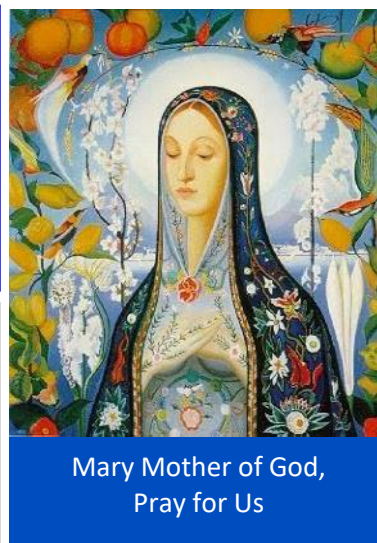

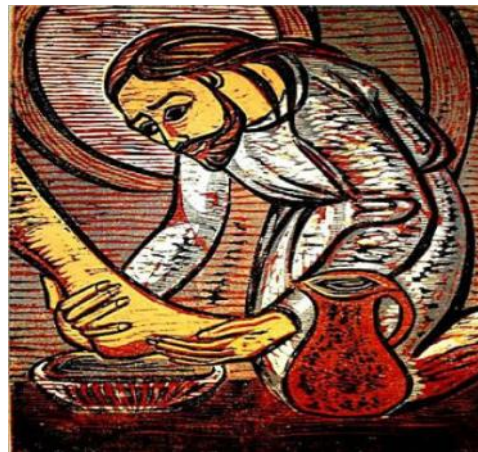

Does Loving Your Enemies Mean We Are Also To Forgive Them? Part 9

Nothing of true and lasting worth comes easily or without effort. This is true for ‘those who are persecuted for righteousness sake’. The disciple discerning the will of God in her or his heart, will not always foresee how or when an attack against their person will occur. In part, it is because they have no desire to prepare themselves for it, other than to love God and their neighbour, as instructed by Jesus. Nor do they see this persecution as a means to somehow elevate them to a more privileged relationship with God. Rather, this moment is a potential turning point away from hard heartedness and narrow mindedness, to now being of humble and contrite heart towards the self and the other.

If the disciple has been taken up into God’s Righteousness (Truth-Justice-Peace), now becoming the very core of their being, then their sole desire is to reveal this presence to the world, not as a choice, but as a loving command. It is not merely for their own good and wellbeing that they do this, but it is for the good and wellbeing of all creation. Keep in mind, God’s Righteousness is unsettling both for the bearer of it, and to anyone to whom is so blessed to be a witness of it. If the disciple is able to continually embrace God’s Righteousness, (the life and will of the Kingdom of God), then a deeper and more profound respect grows for the other, even if they are presently being insulted or persecuted by them.

Persecution is neither a reward nor a punishment for doing God’s will, but an illusory obstacle that presently prevents the other from receiving the Kingdom of God into one’s heart. The disciple needs to remember, any and all forms of violence are the futile attempts of those who were once powerful, successful and in control, have now become the powerless, scared and defeated. Sadly, they are unable or unwilling to accept this new reality, and so they fight. Receive what the other has to offer and in return, share with them what they need, the Kingdom of God, which means no harm to the other, but is a path to liberation. pah
