# Pamphlets No.25 Liquidating the NATO Investment

"Every gun that is made, every warship launched, every rocket fired signifies in the final sense, a theft from those who hunger and are not fed, those who are cold and are not clothed. This world in arms is not spending money alone. It is spending the sweat of its laborers, the genius of its scientists, the hopes of its children. This is not a way of life at all in any true sense.

In December 2022 congress passed and the president signed the Fiscal 2023 National Defense Authorization Act into law allowing for a record \$816.7 billion for the Defense Department. The combined 2022 defense budget of the 30 NATO members was approximately \$1.2 trillion. Compare that number to Russian defense spending for 2023 which was increased to approximately \$84 billion...which means the only credible threat posed by Russia is its 5,977 nuclear warheads on 1,588 missiles versus 5,428 American warheads on 1,644 missiles. It is madness but it is the reason why MAD, Mutual Assured Destruction, has prevented WWIII to this point.

Aside from the growing number of proxy wars, Russia and NATO know there will not be large a combined arms army crossing borders especially given that even without nuclear weapons doing so would be suicide given the proliferation and sophistication of smart weapons and real time surveillance. China has a 3.5 million strong military but it is virtually confined to China proper in that to project force in any meaningful way would require extended and vulnerable lines of communication...and the threat of nuclear weapons to protect them. MAD which begs the question 'Is winning a war even possible in the thermonuclear age?'

With the end of human history as it is understood less than four years hence the time has come to negotiate the disposal of nuclear weapons and rethink the cost/benefit of massive and unsustainable defense budgets while liquidating investments such as NATO for real peace and stability. One need only take a closer look at the military industrial complex in the United States Eisenhower warned about to start the negotiations. The following are excerpts from an article titled '\$858 billion defense budget will still produce a 'hollow force' by Harlan Ullman for The Hill, December 2022:

How is it possible that \$858 billion is not enough for defense? In the defense world, inflation is running at about 8-10 percent. Uncontrolled internal real annual cost growth in the Pentagon is between 5-7 percent absent inflation. Unless annual defense increases of about 13-17 percent are approved just to stay level, the force will shrink in size and capability.

Uncontrolled cost growth is caused by the extraordinary technological advances that are increasingly expensive in order to deliver far greater military capability and for the exploding expense of an all-volunteer force. Salaries, bonuses and medical care are likewise increasing at double-digit rates. And weapons systems are far from cheap.

Each Ford Class nuclear aircraft carrier costs about \$15 billion, and that does not include its air wing and escorts. The new Columbia class of ballistic submarines is approaching that cost per ship and does not include the costs of new ballistic nuclear missiles. An F-35 costs about \$100 million; the B-21 Raider at least \$800 million and that will likely grow.

With a total of about 2.8 million uniform, civilian and reserve personnel in the Department of Defense (DOD), the average annual cost per person is about \$300,000. That is substantially higher than in any other large entity or business. Can it be sustained?

Recruiting and retaining both military and civilian personnel in the DOD are in crisis. Given the standards for military service, less than one-third of the potential cohort of people aged 17-30 is available for military service. Only one in eleven aged 17-25 expresses a willingness to serve in uniform. As a result, the Army is 30,000 short in this year's recruiting goals.

The Air Force and the Navy are in similar trouble. And social issues, from abortion restrictions to wrongful allegations of a "woke" military as well as reports of suicides and sexual assaults, have hurt recruiting.

Even more disconcerting are policy makers that ignore the advice given by President George Washington in his farewell address to the nation; avoid foreign entanglements and permanent alliances. Washington realized that there would be times alliances would be necessary but they should have an end date after accomplishing the reason for said alliances in the first place. The address is all but forgotten but worth the read given Washington's advice was well taken for 152 years and the United States would not form a permanent alliance until NATO in 1949.

NATO was formed to counter the threat posed by the Soviet Union which came to an end when the Soviet flag was lowered and the Russian tricolor was raised on the entirely apropos December 25<sup>th</sup> 1991, but rather than close shop the alliance grew with a number of Warsaw Pact countries and one time Soviet Republics, including the Baltic countries, joining what would morph into a nation building organization; making the world "safe for democracy" which the League of Nations and United Nations failed to do.

If one rightly thinks the thousands of aforementioned nuclear weapons is madness, consider the fact that when the USSR fell the soviets had 39,000 and the United States 25,000. Faced with the prospect of losing control of even one nuclear weapon, the detonation of which would alter the psyche of mankind, scientists came to a conclusion UC Davis professor of management science and engineering Clifton B. Parker ascribed to Siegfried Hecker in a must read article titled *Why the Soviet nuclear arsenal stayed secure as the nation collapsed*: "We arrived in the nuclear century all in one boat, and a movement by anyone will affect everyone...Therefore, you know, we were doomed to work together to cooperate."

And cooperate they did per the Center for Arms Control and Proliferation: "The Strategic Arms Reduction Treaty (START I), signed in 1991, was a bilateral arms control treaty between the United States and the Soviet Union. The result of the agreement was the first significant reduction in the number of strategic nuclear weapons in both the U.S. and the Soviet stockpiles. It entered into force in 1994, after the Soviet Union's dissolution, and eventually expired in 2009. The treaty is considered one of the most successful arms control agreements because by the time of its full implementation in 2001, 80 percent of all the world's strategic nuclear weapons were dismantled."

START I expired in 2009 and was followed by The New Start Treaty which entered into force in February 2011 and which will expire, ironically, in February 2026; the text of which can be found on the Department of State website. It remains a mystery as to why the United States and the new Russian Federation did not announce publically from the beginning that the goal was the total elimination of nuclear weapons in four ten year increments rather than reduction...given a single detonation would likely lead to WWIII.

What few realize goes to what was done with the highly enriched nuclear material salvaged from the thousands of warheads very much in line with profitable at every level of cooperation; the highly enriched uranium was diluted for use in nuclear power plants in the concurrent Megatons to Megawatts commercial agreements.

As to why the cooperation ceased I would posit the rapid expansion of NATO membership that can count the Baltic States and Poland as members on the very border of the Russian Federation was the reason.

Now with the war in Ukraine, Sweden and Finland are in the process of joining NATO which will further aggravate the Russian Federation. Doing so would be a statement but it would not add to security, it would increase the chances of "foreign entanglements" when the EU and NATO has a few internal problems of its own; tensions are rising in the Balkans between Serbia and Kosovo with echoes of the Bosnian war still ringing in the ears of Europeans...and then there is Turkey constantly threating war with fellow NATO member Greece.

But it is the Turkish threat posed to Israel that in turn poses the greatest threat to NATO; Israel is America's very purpose unto God and the case must be made to liqudate the NATO investment...to eliminate nuclear weapons, end Putin's expansionist ambitions and insure the security of Israel against all who plot her demise.

Did you know that after the fall of the USSR the United States removed 40 of the 90 B-61 tactical nuclear bombs from Incirlik AFB Turkey but 50 remain? There is no reason for the bombs or US forces to remain at Incirlik and yet they do...vulnerable to seizure and a safety net hostage situation if Islamist Erdogan chose to do so.

### The EU Fast Reaction Forces and the Islamic Army

According to the European Union Diplomatic Service website the EU is developing a Rapid Deployment Capacity:

The European Union supports peace and stability in its neighbourhood and beyond. As a credible and capable actor in international crisis management, the EU needs to be able to react to conflicts quickly, robustly and effectively. To that end, the EU will develop a Rapid Deployment Capacity (EU RDC) consisting of up to 5000 troops. This EU RDC will be a robust, flexible and scalable military instrument adding to the EU's broad crisis management toolbox.

EU Military Committee chair, Gen. Claudio Graziano said the "...force will also have strategic enablers that have in the past normally been provided by the United States—for example, command and control structures, strategic airlift, strategic transport, intelligence surveillance and reconnaissance capabilities, cyber defense, unmanned air vehicles, space communication assets, electronic warfare systems, anti-missile defense, and I hope in the near future main battle tanks and next-generation fighter jets."

The Biden administration envisions a force to complement NATO independent of the US but I would suggest the proposed force is a reflection of the "diversity" being shoved down the throat of the American military i.e. up to 27 different countries contributing troops with all speaking different languages. In addition, such a force may well be subject to attacks that trigger NATO Article 5 thus drawing the US into a foreign entanglement.

The EU is populated by overwhelmingly Marxian politicians in tune with Washington DC. In NATO one will find common cause between "realist progressives" and "neocons" who believe in militarized social engineering projects; expanding "democracy" in places not ready such as Iraq and Afghanistan. The ever more fascistic regime benefits both financially and in terms of expansive power from a status quo that has dominated NATO for 74 years i.e. a military industrial complex extending opportunity to politicians and staff officers when they leave government service which by extension translates to geopolitical power via existing institutions. For 74 years American taxpayers have paying for the"... corrupt bargain between Washington elites and the regimes of Europe" per an article titled "NATO: Our International Welfare Queens" by Ryan McMaken for Mises.

How is it that after the end of the cold war NATO, a "collective" security organization, has American taxpayers paying over 70% of the \$1.2 trillion annual cost of the organization? Worse yet, the vast majority of members benefit hugely from American protection while at the same time any one of the 26 minor contributors have the potential of dragging the United States into a major conflict given Article 5 which states an attack on one is an attack on all.

With all the saber rattling around the Russian invasion Ukraine the Baltic countries Lithuania, Estonia and Latvia joined with Slovenia in calling for a no-fly zone which would be a de facto act or war against Russian as would the Polish sleight of hand that would have Mig-29 fighters transferred to Ukraine using US airbases then have the vacuum filled by American F-16s.

It is as Ryan McMaken wrote: "...the idea that these countries offer any sort of strategic advantage to the US in terms of defending vital American interests is implausible. The current war in Ukraine has well illustrated just how weak the Russian regime is in terms of projecting power anywhere beyond its immediate neighbors. The idea that Poland and Estonia serve as valuable "buffer states" between the US and a second-rate power like Russia is hardly convincing. These NATO members are simply not critical allies. Rather, they are net liabilities that may even end up forcing an escalation that draws the US into a war with another nuclear-armed power. The US's pledge to defend Eastern Europe through organizations like NATO can at best be described as a form of humanitarian aid for member states that have nothing to offer in terms of vital American geopolitical benefits."

It would probably shock Americans to know that a majority of Europeans consider the United States the foremost threat to world peace...as do a majority of American college students.

The perception is one of a narcissistic superpower wherein the elites have come to believe it is possible to democratize people and governments when an opportunity arises regardless of the lessons of history; most governments now and across history have been status societies of lesser peoples and cultures. The ranks of enlightenment thinkers understood the social, cultural, spiritual and economic conditions had to be right in that a democracy in very real terms is demanding; self-governing citizens are integral to governance not factorum.

"[Without becoming] familiarized with the habits and practice of self government...the political vessel is all sail and no ballast." Thomas Jefferson to Henry Dearborn, 1822

Democracy does not guarantee the election of democratic leaders as evidenced by Hitler in Germany, Chavez in Venezuela, the Muslim Brotherhood in Egypt and Recep Erdoğan in Turkey who is incrementally moving the nation toward an Islamic republic and increasing ties with Russia. Turkey is the only Islamic country in NATO and with the events in Syria Erdogan not only threatened to flood Europe with more than six million new refugees but thumbed a nose at the efforts to protect America's Kurdish allies which had the effect of exposing the inherent weakness of NATO and the EU; self-interest revealed the alliance to be one of convenience that has a potential fatal flaw in the Turkish membership.

Trump was blasted by the establishment for leaving an ally, the Kurds, to be decimated by another ally, Turkey, when he withdrew American troops. None of the establishment intellectual elites stopped to consider Turkey could have simply rolled over those troops then make an excuse knowing Trump would not risk war with a NATO "ally", after which the chattering class would have condemned Trump for not getting the troops out of harm's way. The hubris is telling given Biden left thousands of actual allies in Afghanistan and botched the withdrawal.

Trump then attempted a deal that shocked the establishment but he did so for a reason; Trump was setting the stage for a far more important deal; ejecting Turkey from, and reassessing the very reason for, NATO. It is no secret Turkish President Recep Erdogan considers Israel the primary cause of Middle East unrest, has equated Israel to Nazi Germany and is working behind the scenes to advance the idea of an Islamic army to confront Israel once and for all.

A March 2018 article by Dr. Alon Ben-Meir titled "Army Of Islam": Erdogan's Plot Against Israel reveals stunning details that rank high on Hitler scale i.e. take them at their word:

Less than a month ago, in advance of the summit of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) in Istanbul, the Turkish daily *Yeni Şafak*, which is considered one of the mouthpieces of Erdogan and his ruling Justice and Development Party (AKP), published an article entitled "A Call for Urgent Action." The same article was also published on the newspaper's website with the more explicit title, "What if an Army of Islam was Formed Against Israel?" The article openly called on the 57 member states of the OIC to form a joint "Army of Islam" to simultaneously attack Israel from the east, west, north, and south. According to Israel's Shin Bet, the source of the article appears to be the Turkish company SADAT, which among other sinister plots is aiding Hamas with funds and military gear to create a "Palestinian" army to join in the fight against Israel.

The idea of creating an "Army of Islam" to destroy Israel was accompanied by an interactive map providing formation of military forces for a joint Muslim attack on Israel. It also provides details on military forces based in various locations and the role they can play to execute their scheme.

SADAT International Defense Consultancy was founded in 2012 by Adnan Tanriverdi; retired lieutenant general, Islamist and Erdogan's chief military advisor. Tanriverdi has said "With very pure and decent feelings, we just want to transfer the experiences of our armed forces to Islamic countries. That is all. We also want the Islamic countries to get united" but in truth SADAT is no different than any other Islamic front organization; having been accused of arming and funneling cash to Hamas. Like Obama's UN Ambassador Samantha Power, who suggested an armed force in Gaza under the auspices of the Responsibility to Protect (R2P) doctrine, Tanriverdi has said "The states whose peoples are Muslim should either protect Palestine with their own armed forces or form a modern armed force for Palestine to deal with Israel."

While Tanriverdi's goal of uniting the 57 Islamic countries and forming an army may sound like a pipe dream to western politicians it is a dream shared by Erdogan; it is a dream that is designed to openly challenge the United States with the ultimate target being Israel...which explains the 'enemy of my enemy is my friend' alliance with Marxianity which has opened the door to the mass migration to Europe created by Obama in 2011. Islamists are not shy about the goal of transforming Europe into an Islamic entity, and for the first time less than 50% of people in England identify as Christian...but politicians are terrified to speak truth to Marxianity.

#### **Unchaining the Foolish Giant**

Most are familiar with Imaginarium depictions of mountain climbers roped together in a "rope team" designed to save the team if an individual should a slip or fall but the downside is a single member may very well pull the rest into the abyss. In foreign policy parlance as it relates to mutual defense the term is "chain-ganging" i.e. a minor member of the mutual defense treaty pulls the obligated members into the abyss of war. With the never ending expansion of NATO the chances of the US being pulled into WWIII increases exponentially.

What a tangled web we weave. Sweden and Finland are pressing for NATO membership and on the way both sought clarification of Article 42.7 of the European Union's founding Lisbon Treaty which states that should any EU member come under attack the entire membership is obligated to "aid and assist by all the means in their power" thus chain-ganging the US to a conflict that does not include a NATO member e.g. Sweden or Finland initiate hostilities for whatever reason or comes under attack by Russia the EU would be bound to assist which would in turn create a NATO Article 5 situation obligating the United States to defend.

The response of Sweden and Finland to the war in Ukraine though irrational is not without good reason after the Russian seizure of Georgian territory and Crimea; like the Russian population taught for decades NATO is an existential threat so too Russia in the eyes of the west. Swedish and Finish neutrality has worked well for two countries in no real danger of Russian aggression and in very real terms Britain, Germany and France alone are well capable of negating a Russia that is a shadow of the former USSR including a nuclear umbrella. Very few take the time to consider California's GDP at \$3.1 trillion is more than twice the GDP of Russia and yet lags behind Germany's nominal GDP of \$4.22 trillion.

Rather than be taken aback by the virtually unopposed Russian invasion of Georgia and Crimea the citizens of Sweden and Finland would be well advised to consider the self-evident truths revealed by the Russian debacle that is the invasion of Ukraine. Putin vastly overestimated the Russian ability to project power beyond its own borders and vastly underestimated the ability of Ukraine to fight a proxy war with western support...which has now exceeded the approximately \$80 billion Russian defense spending for 2022. In addition, the war in Ukraine has revealed the Russian military to be inept on the whole and deficient as to specifics; equipment is poorly maintained, troop morale is an existential threat, corruption is endemic, Soviet style planning and decision making is failing and training is utterly insufficient.

The bottom line is that Russia lacks the economic base and material requisites to conduct a war of choice let alone necessity without even factoring the effect of sanctions. Europe no longer needs NATO and the United States no longer needs foreign entanglements that could potentially lead to a world war with Turkey at the top of the list.

The members of NATO are coming to realize that Turkey is a major liability not just because it controls the immigration valve but because Islamists like Erdogan, who called for an Islamic army to confront Israel and in 2020 decided the Hagia Sophia would once again be a mosque, has no doubt considered contingency plans calculating the cost/benefit of creating a false flag operation forcing Israel to respond in a way made to look aggressive precipitating a NATO Article 5 confrontation i.e. the United States will be forced to choose between NATO and Israel which America cannot do.

The first order of business is the removal of US forces and the 50 B-61 tactical nuclear bombs from Incirlik so as to deny Islamist Erdogan the ability to blackmail the United States as Islamists are wont to do. Erdogan once said "We have Israel nearby, as almost neighbors. They scare (other nations) by possessing these. No one can touch them". Doing so would be concurrent to removing all tactical nuclear weapons from Europe where they are not wanted under the auspices of the Swords to Ploughshares Treaty.

#### **Swords to Ploughshares Treaty**

NATO is the largest, wealthiest, most successful and most powerful alliance in history and not to be traded away lightly. Provisions of the Swords to Ploughshares Treaty are as follows:

- 1. NATO would agree to terminate the alliance/organization within one year after the signing of the Swords to Ploughshares Treaty by the United States, Russia, PRC, UK and France.
- 2. All American military personnel would be withdrawn from Europe within six months of termination and bases turned over to the host countries with material/equipment transfer at the discretion of the US in consultation with the host country.
- 3. Signatories would withdraw all warheads from the territories and countries outside their own borders and agree to never again forward position warheads in host countries.
- 4. Russia would relinquish Georgian and Crimean territories taken by force and withdraw all troops from, and aid to, separatist Ukraine.
- 5. Russia would agree to respect the independence and established borders of counties that once belonged to the Soviet Union in perpetuity.
- 6. The signatories would be required to declare and quantify their nuclear arsenals within 30 days including yield, type and delivery system.
- 7. The signatories would within 90 days prepare plans for downsizing ICBM and SLBM capabilities.
- 8. Signatories with ongoing nuclear weapons programs would be required to cease development and thereafter transition to programs restricted to downsizing warheads, increasing accuracy and safety issues.
- 9. Signatories would agree to warhead arsenals of no more than 100.
- 10. Signatories would agree to reduce the yields of 60% of arsenal warheads to 2KT.
- 11. Signatories would reduce the yields of the remaining 40% to no more than 5KT.
- 12. Signatories would agree to remove cities from targeting lists, with the exception of large military facilities within 10 miles of city centers targeted with no more than 2KT warheads.
- 13. Signatories would agree to cease all trade with Iran and North Korea until their nuclear weapons have been destroyed and their programs ended.

The young have been taught the world is going to end with a climate change Armageddon within years or decades but they seem to be unconcerned about thousands of nuclear weapons that could potentially destroy human civilization within an hour. It is no coincidence the Saudis are the guardians of the Kaaba in Mecca; the House of Saud has been chosen to lead in the creation the great Ishmaelite nation *Ishmael*.

For 150 years the idea of Pan-Arabism slammed itself against the Ottoman Empire and then the imperial designs of England and France, but not once did the advocates set aside their Arab identity in favor of one that would have united the people; the people are more Ishmaelite than Arab or Islamic despite what the clerics may say or want and the nation of Ishmael will appeal to people craving for definition that cuts across tribal lines.

Ishmael predated Islam by over 2000 years and the heart of hearts, the heart and soul, of an Ishmaelite still feels the pain of rejection and would do whatever is necessary to prove worthiness to the God of Abraham...now possible with a great Ishmaelite nation living at peace with Israel.

The House of Judah Christian America in partnership with the House of Israel and the House of Saud would move heaven and earth to realize the great Ishmaelite nation promised in Genesis 17:20 by first negotiating the 150 mile federal district on the Mediterranean starting with Hatay province; a vision of the future and a home for Arabs from Gaza, the West Bank and those inside Israel brave enough to accept their destiny.

What was sorely missed was the opportunity to identify and define Islamic Jihad as the enemy. The effort to this day is one of politically correct constraints and rules of engagement that do very little to attack the causation and the political structure behind Islamic Jihad.
