INVOCATION / CONFESSION

Pastor: In the Name of the Father who created us, the + Son who was born to save us, and of the Holy Spirit who brings us to know Christ and keeps us in the faith.

People: Amen.

Pastor: God's Word tells us that "*in the beginning God created the heavens and the earth*" and all that is within them.

People: And God saw that it was very good — in fact, it was perfect.

Pastor: But the "very good" world was soon to be desecrated by sin. Our first parents Adam and Eve took some of the fruit from the tree that God told them not to touch and ate it. In Adam we have all sinned, and like Adam we will all die. Sin, sorrow, suffering and death had come into the world.

People: We, too, suffer from the sins we have committed, sins of thought, word and deed; things that God has told us to do that we haven't done, and things that God has told us not to do that we have done.

Pastor: These sins separate us from God just as the sin of Adam and Eve separated them from their Creator God. Confession of these sins is the first step of God cleansing our souls and forgiving us in Christ. We admit and bring our sins before God now.

WORD OF FORGIVENESS

Pastor: Yet there was hope. Even in the garden, God cursed the serpent and promised the woman: "*I will put enmity between you and the woman, and the woman and between your offspring and hers; He will crush your head, and you will strike His heel.*"

People: When the time was right, God sent His Son, born of a woman, Born under the law to redeem those under the law. When the time was right, God did it. He brought His plan into action. He brought us righteousness. He gave us Jesus.

Pastor: By Jesus' birth, His perfect life, and His death on the cross, He has crushed the serpent's or Satan's head. Jesus has crushed and defeated Satan and death.

People: Amen!

THE CENSUS

Luke 2:1-5






A CHRISTMAS BLESSING
