PLAYER PER CAGE AT ONE TIME. ONLY COACHES ARE PERMITTED TO PICK UP BASEBALLS.

#2 (MASKS / FACE COVERINGS)

**ALL PLAYERS AND COACHES ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A MASK / FACE COVERINGS ON IN THE DUGOUT OR FENCING AREA. PLAYERS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WEAR ONE ON THE FIELD UNLESS GUIDANCE SAYS OTHERWISE (PER STATE ORDERS). ALL PLAYERS AND COACHES MUST ENTER AND EXIT THE FACILITY WITH A MASK ON.
NO MASK = NO PRACTICE/GAME.**

#3 HAND SANITIZER

PLAYERS ARE REQUIRED TO UTILIZE THE HAND SANITIZER MADE AVAILABLE TO THEM AFTER EVERY AT BAT AND EVERY HALF INNING. COACHES MUST USE THE HAND SANITIZER AFTER EVERY HALF INNING AS WELL.

#4 BASEBALLS/SOFTBALLS

BASEBALLS/SOFTBALLS NEED TO BE ROTATED OUT EVERY TWO INNINGS AND SPRAYED WITH CLEANING SOLUTION AND ROTATE BASEBALLS BACK.

#5 SEEDS/GUM/WATER BOTTLES/FOOD

GUM AND SUNFLOWER SEEDS ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED. PLAYERS MUST BRING THEIR OWN WATER BOTTLE/DRINK. THE FACILITY WILL BE A CARRY IN AND CARRY OUT. AT THE LITTLE LEAGUE COMPLEX THE SNACK BAR WILL BE CLOSED FOR THE DURATION OF THE SEASON.

#6 CELEBRATIONS

HIGH FIVES, HAND SHAKES, AND TEAM CELEBRATIONS CAN NOT OCCUR. THERE ARE NO POST GAME HANDSHAKES.

#7 PRE AND POST GAME

PLAYERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO RAKE FIELDS. COACHES SHOULD MAKE SURE ALL FIELDS ARE PROPERLY MAINTAINED (RAKED, COVERED WITH TARPS, ETC) AFTER EACH GAME/PRACTICE AND BE THE ONLY ONES WHO ACCESS THE EQUIPMENT DOORS (WHEN APPLICABLE). PLAYERS MUST EXIT FIELD AREA AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE GAME AND GO TO THE PARENT/GUARDIAN VEHICLE. (SEE SPECTATOR RULES).
