

## **GUIDELINES FOR TENNIS DURING COVID-19:**

Following Santa Cruz County Public Health\* and tennis industry-wide guidelines for continued play during this time, here are strict social distancing and hygiene practices implemented on this private court:

\*Dated 5/4/20 by the office of Dr. Gail Newel, Health Officer of Santa Cruz County at 831-454-4242 These orders are subject to change.

\*Maintain strict social distancing of 6' or more at all times, including players, coach and parents.

\*Coach's on-court roll is instructional only.

\*Ensure that all participants wash/sanitize hands before and after tennis sessions. Hand-sanitizer and paper towels are provided on-court.

\*Limit tennis activities to private and semi-private lessons (up to 4 players) only. Exception: jr. camp.

\*No-ball-touching or equipment sharing. Coach will feed balls, start rallies and/or utilize the ball machine so as to eliminate any ball handling by students.

\*If students wish to serve, they should bring their own, labeled balls, pick them up and take them home.

Alternatively, use a glove (provided).

\*Benches, chairs, ball tubes or any other surfaces that one might touch shall be disinfected after use.

\*Payment may be made on-line (Venmo, PayPal) or by check/cash left at the net post.

\*The gate will be left partially ajar so that players don't need to use handles to enter or exit.
