Tens of millions of Americans have come to believe the republic is lost and there are additional tens of millions who don't care one way or the other as long as they can recline in comfortable complacency and ingest daily doses of PCP; Popular Culture Psychosis leading to toxin immobility. The republic is not lost and with existence of a fully engaged God of Abraham/Sinai, Yeshua and 1776 no longer in doubt, defeat or complacent surrender are no longer options in that Yeshua warned the day would come when the sword would be necessary.

Americans are finally coming to understand that as much as intellectuals detest the idea, there is a Manichean battle between good and evil unfolding; a final confrontation prophesied over 2500 years ago with less than four years until the end of Human history as it is understood when Yeshua returns to Jerusalem in 2026. The battle against evil must be won but none have provided an idea worth fighting for let alone a vehicle Americans can drive to victory until now; the idea is subdue or destroy the false religion of human intellectual arrogance Marxianity to save the Constitution and the vehicle is CommonSenseCession.

Not secession, but **CommonSenseCession** to counter the de facto secession of Marxian states and tear away the fascist carapace that covers Washington DC; an unholy alliance between a weaponized government, media, academia, popular culture and corporations that objectively fits the classic definition of fascism; a covering that now labels those Americans who refuse to submit 'domestic terrorists'.

American patriots need not lament the lack of leadership and courage endemic to small 'r' republicans now that God is fully engaged. The bar has been set for every politician representing the party of Lincoln and you have human detritus to plan massive retaliation. What more could you ask than the foolish to confound intellectuals and the weak to confound the powerful and exactly what mankind was told to expect?

Human detritus commissioned to dismantle every tower of human intellectual arrogance with the most powerful weapon entrusted to human hands since the Ark of the Covenant...the Convergence Matrix.

Dismantling towers will require focus, purpose, conviction and strategy to counter the propagation of the evil theology of Marxianity and the rolling back of Marxian gains made over the span of 60 years. It first begins with 31 states in CommonSenseCession then 38 when Americans come to realize there is a clear choice between a nation adhering to the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God and the fictional utopian heaven on earth Marxians inevitably end up trying to build on the graves of those they profess to serve. How evil Marxianity is apparent from their works per Sun Tzu: "An evil enemy will burn his own nation to the ground to rule over the ashes".

It begins with those 31 states boldly and unapologetically declaring the Constitution and "Laws of Nature and of Nature's God" are non-negotiable then nullification by making it clear to courts in Washington DC 'You made you decision, now try and enforce it' even to the point of arresting federal law enforcement encroaching on the states and converting seized agency facilities to equivalent state enforcement offices; 31 state legislatures passing laws forbidding intrastate federal law enforcement agencies are restructured or disbanded.

The weaponized DOJ, FBI and the courts have openly created a two tier justice system and they, along with the now terrified Marxian establishment, are forewarned; they no longer have the consent of the governed in 31 states...and within a short time 38 at which time the Constitutional Republic will be restored. There will be no tearing down statues or sanctioned riots in states choosing CommonSenseCession; states where the Ten Commandments are displayed in public proclaiming the JudeoChristianNation; states where the law is enforced equally; states where the Convergence Matrix written by God is taught in schools as history.

"The trouble with purging the school curriculum of religious knowledge is that ultimate questions cannot be answered without reference to religious beliefs or at least to philosophy. With religion expelled from the schools, a clear field was left for the entrance of the mode of belief called humanitarianism, or secular humanism--the latter a term employed by the cultural historian Christopher Dawson. During the past four decades and more, the place that religion used to hold in American schooling, always a rather modest and non-dogmatic place, has been filled by secular humanism. Its root principle is that human nature and society may be perfected without the operation of divine grace..."

CommonSenseCession would create a bastion of constitutional principle to serve as a staging area from whence the battle to retake Washington DC from Marxianity can be launched; a battle to reestablish the Republic of Jefferson and Adams with a principled reassertion of the Constitution as it was originally intended with the intent clearly established by the writings and debates of the founders themselves; a battle sanctioned by the God who placed His personal imprimatur on 1776 and the founding documents.

CommonSenseCession (CSC) would not entail secession Marxians would use to justify military intervention; CSC would stand on both Constitutional and moral ground to assert federalism with the reduction of federal government to enumerated powers. The president would command the military, conduct foreign policy, the currency would remain the same, travel across state lines would not be affected, the 10th Amendment would be respected and federal tax authority would be restricted to funding the “necessary and proper”.

In terms American patriots should understand and appreciate; 31 states need not be forced to choose between submission to Marxianity or secession to preserve the Constitution, which would result in a civil war Marxians want now that they control the military...patricide. It is a trap as obvious as the election fraud and the capitol, Reichstag Fire, “insurrection”. The focus must be on creating room and time; room for Marxians to fail and time to let the reality of an extant God of 1776 sink in.

Thirty-one states in a position to turn Marxian intellectual arrogance into their greatest weakness; thirty-one states Marxians would be happy to let go if doing so were possible. The only question is how to translate the wishes of both into a workable formula; one that would share the costs of the enumerated federal functions.

Federalism is the key; federalism as the founders intended; federalism as defined by Michael Anton in his must read book *The Stakes; America at the Point of No Return*:

"Our founders sought to establish the weakest possible federal government capable of performing its essential functions, for three fundamental and intertwined reasons. First, government is inherently dangerous, so the less power it has, the better. Second, the states—being closer to the people and more responsive to regional differences and needs—are better equipped to handle most matters than a far-off centralized administration. Third, the states were prior to the federal government; the people, through their states, created the latter to serve them, not the other way around."

"According to the parchment, the federal government is supposed to field and fund an army and navy, protect the borders, make treaties, regulate foreign trade and interstate commerce, maintain a sound common currency...and that's about it."

Federalism is entirely incompatible with statist theologies that have proven to be the greatest mass murders in history. If thirty-one states told the other 19 that all legislation and existing laws that exceed the enumerated powers in the Constitution, as well as SCOTUS decisions encroaching on social issues the founders intended to be determined by individual states, were nullified, states in CommonsenseCession would not only gain the constitutional but also the moral high ground i.e. if you want to live in blue America where the alphabet of sexual preference and race determine all things...then go.

Republicans now control the state legislatures of 31 states; providing the foundation for a strategy to secure a total of 38 state legislatures, governors, representatives and senators so as to restore the Constitution. One need only imagine the possibilities as it concerns the recent move by tech oligarchs to silence "domestic terrorists" if CSC was in place; California is the largest importer of electricity from CSC states ergo in response to censorship a flick of the switch would subject California to 'denial of service' in turn.

No doubt the Menlo Park technocracy has made provisions for backup, but the fence hasn't been built that will stop the enraged plebeians from exacting the same punishment the tech patricians thought justified when it was Black Lives Matter burning cities. New York financial services are no different; New York depends upon states they look down upon to keep Broadway lights burning and the financial services servers online.

There may be no better example of the founder's intention that states would hold parity power with the central government than the revocation of the Keystone XL pipeline permit which eliminated 11,000 high paying jobs virtually overnight; justified by asserting the pipeline was not in the best interests of the United States even though the pipeline is critical to energy independence; minimizing dependence on Middle East oil is less important to Marxians than the moot issue of climate change given Yeshua in 2026 Jerusalem.

TC Energy Corporation, formerly TransCanada Corporation, filed a Notice of Intent with the Department of State to initiate a North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) claim to recover economic damages resulting from the revocation of the Keystone XL Project Permit. Aside from the fact Canada TC Energy has a valid detrimental reliance claim based upon the Trump approval, President Biden's authority to cancel the permit was challenged in court by 21 states led by Texas AG Paxton which rightly pointed to Article 8, Clause 3, Article 1 of the Constitution that grants congress the sole authority to regulate foreign commerce...which congress did in 2011 after which it languished for years until the Trump approval.

The lawsuit was dismissed as a moot issue when TC Energy cancelled the project. Now consider what might have happened if the 22 states including Missouri, Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, Georgia, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, South Carolina, South Dakota, Texas, Utah, West Virginia, and Wyoming embraced CommonSenseCession and simply nullified Biden unconstitutional power grab and issued the necessary permits of their own accord.

The eventual constitutional crisis cannot be avoided and in approving the pipeline an argument for nullification would be easy to understand given Marxians nullified immigration law to establish both sanctuary states and cities; banning federal immigration officers from enforcing federal law. Importantly, the JudeoChristianNation in CommonSenseCession (CSC) will have gained the moral high ground easy to see and understand given the blatant hypocrisy of Marxian states. Unfortunately, what Victor Davis Hanson termed Marquis de Queensbury small 'r' republicans are unwilling to call a spade a spade...Marxianity is evil incarnate and willing to break every rule, trample every tradition and weaponize government to advance an agenda that will end in inevitable violent revolution: Gramsci's "War of Maneuver". Do you really think the IRS needs 5 million rounds of ammunition?

The main thrust of Pamphlet No.5 JudeoChristianNation is recreating the Black Robe Regiment under the banner of One Faith-One Voice to turn the churches into centers of learning in anticipation of the pews filling with those seeking understanding, meaning and purpose in the context of an extant God. The churches need not forfeit their identities, however, Democrats, Independents, Republicans and complacent committing to the war that must be fought to save the republic will require both education and a common identity...as if from day one.

"[If a] people [are] so demoralized and depraved as to be incapable of exercising a wholesome control, their reformation must be taken up ab incunabulis (from cradles). Their minds [must] be informed by education what is right and what wrong, [must] be encouraged in habits of virtue and deterred from those of vice by the dread of punishments, proportioned indeed, but irremissible. In all cases, [they must] follow truth as the only safe guide and eschew error which bewilders us in one false consequence after another in endless succession. These are the inculcations necessary to render the people a sure basis for the structure of order and good government." Thomas Jefferson to John Adams, 1819

God evidenced insures "...the dread of punishments, proportioned indeed, but irremissible" and each individual must make the penultimate choice; choose God or lose all. Choosing God requires embracing right rather than wrong and good rather than evil; following "...truth as the only safe guide". One cannot recognize the truth without some type of education and there can be no doubt that after public schools stopped teaching civics in 1978 America has become "...so demoralized and depraved as to be incapable of exercising a wholesome control (ergo) their reformation must be taken up ab incunabulis (from cradles)." Hence the Black Robe Regiment and Democratic-Republicans to work with the likes of the Heritage Foundation, Hillsdale College and the Claremont Institute among others to create a curriculum...while also reintroducing God to the classroom.

Democratic-Republicans in CommonSenseCession

"The unquestionable republicanism of the American mind will break through the mist under which it has been clouded, and will oblige its agents to reform the principles and practices of their administration." Thomas Jefferson to Elbridge Gerry, 1799

Prescient Thomas Jefferson, prophet of governance, knew then this time would come; the Republican Party will be reborn and the mid-wife will be principled Democratic-Republicans armed with definition as never before to compel those seeking office under the banner of Republican to "reform the principles and practices of their administration"; definition that establishes clear moral lines; definition reestablishing the terms of the necessary debates by replacing politically correct speech, tailored to define the terms before the debate begins, so as to have the honest conversations Americans have fought and died for; Democratic-Republicans as the new home for those who despise the swamp dwellers that now occupy Washington DC whether (D) or (R); a 'we the people' identity to create a Republican Party Lincoln would embrace.

"We the people are the rightful masters of both Congress and the courts, not to overthrow the Constitution but to overthrow the men who pervert the Constitution." Abraham Lincoln

Those well versed in American history might think Democratic-Republican an odd descriptive given the original party of Jefferson and Madison were in opposition to the Federalists, including John Adams who brought the Constitution into being while Jefferson and Thomas Paine were fortuitously in France. Explore the difference between the two parties in what might be considered the first failure of American reason given the divisive nature of the intellectual battles that severed the friendship and tested the mutual respect shared by Jefferson and Adams; two greats who would reconcile before their deaths to provide guidance for this moment.

The evil that was the French Revolution cannot be understated with Jefferson believing it to be the natural successor to the American Revolution; a secular and anti-religious revolution founded upon reason alone appealed to Jefferson but Adams and Burke recognized Voltaire was right when he said "If God did not exist, we would have to invent him". When the churches burned in France the barrier to mass murder was reduced to ashes and tens of thousands of men, women and children in Vendee who refused to bend to a state sanctioned church were butchered in the first modern genocide...literally in the name of progress. It can and will happen here if Americans fail to reject the state sanctioned church Marxianity en mass.

It can be said the first American political parties, Democratic-Republicans and Federalists, resulted from the weak Articles of Confederation and the French Revolution. Jefferson never ceased believing in a God of reason but the bloody horrors in France led him to concede his differences with Adams were misplaced as to the need to infuse God in politics so as to provide critical moral and ethical guardrails; a very private and individual infusion needed

at every level of governance from school boards to town councils to state legislatures to Washington DC. Doing so would require Democratic-Republicans willing to "... Mutually Pledge To Each Other Our Lives, Our Fortunes, And Our Sacred Honor" then commit the time necessary to learn foundational truths.

Those who would lead Democratic-Republicans have a bar to surmount; every Republican seeking office should be prepared to answer these questions; Have you read every topical Jefferson quote?; Have you read every topical Adams quote?; Have you read the Federalist Papers in their entirety?; Have you read *Reflections on the Revolution in France* by Edmund Burke?; Have you read William Blackstone's four-volume *Commentaries on the Laws of England* in their entirety? If the answer is no the candidate is unqualified for office under the terms of a Democratic-Republican. For those who would follow there is Thomas Jefferson's letter to his nephew Peter Carr in 1785 as a starting point:

---"When your mind shall be well improved with science, nothing will be necessary to place you in the highest points of view, but to pursue the interests of your country, the interests of your friends, and your own interests also, with the purest integrity, the most chaste honor. The defect of these virtues can never be made up by all the other acquirements of body and mind. Make these then your first object. Give up money, give up fame, give up science, give the earth itself and all it contains, rather than do an immoral act. And never suppose, that in any possible situation, or under any circumstances, it is best for you to do a dishonorable thing, however slightly so it may appear to you. Whenever you are to do a thing, though it can never be known but to yourself, ask yourself how you would act were all the world looking at you, and act accordingly. Encourage all your virtuous dispositions, and exercise them whenever an opportunity arises; being assured that they will gain strength by exercise, as a limb of the body does, and that exercise will make them habitual. From the practice of the purest virtue, you may be assured you will derive the most sublime comforts in every moment of life, and in the moment of death. If ever you find yourself environed with difficulties and perplexing circumstances, out of which you are at a loss how to extricate yourself, do what is right, and be assured that that will extricate you the best out of the worst situations. Though you cannot see, when you take one step, what will be the next, yet follow truth, justice, and plain dealing, and never fear their leading you out of the labyrinth, in the easiest manner possible. The knot which you thought a Gordian one, will untie itself before you. Nothing is so mistaken as the supposition, that a person is to extricate himself from a difficulty, by intrigue, by chicanery, by dissimulation, by trimming, by an untruth, by an injustice. This increases the difficulties tenfold; and those who pursue these methods, get themselves so involved at length, that they can turn no way but their infamy becomes more exposed. It is of great importance to set a resolution, not to be shaken, never to tell an untruth. There is no vice so mean, so pitiful, so contemptible; and he who permits himself to tell a lie once, finds it much easier to do it a second and third time, till at length it becomes habitual; he tells lies without attending to it, and truths without the world's believing him. This falsehood of the tongue leads to that of the heart, and in time depraves all its good dispositions"---

Thomas Jefferson, a sect of his own, wrote words Solomon would recognize as a virtual summary of Proverbs, and Judaic scholars might deem a Halakhah; the way a Democratic-Republican walks. Education is the key and luckily there are a number of eminent writers, Michael Anton and Peter Berkowitz in particular, capable of eloquent exposition as to the founding principles and the 'first things' but at the moment they are as prophets crying in the wilderness; lost in dark shades of gray that dominate the landscape; trying to explain to ploughmen complex concepts made difficult to understand by a theology that has been allowed to define all things in shades of gray.

New students require the language of the ploughman and simple explanations to begin with to provide some foundation as to what they are witnessing so as to focus on the truth made clear and at the top of the list is culture versus race. God does not recognize race per se but has from the beginning placed great emphasis on greater and lesser peoples and cultures with the 'prime directive' being the greater is to elevate the lesser but never is the greater to be made less by contact e.g. misogynistic, violent and racist Rap "music".

Jonah Goldberg wrote a piece for National Review titled *In Defense of Elitism* which captured the truth before the truth became verboten:

About a decade ago, one of the Smithsonian museums here in Washington had an exhibit on the history of human civilization, or something along those lines. I didn't see it, but a friend of mine went and his description always stuck with me. One of the displays was a comparative timeline of different cultures. At, say, 1250 you'd see what the British, the Japanese, the Chinese, or the Arabs had come up with. The sight that really struck home for my friend was a beautiful Renaissance Italian clock, with movable gears and a stunning hand-painted face with a sun and moon alternating for AM and PM. The clock came from the 15th or 16th century, I think. But that's not really important. On the same timeline for African culture there was a wood mask with eye- and mouth-holes cut out in some "novel" way. The little explanatory card on the wall tried to make it sound, somehow, as though the handcrafted clock and the mask were similarly impressive accomplishments. To which my friend responded, roughly, "Are you high?"

I may have gotten the details a bit off here, but the substance is obviously true. Some things are better than other things. Some cultures are better than other cultures. Some things are more worth studying, celebrating, and emulating than other things. Or as the late William Henry III put it in his wonderful book, *In Defense of Elitism*, "It is scarcely the same thing to put a man on the moon as to put a bone in your nose."

Obviously, the article would be called racist today...but it is not; it is the truth that has been suppressed by Marxian elites who know very well the words of Émile Zola are operative: "If you shut up truth and bury it under the ground, it will but grow, and gather to itself such explosive power that the day it bursts through it will blow up everything in its way." In the 1960s neo-Marxists abandon class distinctions in favor of never to be resolved racial distinctions by redefining the Civil Rights Movement as *the seminal event in American history*...and after close to 2000 race riots in the intervening years Marxians fully intend to use the black subculture as cannon fodder in the "War of Maneuver" or violent revolution at the appointed time.

More recently, Rod Dreher wrote a piece for The American Conservative titled Jon Haidt Defends Amy Wax and he too captured the essence of the truth in the first two paragraphs.

In an extraordinary show of the collapse of standards at an Ivy League law school, almost half the faculty at Penn Law signed a letter denouncing their colleague Amy Wax for her recent op-ed column decrying the loss of bourgeois values like self-discipline and commitment to marriage. Wax (and her co-author Larry Alexander) wrote, in part:

All cultures are not equal. Or at least they are not equal in preparing people to be productive in an advanced economy. The culture of the Plains Indians was designed for nomadic hunters, but is not suited to a First World, 21st-century environment. Nor are the single-parent, antisocial habits, prevalent among some working-class whites; the anti-"acting white" rap culture of inner-city blacks; the anti-assimilation ideas gaining ground among some Hispanic immigrants. These cultural orientations are not only incompatible with what an advanced free-market economy and a viable democracy require, they are also destructive of a sense of solidarity and reciprocity among Americans. If the bourgeois cultural script — which the upper-middle class still largely observes but now hesitates to preach — cannot be widely reinstated, things are likely to get worse for us all.

If one gains the higher vantage where an ineffable intellect and power that chose the title God has a plan for human ascendance the tiny sliver of humanity that is the Jews makes uncommon sense; Jews were subjected the stringent laws of the Torah to create a highly disciplined people that would lead mankind into the future and they survived and thrived against all odds...and John Adams took note:

"I will insist the Hebrews have [contributed] more to civilize men than any other nation. If I was an atheist and believed in blind eternal fate, I should still believe that fate had ordained the Jews to be the most essential instrument for civilizing the nations ... They are the most glorious nation that ever inhabited this Earth. The Romans and their empire were but a bubble in comparison to the Jews. They have given religion to three-quarters of the globe and have influenced the affairs of mankind more and more happily than any other nation, ancient or modern."

John Adams, in a letter to F. A. Van der Kemp

The United States is truly exceptional ...the beneficiary of a plan that can be traced directly to Sinai with an emphasis on greater cultures. In the last 100 years she has risen to the occasion and defeated both Soviet and Nazi versions of socialism...both specifically identified as evil incarnate in the matrices. In the short 77 years since the end of WW2 Americans lost touch with the basic requirements of a civilization in direct proportion to the purging of God from schools and the civic square, with the destruction of the family a primary target of the evil that is Marxianity.

It is incumbent upon Americans to realize and accept the United States was created in usufruct for two purposes and two purposes only; "...a model for the protection of man in a state of *freedom* and *order*" per Thomas Jefferson and the reestablishment of Israel. The terms of usufruct, 'the right to enjoy the use and advantages of another's property short of the destruction or waste of its substance' has been violated and God is engaged.

The Convergence Matrix is both an offer of peace with nonnegotiable terms and a warning...and the most profound warning goes out to the most loyal tribe; of the tribes of Marxianity no other has more to gain and more to lose than the black subculture. After 60 years and upwards of \$25T the needle on the character scale has gone down; evidencing Martin Luther King Jr. was a failure and rather than the seminal event in American history the Civil Rights Movement is revealed to be nothing more than a Marxian foil to advance an agenda.

Unbeknownst to blacks in America, they are the last chosen people but they are jeopardizing their legacy and blessing by threatening God's plan. Do you realize that 5% of the population, black males age 15 to 45, commit 55% of reported crimes and if eliminated crimes rates would soon match the safest countries in Europe? Make no mistake; there is a major difference between greats like Thomas Sowell and those blacks who identify as black before American constituting the black subculture. For decades those blacks have been extended a virtual cloak of invisibility by Marxians with the threat of "racist" or "white supremacist" used to silence the opposition.

To gauge the cowardice and accepted double standard one need only ask what the reception would be to a Congressional White Caucus to oppose the Congressional Black Caucus...the members of which are inextricably bound to the black subculture and slated for destruction. The overt pandering by the political establishment has resulted in two black federal holidays which will cease to exist when the first shots of revolution are fired.

America is quickly losing its freedom and Planned Chaos has dealt a near fatal blow to order yet the shades of neo-Marxist gray have somehow managed to hide the true nature of the establishment beast. For purposes of CSC two truths require illumination; first, the cold civil war now engaged is not about race any more than the Civil War was about slavery before 1863, and second, the divisions then and now are primarily economic and cultural.

In the 72 years between ratification of the Constitution in 1789 and the start of the Civil War in 1861 two distinct economies emerged and were controlled by two equally distinct categories of elites; the agrarian south and manufacturing north; a southern aristocracy and a New England gentry being subsumed by scores of venture capitalists including outliers like Cornelius Vanderbilt and immigrants like Andrew Carnegie birthing the first modern industrial society and the classic American melting pot.

The Civil War was a conflict between rival economic interests with the Southern agrarian economy dependent upon the export of cotton, tobacco and food commodities to Europe while at the same time the fast growing industrial North was attempting to displace European industrial goods...diametrically opposed interests.

The founders and the generation that followed harbored an aversion to "foreign entanglements" that spared the United States the power and influence of the eminently political European banking houses. The banking system in America evolved slowly and it wasn't until after the 1st and 2nd Bank of the United States came and went the National Banking Acts of 1863 and 1864 actually created the United States National Banking System. The libertarian financial services industry of today did not exist before the Civil War.

Academics debate whether politics is upstream or downstream from culture if somehow the time immemorial fundamental foundation of cultures, shared religion, no longer applied. American culture is in chaos absent shared moral foundation and as such the debate has been essentially economic until certitude. I would posit that the division edging ever closer to an actual Civil War is as it was in the approach to 1861 but the difference between the two economies is even starker; the divide separates those who create tangible wealth and those who manipulate the intangible but highly profitable world of finance, media, high tech and the Imaginarium.

As noted, from the higher vantage which informs neo-Marxism is regressive in extremis, tending toward status societies, the map of red and blue counties has two eerie analogs; the plantation system of the antebellum south and castles of feudal Europe...both of which looked to the surrounding peasants to support their lifestyles. Few know the nouveau riche of a rapidly industrializing United States flocked to Europe to mingle with the aristocracy just as the nouveau riche of the CCP are doing today; one generation behind the tech aristocracy loosing coastal trustafarian offspring on America.

In many ways the confrontation between red and blue counties reflected in the growing authoritarianism coming from Marxians now in control is a desperate move to solidify a Marxist revolution unique in the annals of history but one that Gramsci should have anticipated given the top down nature of Cultural Hegemony as it would evolve in America; a revolution of the elites to subdue the working class.

One might better understand the coastal obsession with climate change and the environment in context in that energy production is a predominately flyover country mainstay that extends far beyond oil field workers into ranching, farming, transportation and manufacturing the coastal castles and estates view as déclassé and an necessary evil given the global economy. The wealthy coastal elites driving climate change enjoy virtual immunity from environmental regulations in that most elites work in sectors of the economy least affected the regulations...and those elites have little or no sympathy for those who work with their hands and actually create wealth.

Destroying the fossil fuel industry will result in the same widespread energy poverty that has the California working class paying almost twice as much for gasoline and electricity than most flyover states and the job losses will destroy even more small towns and cities struggling to survive in those states.

What the elites on the coasts avoid discussing whenever possible is the NIMBY reality of wind and solar; none want their view polluted by wind and solar as appealing as billboards. California, champion of wind, has less than 6000 windmills while Texas has close to 29,000...which proved to be less a boon than a bust when the capacity went offline after freezing.

Marxians fully intend the red states to serve as the physical plant for the “Green New Deal” agenda so popular in the coastal castles and estates; allowing elites to feed their environmental and clean energy egos at the expense of the peasants and in doing so rarely having to be upset by the site of windmills and solar marring nature most prefer to fly over. A more accurate accounting of GND ambitions can be found in an article titled *Green Fascists Are Destroying the World* by Edward Ring for American Greatness.

The existing republican establishment will not press the advantage afforded by the matrices which, again, goes to the necessity of Democratic-Republicans; not to destroy the Republican Party but to restore the principles and virtues of Jefferson, Adams and Lincoln; requiring every establishment republican to join the fight or step down and get out of the way.

The restoration of the Constitution first begins with separating the wheat from the chaff; separating those who adhere to the Laws of Nature and of Nature’s God from those who do not by creating an island of constitutional and societal order in the sea of Planned Chaos created by Marxianity. How refreshing if the thirty-one states in CommonSenseCession, one after the other, ban CRT, unconstitutional equity over equality, affirmative action and trans competing in sports...while also reintroducing God to the schools as history.

Separation of greater peoples and cultures from the lesser has been one of the most important priorities since Sinai and a prerequisite for progress in the truest sense of the word. Those who adhere to the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God are by definition greater people capable of creating a greater culture even when having to start from the dark hole Marxianity has created; a society and nation grounded by moral absolutes has a natural foundation to establish standards of conduct and promulgate those standards while maintaining the political authority and will to negate influences damaging society and traditional American culture.

The JudeoChristianNation in CommonSenseCession is more a state of mind than anything else; it is a place that has occupied the contemplations of human beings from time immemorial; it is a place where people are free to pursue meaningful lives focused on family, friends and community unencumbered by the distant demands of government and coercive power in the hands of politicians.

For Marxists it is the 'after government withers away' utopia that first requires maximum coercion and the dictatorship of the proletariat...but for Jefferson, Adams and the founders the answer was constraining the base instincts of men with the certainty of a higher power required for self-governance and a delicately balanced Constitution designed to constrain government, captured succinctly by William Barr at the University of Notre Dame:

---"These practical Statesmen understood that individuals, while having the potential for great good, also had the capacity for great evil. Men are subject to powerful passions and appetites, and, if unrestrained, are capable of ruthlessly riding roughshod over their neighbors and the community at large. No society can exist without some means for restraining individual rapacity.

But, if you rely on the coercive power of government to impose restraints, this will inevitably lead to a government that is too controlling, and you will end up with no liberty, just tyranny. On the other hand, unless you have some effective restraint, you end up with something equally dangerous – licentiousness – the unbridled pursuit of personal appetites at the expense of the common good. This is just another form of tyranny – where the individual is enslaved by his appetites, and the possibility of any healthy community life crumbles. Edmund Burke summed up this point in his typically colorful language:

"Men are qualified for civil liberty, in exact proportion to their disposition to put chains upon their appetites....Society cannot exist unless a controlling power be placed somewhere; and the less of it there is within, the more there must be without. It is ordained in the eternal constitution of things that men intemperate minds cannot be free. Their passions forge their fetters."--

Passions can be a major problem and to CSC there will be those who will push for secession; some genuinely and others trying to prompt a civil war. Those who have learned their American history, and those who would be well advised to learn quickly, are likely familiar with Lincoln's House Divided speech and his 1st Inaugural Address as appeals to reason; trying to persuade the South it was in their best interest to preserve the Union...going as far as assuring the South he had no constitutional authority to interfere with slavery. Lincoln knew full well slavery would eventually wither away and questioned why the South would forego representatives and Senators and lose the ability to protect Southern interests in congress.

Passion and pride overcame reason and South Carolina foolishly fired...less on Ft. Sumter than on an industrial economy that manufactured over 90% of the locomotives, footwear, cloth and firearms. General Sherman captured the failure of reason in a letter to Atlanta:

"You might as well appeal against the thunder-storm as against these terrible hardships of war. They are inevitable, and the only way the people of Atlanta can hope once more to live in peace and quiet at home, is to stop the war, which can only be done by admitting that it began in error and is perpetuated in pride."

False pride and passion must not be allowed to jeopardize the battle of wills and ideas necessary to remove Marxianity from Washington DC...secession is not an option though a cold civil war certainly is. A civil war is entirely a question of legitimacy and when the existing political consensus no longer holds the Constitutional order begins to break down. The most telling aspect of legitimacy is writing, interpretation and enforcement of the law and as such, to what degree the political consensus has frayed and the constitutional order has broken down can be gauged by the willingness of the political factions, society and the judiciary to respect the law. By measure the Constitution is facing an existential threat.

It has become patently obvious the gauge points to Marxians establishing a legal double standard, the administrative state as a weapon and nullification of immigration and drugs laws in Planned Chaos. Americans clinging to their guns, bibles and Constitution are being subjected to the coercive imposition of intellectualized morality resulting in a society divested of traditional customs, norms and its Judeo-Christian identity; an assault the feckless and often times servile Republican Party is ill-equipped to resist.

Before confronting Marxianity directly, Democratic-Republicans will have to first fight an internecine civil war with the Republican Party establishment best fought in the JudeoChristianNation at every level beginning with a focus on the family and community including local school boards and city councils. Doing so will require Patriots focused upon organizing to flood every school board and city council meeting to begin the process of retaking territory ceded long ago and in doing so send a message to Washington DC.

This, we will defend, and what you have taken or destroyed will be restored.

Certitude is liberation writ large; Marxians tout vaunted intellectual arrogance but American patriots have the mathematics fused with history and the Torah evidencing the God of Sinai, Yeshua and the Constitution of the United States as a continuum; matrices defying probabilities mathematics beyond the breaking point and as such admissible in a court of law. Democratic-Republicans can rightly insist that the matrices are taught in schools and never again will Freedom from Religion be able to bar the Ten Commandments from the public square. Something to believe in is something worth fighting for...and the young cannot escape the choosing.

"We are now trusting to those who are against us in position and principle, to fashion to their own form the minds and affections of our youth... This canker is eating on the vitals of our existence, and if not arrested at once, will be beyond remedy."

Thomas Jefferson to James Breckinridge, 1821

Teaching the young and those who paid no attention in history class is a priority for both the Black Robe Regiment and Democratic-Republicans in CommonSenseCession. Historians within the last 100 years have introduced a degree of sophistication that has evolved into a more Marxian historical determinations way of interpreting history and as such what should have been formative years of civic education became an ideological burden with almost zero appreciation for the past conveyed to two entire generations.

The future severed from the past has resulted in a generation of nihilistic iconoclasts that perceive destruction of statues and tradition as "progress" as was intended by Marxianity; Planned Chaos. The pieces on the chessboard are nearing their final positions but the game has changed with the appearance of a evidenced God of 1776; order from chaos.

Order from Chaos

*Property is surely a right of mankind as really as liberty. ... The moment the idea is admitted into society, that property is not as sacred as the laws of God, and that **there is not a force of law and public justice to protect it**, anarchy and tyranny commence.* John Adams

John Adams was right and all it will take is 31 states passing laws protecting property mirroring those of Texas to put an end to race riots now approaching two thousand in number since 1960. Marxians say "brick and mortar" can be replaced; missing the point entirely...it is about principle and from hereon in to 2026 first principles and virtues such as honor, honesty, loyalty, courage and character will be critical not only to how the end of days plays out but also the tipping of the scales of judgment.

As Americans come to embrace a precise baseline definition of 'Patriot' they will also come to realize the battlefield in front of them is fraught with danger and as it is with all wars it is an unfortunate reality there will be casualties with decapitation a primary goal of Marxians; tech companies are censoring speech, 'woke' corporations are demonetizing and denial of service is growing. There is no guarantee what few conservative voices broadcasting today will be broadcasting tomorrow. Hence necessity for CommonSenseCession as an island platform from whence massive retaliation can be mounted.

Scottish common sense screams out what is now a cold civil war will rapidly spiral out of control if patriots cannot bring themselves to label Marxians as enemies of the Constitution and act accordingly. Fortunately, America still has great minds like Victor Davis Hanson, Peter Berkowitz and Michael Anton waiting for a call to provide guidance. After the '*The Flight 93 Election*' article by Anton only two other essays managed to capture the moment until just recently as exemplified by that of Tal Bachman; '*Conservatism and the People*' and '*America's Proud Legacy of Liberty*' by Peter Berkowitz.

In the liberty essay Berkowitz quotes Richard Brookhiser from his book "*Give Me Liberty: A History of America's Exceptional Idea*" which rejects "...that classical liberalism, which holds that government's purpose is to protect individual freedom, is inherently incompatible with nationalism, which champions government's promotion of a particular people's traditions and political aspirations... the United States, notwithstanding the blemishes and flaws it shares with all countries, is different".

Brookhiser wrote, and Berkowitz recognized, "The unique feature of America's nationalism is its concern for liberty...We have been securing it, defining it, recovering it, and fighting for it for four hundred years. We have been doing it since we were a floundering settlement on a New World river, long before we were a country. We do it now on podiums and battlefields beyond our borders." Beyond our own borders is actually germane in that dangerous nationalism is centered on lebensraum as in Hitler and China...not the introverted nationalism that defines Americans.

What is derided as populism and nationalism is the result of an uncomfortable gut instinct that hundreds of years of shared traditions, values and history being swept aside by Marxian policies such as multiculturalism is the root cause of societal decay. More than a gut instinct, what people feel is a visceral connection with the God of Sinai which is softly speaking to the heart of hearts of tens of millions whispering 'Marxianity is evil'.

Whether in Britain with Brexit, Hungary or the United States, populism and nationalism is inextricably bound to patriotism rather than conservatism and has as its foundation the immutable "Laws of Nature and of Nature's God" as opposed to the various conservative creeds that failed to preserve Judeo-Christian societies as Marxians inexorably executed Gramsci's strategy of Cultural Hegemony.

The Satan and ha-satan exist; created by the God of Sinai to test mankind...a final test of reason that will be unrelenting, demanding and nonnegotiable. It goes without saying one does not want to be on the wrong side of the line when the end of history as it is understood comes to an end. But it must be said true center, where every human being can find a place, will have to be built on a solid foundation of reasoned certitude not religion though both have the same predicate...the God of Sinai.

For Democratic-Republicans that truth will require a word representing center to convey in no uncertain terms the foundation of a reasoned position or proposition; Blaise Pascal's "certitude" which will allow Americans and their representatives to forcefully respond to questions as to the basis for a position by simply responding "certitude" rather than 'my beliefs' or 'my faith'. It is a truth reflected in the measure of all things derived from the Convergence Matrix as foundation for patriots...an insurmountable problem for Marxianity.

"The Torah and moral law of Sinai, Yeshua as a precisely defined messiah of purpose, the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution of the United States, republican governance as defined by Jefferson and Adams, are the benchmarks by which all else is to be measured; gone are the debates as to every belief system on earth having equal stature."

With the measure of all things there is certitude as never before which, when applied in the context of a now self-evident plan, will have the potential of transforming conservative intellectuals into patriots; unapologetic patriots as certitude is wont to do. Lincoln was one of the first to use the term "conservative" but not in opposition to "liberals" in that whether abolitionist or slave holder all appealed, with various degrees of legitimacy to the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution; a conservative sought to preserve and defend the Constitution and its principles and though southern Democrats wrapped themselves in the robes of the Constitution in the end their position was impossible to reconcile to "all men are created equal".

And yet they fought to the bitter end for reasons history written in blue ink has never fully explained given the fact 95% of those who fought for the South did not own slaves. That Americans will refuse to bow to tyranny is a lesson that need not be repeated. One proud confederate soldier when asked by a Union officer 'You don't own slaves, why are you fighting?' answered "Because you're down here."

"Rebellion to tyrants is obedience to God" explains every rebel life lost and the equation is the same today as it was in 1861, but CommonSenseCession not secession; resistance vs. rebellion is a distinction yet to be determined by Marxians intent upon provoking violence...*a verbis ad verbera*.

Marxians are making the final push as exemplified by the judicial double standard and yet per Alinsky's 'Make the enemy live up to its own book of rules' Marxians insist the opposition adhere to laws they themselves break with impunity. CSC will require Democratic-Republicans to craft civil disobedience exceeding that of Marxians so as to confound the power structure they now control which will include nullification of laws.

"A strict observation of the written laws is doubtless one of the high duties of a good citizen, but it is not the highest. The laws of necessity, of self-preservation, of saving our country when in danger, are of higher obligation. To lose our country by a scrupulous adherence to written law, would be to lose the law itself, with life, liberty, property, and all those who are enjoying them with us; thus absurdly sacrificing the end to the means."

Thomas Jefferson to John Colvin, 1810

As noted, before confronting Marxianity directly, Democratic-Republicans will have to first fight an internecine civil war with the Republican Party establishment and another product of the Civil War; libertarians who evolved from the northern gentry.

The Libertarian and Conservative Aristocracy; Principal vs. Principle

"It is though we had wanted to add to the already existing proofs of God's Existence, a new and finally convincing one: the universal destruction that follows on assuming God's non-existence."

Americans are witnessing in real time the universal destruction Wilhelm Röpke and other greats such as Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn warned the west would occur when God was removed from the equation; without serious consideration the lessons of the past were disposed of in quick order leaving nothing to prevent venerable corporations like Disney from supporting Black Lives Matter then advancing homosexual and trans causes. And then there is Marquis de Queensbury republicans like Mitt Romney marching in the street with those who seek the destruction of the United States, unimpeded by the deafening silence of libertarians and the conservative aristocracy aka small 'r' republicans.

The principles, virtues and enlightenment ideas the founders stood for were torn asunder long before the Civil War fractured the nation, but the political parties Madison believed to be an unfortunate necessity took on an alien life form of their own after 1865. Republicans have at least been consistent in clinging to the critical importance of private property to freedom; aligning the party with business interests.

But without virtue and principle the measure of freedom was reduced to how free the market economy; a free market economy with a potentially fatal flaw that will have a corrective prescription in Pamphlet No.8

Democrats on the other hand have absolutely no foundation in principle and morphed into a shape shifting specter that can at once claim slavery, the KKK, segregationist Woodrow Wilson, racist FDR's New Deal, the administrative state...and a strategy that began in earnest in 1960 to implement a plan to "fundamentally change" the United States into a socialist state reaching its apex as these words are being written, and why these words are being written.

It was because the republicans were devoid of the founding principles beyond private property that an ideology that never really masked its intentions was able to run free given the free market preference to negotiate and contract at the expense of the principles, traditions and values intrinsic to the original Judeo-Christian civil religion of America. Culture has little value to libertarians.

Gramsci's strategy of cultural hegemony worked brilliantly when after 1960 the focus turned to an academia tasked with turning out young true believers to fill the agencies of government, and the media with journalists incapable of unbiased reporting. The last to fall was the Imaginarium which now courts the young with assurances sexual license, homosexuality and gender preference are badges of "progressive" enlightened thinking. Marxism on the left and libertarian capitalism on their right but still to the left of the Constitution...and neither one can admit HaShem exists.

"Untouched by the breath of God, unrestricted by human conscience, both capitalism and socialism are repulsive."
Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn

James Madison envisioned parties that would serve as a check on one another, never anticipating the result would be one and one-half party in a symbiotic relationship that excluded the people. But then again, Madison had no way of knowing an ideology, Marxism, would be so compelling that there would be Americans willing to quietly wait in the background for an opportunity to initiate a plan with the specific goal of eliminating the Constitution; an opportunity that came with the Depression and the Civil Rights Movement after which, in real terms, there were two constitutions, neither of which the founders would recognize, existing on the fringes either side of the original.

The willingness of republicans, small 'r' very much intended, to compromise principle reached an apex with the Kavanaugh confirmation hearings; an inflection point that drew indelible lines in the sand when Senator Feinstein withheld a specious accusation from established Senate procedures then at the last minute made an accusation and demanded the accused prove innocence; Kafkatrapping Napoleonic injustice writ large.

Rather than tell the Democrats 'no', violating senate procedures was unacceptable, the republicans compounded the violation by accommodating the accuser and denying the accused the right to face his accuser. Since 1965 republicans have been engaged in nothing more than a rear guard defense of an established "conservative" hierarchy, but the status quo has changed with the rise of populist nationalism led by Trump which Marxians branded "white supremacy"

Americans are beginning to rise but before this writing they had nowhere to go; the Republican Party hierarchy, conservative think tanks, publications, intelligentsia, commentariat and politicians would find it neigh on impossible to give up the warmth and comfort of the cesspool; a cabal unwilling to risk their comfort to engage in a holy war to defend the "Laws of Nature and of Nature's God" that undergird the Judeo-Christian civil religion, traditional American culture and founding principles of America.

"The theory of 'natural rights' depends upon the premise of an on alterable human nature bestowed upon man by God. Only acceptance of the divine order can give enduring freedom to a society; for this lacking, there is no reason why the strong and the clever, the dominant majority or the successful oligarch, should respect the liberties of anyone else. Freedom without the theory of natural rights becomes simply the freedom of those who hold power to do as they like with the lives of those whose interests conflict with theirs." Russell Kirk

Had Russell Kirk lived to see natural rights, unalienable rights, proven to be fact, not theory, I have no doubt the tone of his writings would be far less academic and far more confrontational...especially given the dominate majority has entered into an unholy alliance with corporations in the classic definition of fascism. Doubly so given the People's Republic of China is now a nationalist, race centered, fascist state one charismatic leader away from not so sui generis Nazism...with lebensraum a priority with the Belt and Road.

American oligarchs are betting China will soon surpass and one day defeat the United States and as such are hedging their bets with loyalty to the "great reset". Americans rail against "globalists" not realizing there is better term for the alliance between the nest of Democrat and republican vipers in Washington DC and the cosmopolitan libertarian boa constrictors pressing for open borders in both trade and people; neo-Marxists refer to the cabal as the transnational capitalist class (TCC) which includes, ironically, neo-fascist China. But because American and European denizens of Davos bear no allegiances the term '*citizen of the world*' as a pejorative is not only apropos but aligns with the inevitable end of multiculturalism leaving them stateless.

Citizens of the world; products of "transnational class formation" in the words of neo-Marxists to whom words are nothing but weapons, will rail and fight against the idea of a distinct American identity in that the industrial and financial aristocracy truly believe their world linked by technology and global markets has ascended above meaningless national identity and citizenship hence far too many of the leading firms such as General Electric, Chevron, and Amazon that had their start in America refuse to identify as American. Former CEO of AOL, Steve Case, even suggested immigrants were worthy replacements for the American working class; people who lost their futures to "transnational class formation".

Russell Kirk knew an economy lacking tempering unalienable rights enables mercenaries and extortionists to direct inordinate and unwarranted amounts of wealth to a smaller number of people every year to satisfy their lust for power, luxury and gratification at the expense of the average citizen.

"The libertarian thinks that this world is chiefly a stage for the swaggering ego; the (Democratic-Republican) finds himself instead a pilgrim in a realm of mystery and wonder, where duty, discipline, and sacrifice are required-and where the reward is that love which passeth all understanding." Russell Kirk, *The Conservative Mind: From Burke to Eliot*

An economy lacking the tempering effect attendant to the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God is a recipe for license; "bread and circuses" popular culture emphasizing sex and gratification of wants and needs nobody knew they had until Madison Avenue told them; wants and needs libertarian businesses stand in line to fulfill. It might be said economies are the most accurate gauge of the civic and moral health of a republic; the term "bread and circuses" was used by Roman poet Juvenal to describe the diet of distracting entertainment and welfare fed to the people by politicians of a Roman republic in decline.

"And Burke, could he see our century, never would concede that a consumption-society, so near to suicide, is the end for which Providence has prepared man. If a conservative order is indeed to return, we ought to know the tradition which is attached to it, so that we may rebuild society; if it is not to be restored, still we ought to understand conservative ideas so that we may rake from the ashes what scorched fragments of civilization escape the conflagration of unchecked will and appetite."

Russell Kirk, *The Conservative Mind: From Burke to Eliot*

Not one reasoned individual would argue against the importance of the market economy to freedom and it can be argued free markets have not only lifted billions from abject poverty but freed more people than religion and while true, libertarians would be hard pressed to sit across from Burke to debate the difference between liberty and license. Nature's economy dwells on an island or reason just off the coast of free market capitalism...and an ocean away from Marxism based upon a simple premise; not bread alone.

Libertarians will have a far more difficult time than most with the Constitution being exactly what the founders knew it to be; a covenant of freedom and liberty designed for a self-governing moral people providing the conditions necessary for every individual to pursue happiness...not "property" as George Mason would have it or inferred from Locke. Jefferson knew property without meaning and purpose was sterile and ephemeral, ergo the pursuit of property by wealth revealed the covetousness and mercenary nature of human beings disinclined to the moral guardrails of self-governance.

"We are ruled by mercenaries who feel no long-term obligation to the people they rule" wrote Tucker Carlson in the first chapter, 'The Convergence', of his 2018 book *'Ship of Fools'*. Michael Anton used the quote in his prescient essay *'Tucker's Right; The beginning of a new conservatism?'* to frame the plight of "...millions of apolitical Americans who feel—rightly—abandoned, even preyed upon, by the status quo" with nowhere to go and the possibility of a "new conservative movement" to replace the intellectually exhausted old following the lead of Carlson "inspiring and creating a new majority".

The release of *Ship of Fools* coincided with the draft distribution of *Not Peace but the Sword; the Convergence Matrix* in PDF to universities...and I would suggest 'coincidence' is God's way of remaining anonymous.

The conservative intellectual and philosophical old guard subscribe to a theoretical existence of God clinging to the "vapor trails of Christianity" AG William Barr spoke of in his speech at Notre Dame University; a perception that allows for far more latitude than the actual existence of God. But as it concerns libertarians there is one extremely insightful Anton observation; libertarians rightly view market forces to be a literal force of nature and as such standing in the way of Schumpeter's gale of creative destruction "must apply every bit as much to people, families, and societies as it did to the buggy whip industry".

Libertarians are in for a rude awakening beyond "woke" in that there are discernable high points in human ascendance that must be preserved and nurtured e.g. the Notre Dame Cathedral is far more than mere "brick and mortar". Libertarians embrace the Laws of Nature, but lacking even a whiff of the vapor trail libertarians ignore the higher truth of Nature's God; human beings are subject to the Laws of Nature but with sentience and the ability to calculate the effects of right and wrong, humans were lifted from the animal world to a place above nature where the truth, virtues and principles reside and must be protected from the gale in that not all destruction is creative.

"The natural law is an instrument for progress, not a weapon of revolution."

Russell Kirk, *The Roots of American Order*

That the "conservative" intelligentsia seemed to prefer theoretical compare and contrast arguments when defending the free market against Marxism rather than simply pointing out Marxism begins with theft of private property and never addresses producing wealth was perplexing...until I realized there is an entire generation receptive to organized crime. Of the 7 out of 10 eager to vote for socialism perhaps one is an actual Marxist while the other six simply like the idea of a socialist government seizing the wealth of others and redistributing it to the "oppressed" i.e. organized crime for the masses.

Those six now have a far greater problem than the hard working Americans doing the heavy lifting in flyover country who don't approve of the government supporting those who will not work. Every individual taking from the government what has been taken from hard working people by way of taxes when they are able to work is both coveting and stealing in violation of the Ten Commandments of a God getting closer every day.

"We have staked the whole future of American civilization, not upon the power of government, far from it. We've staked the future of all our political institutions upon the capacity of mankind for self-government; upon the capacity of each and all of us to govern ourselves, to control ourselves, to sustain ourselves according to the Ten Commandments of God."

James Madison: 1778

The words of James Madison must be far more than a statement of ultimate truth; the words must be adopted as the Democratic-Republican creed. The Ten Commandments must be reintroduced to the public square and taught in every school as history given the unassailable mathematics validating the matrices...and like unalienable rights all else will follow.

The spirit of America has a long tradition of hard work and communities taking care of each other but now it is rare for neighbors to actually know each other well enough to warrant an invitation to dinner; people have come to expect the government to solve every problem, but government is the problem as are libertarian republicans...and the God of Sinai the solution.

"On the way from the Renaissance to our days we have enriched our experience, but we have lost the concept of a Supreme Complete Entity which used to restrain our passions and our irresponsibility. We have placed too much hope in political and social reforms, only to find out that we were being deprived of our most precious possession: our spiritual life. In the East, it is destroyed by the dealings and machinations of the ruling party. In the West, commercial interests tend to suffocate it. This is the real crisis." Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn

Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn would appreciate the idea of Democratic-Republicans grounded in certitude as to the "Supreme Complete Entity" dedicated to renewing the spiritual life of America to reverse decades of social engineering and the political machinations of both parties; a reversal requiring guardrails for commercial interests to impress upon them self-governance requires a sense of morality and moderation they will no longer have the license to exclusively define for themselves.

Democratic-Republicans, like Jefferson, are a sect of their own; on their own after the collapse of the already widely dispersed conservative lines that followed the nomination and election of Trump. At the moment the center is intact, proudly flying the flags of populism, nationalism and constitutionalism with a large number of 'Don't tread on me' flags for good measure; patriots unwilling to compromise and as such Democratic-Republicans without yet knowing it. The ranks will fill quickly with populists having good reason to fight...an extant God of 1776 is no small thing.

The nature of the populism is best understood in the context of Victor David Hanson's *"Dueling Populisms"* but the nature of the right and left flanks distancing themselves from the center risks the whole; establishment libertarians and the conservative intelligentsia will have but this one chance to rethink their positions.

"No People can be bound to acknowledge and adore the invisible hand, which conducts the Affairs of men more than the People of the United States. Every step, by which they have advanced to the character of an independent nation, seems to have been distinguished by some token of providential agency." George Washington 1st Inaugural Address

On the left flank are libertarians utterly detached from the Adams admonition "Our Constitution was made only for a moral and religious people...it is wholly inadequate to the government of any other"; without the guardrails of moral conviction, individual self-governance and objective truth, society will decay into a tyranny of the majority, the mob, and finally anarchy unhindered by libertines who measure personal freedom by the degree of self-indulgent avarice they enjoy. Laws and regulations constitute the libertarian guardrails; minimal governance is not a matter of principle but rather license in that large corporations know regulations hinder up and coming competition and entrepreneurs.

On the right flank the aristocrats of the conservative intelligentsia dominated by the likes of Max Boot, David Frum, David French, Bill Kristol and George Will would rather compromise than soil their false pride; haughty intellectual snobs thus perfect targets for Alinsky's "Make the enemy live up to its own book of rules"; aristocratic intellectual elites that would rather die than support a judicial and policy juggernaut with bad table manners. As Victor David Hanson observed; Marquess of Queensberry Republicans would rather lose nobly than win ugly.

Perhaps a view from the higher vantage will give some perspective; all are being challenged to set aside all they know and think they know and think again as to why Trump was chosen. I would suggest his breaking the mold has revealed both Marxians and the conservative intelligentsia to have more in common than they are willing to admit...and for the ploughman caught in the middle of a maelstrom threatening his very existence the long neglected oracle of reason is beckoning. I would suggest that with the identity of the "God of Nature" no longer subject to debate, all have good reason begin the search for worthy Democratic-Republicans while reassessing all things.

"The (twenty-first century) conservative (should be) concerned, first of all, for the regeneration of the spirit and character – with the perennial problem of the inner order of the soul, the restoration of the ethical understanding, and the religious sanction upon which any life worth living is founded. This is conservatism at its highest."

Russell Kirk, *The Conservative Mind: From Burke to Eliot*

With the reintroduction of the God of Sinai presenting as pure intellect and reason demanding the same, the fear of God cannot be dismissed thus changing the equation from one of faith to one of certitude; there are scales and measures ignored at great personal risk including the Constitution as instruction and the elimination of race in favor of greater and lesser peoples and cultures...but never is the greater to be made less.

Table manners should be the least concern of elites that are now tasked with leading by first reestablishing the intellectual foundations created by the founders; the Constitution is nonnegotiable.

Between the flanks are the hardworking average Americans trying desperately to preserve a traditional way of life centered on family, community, Main Street and moral certitude; a Judeo-Christian America paid lip service by compromised libertarian and conservative wings that did nothing to impede the slow evisceration of the fundamental truths, principles, virtues, values and morals that bound American civil society together.

The amoral ethical infants of libertarianism would be hard pressed to develop a 'reset' button to fix the decay of American society or even where to begin; wealthy ethical infants ensconced in ivory towers in lockstep with open border multiculturalists...convinced free trade and technology is the answer to every illness.

Libertarians and the conservative aristocracy firmly believe politics is not well served by the perception of politics as a Manichean battle between the forces of light and darkness, but the matrices empirically evidence that is exactly the case and as such compromise with the darkness that is Marxianity is a luxury neither can afford. The time has come for libertarians and the conservative aristocracy to think in terms of *principle rather than principal* or lose all.

Now that the 2020 election has passed and Marxians are making clear their intentions, the flanks of the line will fill again with Americans who now have purpose, meaning and something to believe in; patriots who will appreciate the symbolism of reclaiming the title Democrat and Republican from those to whom words are just words in a political manifestation of E Pluribus Unum; Democratic-Republicans with a platform of solutions rather than just words to take the Republican Party from weak compromisers to an uncompromising party of principle so as to mount the massive retaliation necessary to defeat the fascist evil that is the false religion of intellectual arrogance Marxianity.

The entire republican establishment will have to make the same penultimate choice as every other American; the measures providing certitude as never before are nonnegotiable and as it concerns the battle ahead 'Lead, follow or get out of the way' applies to every republican heretofore willing to compromise so as to avoid a now unavoidable fight; Democratic-Republicans will no longer fold their arms and allow Marxianity to have its way.

Regardless of the voices to the contrary, the Anglo-Saxon Protestant and very Judeo-Christian civil religion undergirds all that is good about America and unless the courage to restore the civil religion is manifested the republic of Jefferson and Adams will not be realized and it, Shoah, can happen here.

"Courage is indispensable because in politics not life but the world is at stake."

Marxianity has prioritized divesting western civilization of its past with high revisionism and instilling the young with a sense of guilt sans any thought the past has redeeming value...with Marxian media and academia denigrating those who disagree as simplistic and blindly accepting proles; populists who long for an imaginary past that doesn't exist. To complete the strategy every past tradition, custom and virtue must be marginalized and framed as questionable. Never before have whole nations been so divorced from history with destruction of said history justifying the destruction of historic statues and monuments.

That Marxianity first attacked White Anglo-Saxon Protestants in the early 1960s and then western civilization as a whole shortly thereafter is clear evidence Marxians are not only influenced by the Satan but have intuitive understanding both where crafted to advance God's plan for human ascendance. Both are a greater people and culture designed to bring the United States, a nation of all nations, into being to serve as a beacon of freedom for mankind; reestablishing Israel and protecting her until Yeshua in 2026 Jerusalem. It really is that simple.

Arguments and narratives will be insufficient in the absence of a compelling reason to listen and act, hence the God of Sinai has let Americans know He will not sit on the sidelines; the choice between Marxianity and a Constitution bearing His personal imprimatur is nonnegotiable. The God of Sinai represents the argumentum a fortiori; the stronger argument worth fighting and dying for and there can be no compromise.

Of late Marxians have begun to project; claiming civil war is being contemplated by "domestic terrorists" and openly asserting the Constitution has failed as exemplified by an article titled "The Constitution Is Broken and Should Not Be Reclaimed" by law professors Ryan D. Doerfler of Harvard and Samuel Moyn of Yale. Neither is willing to concede the Constitution blocking the Marxian agenda is performing exactly as designed and talk of admitting new states, abolishing the Electoral College and packing the Supreme Court to circumvent the Constitution is a declaration of war that will be answered in no uncertain terms if they should be so bold.

The situation at hand is plain for all willing to open their eyes as exemplified the following excerpt from an article titled *A New Nationalism* by Joel Kotkin with the Claremont Institute.

Fortunately, America has revived itself before, albeit often later than would have been ideal. We freed ourselves from Britain through Hamilton's embrace of industrial development; Lincoln's development of credit systems, the Homestead Act, and the development of industries proved critical to defeating the slave economy of the south. Massive American production was critical in defeating Nazism and, over the ensuing four decades, under both parties, the United States managed to innovate and out produce the Soviet industrial state.

To be effective at countering that vast effort, a new American nationalism must transcend Donald Trump's often hyperbolic "America First" rhetoric. We are fighting a primarily economic war, not against ideological opponents like the USSR or Mao's China, but against leaders strategically motivated by imperial revanchism. In countering these autocratic moves, we cannot count on the United Nations, the European Union, or the globalist grandees of Davos. The current challenge can only be met by a national response on every level—from our increasingly weakened military, to our industrial and agricultural establishment—as well as an embrace of America's uniqueness and historic mission.

Yet sadly, the biggest obstacles to America's nationalist revival comes from the very people—top corporate executives—who once had an abiding self-interest in the prosperity and political support of the populace.

McKinsey's admonition to abandon American production reflects the profoundly denationalized globalism of the American establishment. Although the antics of Putin and Xi may make corporate America somewhat less enthusiastic about our current springtime for dictators, most U.S. firms seem unwilling to unplug from their autocratic attachments. Just last year saw the signing of Apple's astounding \$275 billion deal with Xi's regime, an agreement that grants China continued control of production while selling off advanced technology to the autocratic regime. Wall Street figures like Michael Bloomberg, Ray Dalio, Jamie Dimon of J.P. Morgan and Blackrock's Larry Fink, seem to see no contradiction between their craven progressive mutterings at home and China's brutal repression in Sinkiang or Hong Kong—not to mention the Middle Kingdom's greenhouse gas output, which totals more than the rest of the developed world combined.

The notion of a national response may be seen as heretical, to both traditional conservatives and many progressives, but conforms to deep strains in American history, starting with Hamilton, the nation's economic architect. As in his times, the challenge to our economy and political values can only be met by a national response on every level.

Ultimately, America can meet the challenges posed by the autocratic duopoly. But this can only occur if there's an emergence of a new national spirit, one that reflects our diversity and evolving society, but retains faith with our national experiment.

The oligarchs and corporatists, many of who made fortunes manipulating bits and bytes of binary logic, have chosen to battle the Creator of our binary existence. Marxians are known for creating lists of their enemies but few have seriously considered those who kneel only to God are equally adept at creating lists. Should Marxianity take to the streets in Gramsci's War of Maneuver to spill the blood of patriots the wealth those who have sided with Marxians will be forfeit bar none and everything done in the dark will be brought to the light. The end of days has arrived and it is as Yeshua warned "I did not come to bring peace, but a sword".

Unsheathing Yeshua's Sword

"Prudence, indeed, will dictate that Governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and accordingly all experience hath shewn, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed. But when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same Object evinces a design to reduce them under absolute Despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such Government, and to provide new Guards for their future security"

The words of Thomas Jefferson from the second paragraph of the Declaration of Independence are as valid today as they were in 1776 with the operative words in this instance being “...when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same Object evinces a design to reduce them under absolute Despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such Government”. The United States is a nation divided; to such an extent the term nation and definition of what entails a nation is subject to debate...and from the higher vantage the exact 50/50 split speaks to what all were told to expect in the end of days.

Consider the definition of a nation from an essay titled *Conservative Nationalism Is Not About Liberty* by Richard M. Ebeling for AIER:

---What defines a “nation”? In a famous lecture delivered in Paris in 1882, the French historian Ernest Renan (1823-92) asked that very question (“What Is a Nation?”). He devoted much time to explaining what were unsatisfactory answers to that question. Nations were not the product of historical dynasties; they were not based on “race,” because in the reality of Europe there were no “pure” or homogeneous racial or ethnic groups, in spite of what a number of German intellectuals were already claiming at that time. While language binds people together in an almost obvious way, it too has its limits in giving a complete answer; nor were religion or geography useful for a broad generalization.

Renan’s answer to the question was to suggest two elements, one that looks backward and the other that looks to the future: a heritage of a shared past and a consensual desire for continued shared community:

One is the past and the other is the present.... One is the possession in common of a rich legacy of memories; the other is present consent, the desire to live together, the desire to continue to invest in the heritage that we have jointly received.... These are the essential conditions of being a people: having common glories in the past and a will to continue them in the present; having made great things together and wishing to make them again....

It presupposes a past but is reiterated in the present by a tangible fact: consent, the clearly expressed desire to continue a common life. A nation’s existence is (please excuse the metaphor) a daily plebiscite, just as an individual’s existence is a perpetual affirmation of life.

The article continues:

Your country’s history is taught in government-run or -regulated schools. Your country’s “values” and belief systems are inculcated in the educational curricula of each nation-state. While loyalties, allegiances, and identifications with family, friends, and surrounding community members are, in a sense, inescapably “natural” — they are the immediate “worlds” in which we grow up, experience life, and go about living — nationality and a sense of nationalism are far more creations of the political authorities under which we respectively live.

In 2021 Biden Department of Education published 'Proposed Priorities – American History and Civics Education' which included guidelines for a grant program which called for "the development of culturally responsive teaching and learning" benefiting "underserved populations" in light of "the ongoing national reckoning with systemic racism [that has] highlighted the urgency of improving racial equity throughout our society, including in our education system."

Can there be any doubt as to why parents must take control of school boards? Can there be any doubt as to why small 'r' republicans incapable of forcefully challenging "equity" as a purely Marxist term for unconstitutional redistribution and reverse discrimination must be expunged from government?

"Human beings are born with different capacities. If they are free, they are not equal. And if they are equal, they are not free"

The mere fact that Marxianity seeks the destruction of the history of both America and western civilization is enough to unequivocally state it is they who are planning secession as part of the Marxian agenda and the prospects for peaceful resolution of differences is not the plan. The separation is readily apparent on an individual basis in that the Marxian Tik Tok lumpen identify with "autonomy" that demands rights without responsibility while rejecting the "Laws of Nature and of Nature's God" and the idea of a natural order.

Without the guardrails provided by God they are a rudderless mass susceptible to comfortable complacency and the demands of the mob; gaining meaning a purpose in creating Planned Chaos and the atheistic propensity to attack all things associated with an extant God. One would think those who subscribe would realize the ideology was the common thread binding the mass murderers of the 20th century. The autonomous individual tends to pursue an ever expanding definition of civil rights as defined by laws written most often by Marxian elites rather than moral absolutes...a mistake Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn warned against:

"At the present time it is widely accepted among lawyers that law is higher than morality—law is something which is shaped and developed, whereas morality is something inchoate and amorphous. This is not the case. The opposite is true: morality is higher than law! Law is our human attempt to embody in rules a part of that moral sphere which is above us. We try to understand this morality, bring it down to earth, and present it in the form of law. Sometimes we are more successful, sometimes less. Sometimes we have a mere caricature of morality, but morality is always higher than law. This view must never be abandoned."

With the God of Abraham/Sinai, Yeshua and 1776 no longer debatable certain aspects of the confrontation at hand can be set aside beginning with recognizing Marxianity has been identified as evil incarnate and then moving on to the long held fiction that "politics is downstream from culture" i.e. the Democratic Party is not "liberal" or "progressive" but

rather reactionary in extreme hearkening to Sir Henry Sumner Maine's 1861 classic *Ancient Law* which holds that every form of governance before the Constitution, a contract society, was and is a status society in which who you are determines government benefits. As to culture, the moral law of Sinai is inextricably bound to both the Constitution and American society; a greater people and culture.

Marxians are enemies of the Constitution and as such Democratic-Republicans will have to take a no holds barred approach to defeat them under the banner of certitude. Marxianity is dominated by deadly serious radicals within the ruling elites including "progressive" academics and law professors who are constantly shifting the cultural battle lines with new theories and victims to be opportunistically litigated; politics as an avocation that is supported by the media, tech oligarchs, corporations and now a weaponized federal bureaucracy...a cancer that first attacks the culture; a cancer requiring the antidote that is a strong dose of fear God.

There will be no change from the top down given small 'r' republicans refuse to confront what is a distinct and dangerous ruling class; they want to be part of it. It is in that truth one has an answer as to why bills are passed with republican leadership approval that fly in the face of wants and needs of the constituencies; small 'r' republicans are minority shareholders in a Leviathan dominated by Marxianity.

CommonSenseCession is meant to be an insurgency from the bottom up where Democratic-Republicans will have a voice in restoring the Constitution and establishing a Republic Jefferson and Adams would embrace.

Just as Thomas Jefferson's advice to his nephew Peter Carr establishes a starting point for individual conduct so too Michael Anton's definition of the intended Republic from his book *The Stakes; America at the Point of No Return*:

"Our founders sought to establish the weakest possible federal government capable of performing its essential functions, for three fundamental and intertwined reasons. First, government is inherently dangerous, so the less power it has, the better. Second, the states—being closer to the people and more responsive to regional differences and needs—are better equipped to handle most matters than a far-off centralized administration. Third, the states were prior to the federal government; the people, through their states, created the latter to serve them, not the other way around."

"According to the parchment, the federal government is supposed to field and fund an army and navy, protect the borders, make treaties, regulate foreign trade and interstate commerce, maintain a sound common currency...and that's about it."

The Yeshua's Sword Pamphlet series provides legislative answers issue by issue designed to starve and defang the Marxian beast and as such is only touched upon in passing herein. None of which will be possible unless American patriots find the courage to implement CommonSenseCession in the short time remaining before the end of human history as it is understood in 2026...at which time the only question remaining will be who stood in defiance and fought the evil that is Marxianity and who didn't.

Do you really believe G'td would leave evidence of existence and the needed definition of history in history simply to have the evidence ignored?

CommonSenseCession begins with capturing territory and minimizing the ability of Marxians to use allies in the financial services to coerce submission; move if possible to CSC states and if not to CSC counties and then close bank accounts beholden to New York financial services then open new accounts in CSC certified intrastate banks. When a majority is achieved, whether state or county, focus on taking control of county and city government with an emphasis on school boards and prosecutors.

Marxians have every intention of removing the most formidable obstacle to tyranny; the 2nd Amendment. All should realize that when the time comes to disarm Americans there will be no knocks on the door but rather closed bank accounts as Trudeau did to truckers until the weapons Google knows you have are turned in. In that one might better understand why severing ties to New York financial services is necessary.

The first order of business for states in CommonSenseCession must be aligned with the 2nd Amendment i.e. universal open or conceal carry and the formation of militias...including state laws authorizing militias to intervene to quell riots when the authorities cannot do so within 24 hours; intervention that includes the same qualified immunity extended to police officers.

CSC states would forbid federal law enforcement no matter what agency from investigating or operating within individual states unless approved by the state AG and accompanied by state law enforcement; the agencies would still be able to operate but a layer of constitutional oversight would be required. The next logical step would be reasserting the 10th Amendment: *"The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the States respectively, or to the people."* Doing so would require invoking the advice of Democratic-Republicans Thomas Jefferson and James Madison; nullification.

"Every State has a natural right in cases not within the compact (casus non faederis) to nullify of their own authority all assumptions of power by others within their limits. Without this right, they would be under the dominion, absolute and unlimited, of whosoever might exercise this right of judgment for them"
Thomas Jefferson

Nullification first reasserts “...the states were prior to the federal government; the people, through their states, created the latter to serve them, not the other way around” and holds as axiomatic that any law passed by congress that objectively violates the Constitution is void and of no effect. States in CommonSenseCession need only jointly declare a law passed by congress as null and void...rather than the piecemeal approach to nullifying immigration and drug laws as was done by Marxian states.

Laws, edicts and executive orders cannot be enforced if those tasked with enforcement refuse. Rebellion has a strong tradition in America as opposed to the worst in history who tried to justify their actions with “I was just following orders”. That is especially true at the state level as exemplified by county and city governments and even local sheriffs who refused to enforce Covid mandates. It can be said that one of the most important skills Americans must learn is the ability to confront those who make unconstitutional demands with disobedience; if there is a law or order in conflict with the Constitution one not only has a right but an obligation to disobey.

States such as California and Oregon can be equally tyrannical as the federal government and as such it is incumbent upon county and local government to interpose themselves between unjust laws and the people they serve. States can nullify federal laws and localities can nullify state laws to great effect if necessary.

In 1798 Jefferson and Madison wrote the Virginia and Kentucky Resolutions as the Democratic-Republican answer to John Adams Alien and Sedition Acts claiming that because these acts overstepped federal authority under the Constitution, they were null and void.

Thankfully John Adams was wise enough to let the Act die of its own accord given the alternative. James Madison warned “refusal to co-operate with the officers of the Union ... would present obstructions which the federal government would hardly be willing to encounter.” Madison was right in that coercing a state was then and is now an untenable option in that seizing state resources would be impossible as would jailing legislators, however the threat remains and as such states in CSC would be well advised to minimize ties with the federal government in the interim.

Prudence calls for CSC states to anticipate denial of service whether internet, accreditation or licensing by establishing back up plans.

With some irony the Marxian status society, the map of which hearkens back to feudal Europe, provides an answer to tyranny now that was enforced then by the poetically ironic Shire-Reeve; the keeper or chief of the County.
