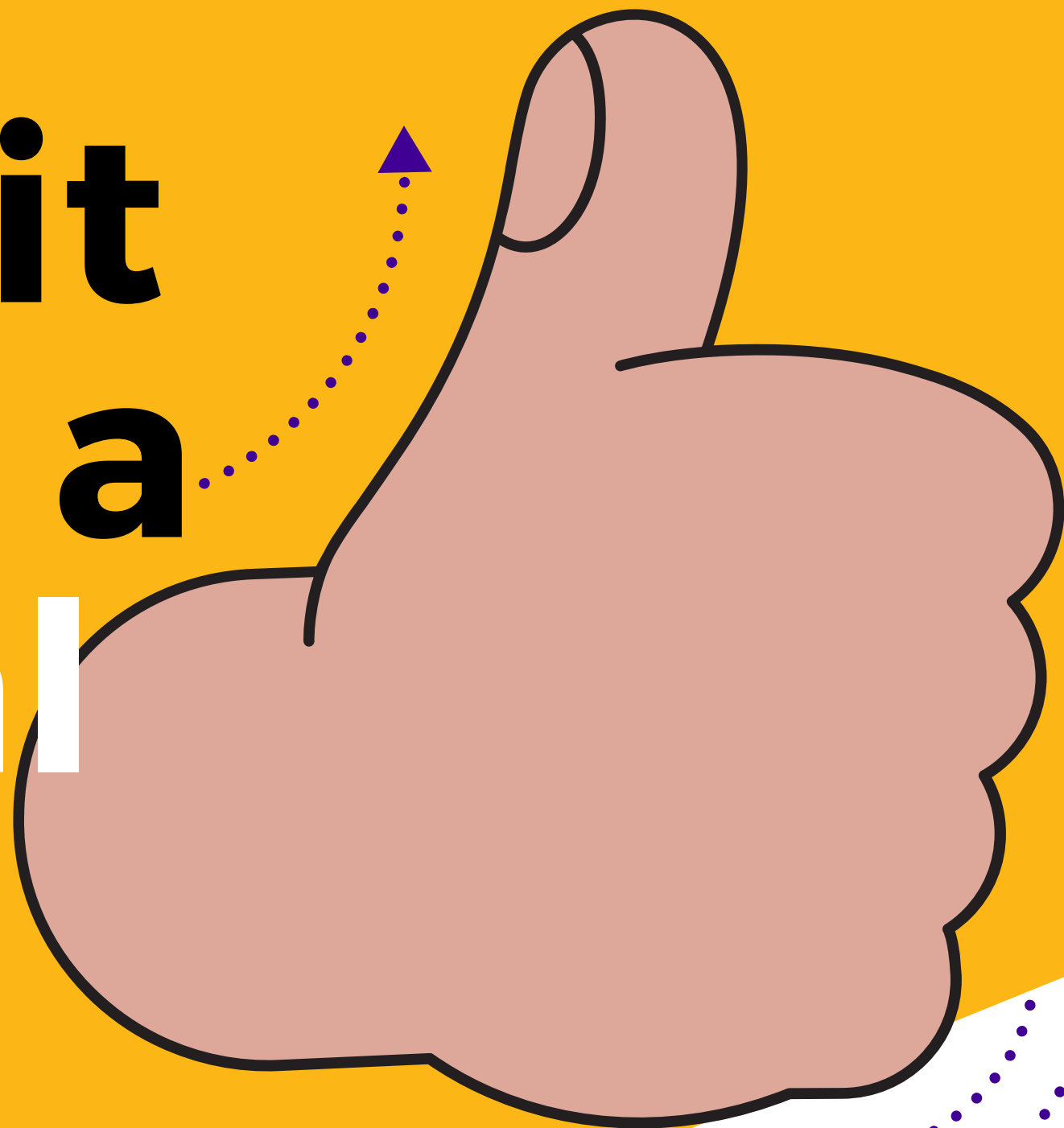

Being a good digital citizen is important, it means you set the standard for others.

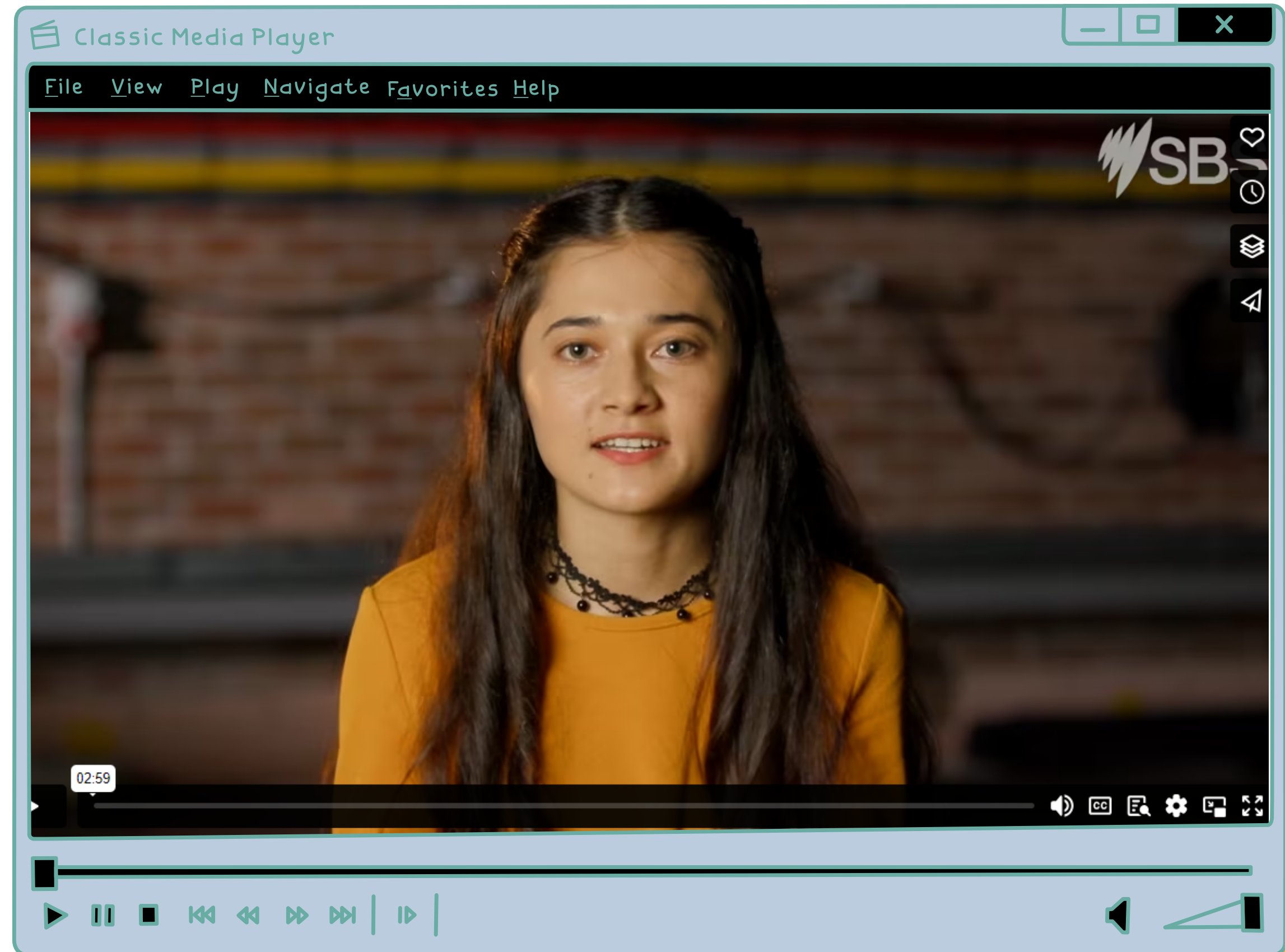
You are showing them how they too can be good digital citizens, it means you also become more aware.
