GUADETE SUNDAY!!!

The third Sunday of Advent is called "Gaudete Sunday" because the Mass for today (in its original Latin text), begins with the opening antiphon: "Gaudete in Domino semper" -"Rejoice in the Lord always." To remind ourselves that we are preparing for the very joyful occasion of the birth of Jesus, we light the rose candle in the Advent wreath, and the priest may wear rose vestments. The common theme of the day's Scripture readings is one of joy and encouragement. The readings urge us to make the preparations required of us as we await the rebirth of Jesus in our hearts and lives. Holy Scripture reminds us that the coming of Jesus, past, present, and future, is the reason for our rejoicing.

Henri J. M. Nouwen in his book *Peace: Prayer, Resistance, Community* has this to say about the joy of the Lord being our strength: "Jesus promises joy; a joy like the joy of a mother after childbirth, a joy that no one can take away from us; a joy that is not of this world but a participation in the divine joy, a joy that is complete. There is probably no surer sign of a true peacemaker than joy" (pg.79). This joy has guided John the Baptist in his witness to the Lord. And Jesus himself commends and rejoices with John in his courageous witness to the world on his behalf.

Deep down within, what makes your joy at this time? The little book, Advent and Christmas - A Wisdom from G. K. Chesterton compiled by Thom Satterlee and Robert Moore-Jumonville has something on the Doctrine of Conditional Joy. "For the pleasure of pedantry I will call it the Doctrine of Conditional joy", they write, "The note of the fairy utterance always is, "You may live in a palace of gold and sapphire, if you do not say the word 'cow"; or "You may live happily with the King's daughter, if you do not show her an onion." The vision always hangs upon a veto. All the dizzy and colossal things conceded depend upon one small thing withheld. All the wild and whirling things that are let loose depend upon one thing that is forbidden." For us, it is the blessed restraint. Happy are those who do not follow the advice of the wicked, or take the path that sinners tread, or sit in the seat of scoffers, Psalm 1:1-3

Advent joy is rooted in the blessed restraint. Self-restraint presents potential for deep joy. Identify the one "luxury" in your life right now you depend on most for comfort (what is it you think most about?). For some of us it is coffee, chocolate, or alcohol. For others it may more subtle (popularity) or more insidious (power). Whatever it is that you are depending on, fast from it this week for at least two days. Calling out to God to fill you with his Spirit of joy whenever you notice it missing. The experience of a real joy is a sure sign that God is with us and a sure help as we work toward readying ourselves for Christ's coming. Don't be discouraged. Rejoice today and move forward. Jesus rejoices in us as he thanks his Father for the gift of each and every one

Lord, thank you for the presence of joy in my life. Give me the presence of mind to be thankful for all the gifts you have given me and the fullness of heart to enjoy the rest of Advent. Amen Fr. Dominick
