HUMAN RIGHTS STATEMENT



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INTRODUCTION

This statement affirms our established commitment to human rights and our commitment to contribute towards the Sustainable Development Goals. We believe that respecting human rights and contributing to the realisation of rights is not only critical to the sustainable operation of our business, it informs our purpose. LiteHaus International's programs tackle digital inequality as a form of poverty. Every person has a right to education. However, a quality education can only be a digital education in today's world as so much of the human experience takes place across a digital lifesphere. As such, we perceive digital access as a fundamental human right and commit to advocating for recognition of this right. The digital world belongs to everyone and we firmly support the principle that the same fundamental human rights which exist in the physical should co-exist in the digital ecosystem.

To act on these commitments, we comply with applicable laws and regulations of the countries in which we operate, and where differences exist between Our Code of Conduct (Our Code) and local customs, norms, rules or regulations, we apply the higher standard. We operate in a manner consistent with the United Nations (UN) Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights.
