

#### HE TAUGHT THEM AS ONE HAVING AUTHORITY

At the beginning of Jesus' public ministry, St. Mark tells us that Jesus enters the synagogue and teaches as one having authority. But he does not tell us what precisely Jesus is teaching. Instead, he narrates that Jesus expels an unclean spirit from a man in the synagogue. This is an example of Jesus' teaching in deed not just words. The event itself teaches the people that Jesus has authority over unclean spirits. The people are amazed and exclaim that it is a new teaching-with authority. The words of Jesus are indeed powerful and effective.

This is the first sign of Jesus' power as recorded in Mark and the people of Capernaum, where this first miracle in Mark happened, were all amazed. They are even more astonished when Jesus expels the unclean spirit from a demoniac.

It's thought-provoking that what the bystanders were amazed at wasn't Jesus' power, but his teaching. Jesus, however, resisted the temptation to become famous; he wanted only to be faithful to the mission given him by his heavenly Father.

One great lesson to learn from reflecting on Mark's angle of approach to Jesus' public ministry is to see it as a "power struggle" between good and evil. Hence the show of Jesus having power over demons and evil spirits. We live in a world where the struggle between good and evil can be very dramatic indeed. For example, fear of terrorism in one form or another casts a dark shadow over the lives of many today. This, in turn, often leads to further evil in the form of violation of human rights, cutting corners in the administration of justice, discrimination against others because of ethnic origins, religions, etc. In fact, there will be no happy outcome to the struggle against the powers of darkness unless we allow Jesus to confront the demons within us so that we can be healed from our self-righteousness and hypocrisy. The personal struggle within us must never be forgotten either.

God in Jesus has potentially released us from all sorts of spirits-greed, jealousy, despair, etc.-potentially, I say, because it depends on our cooperation so that our life can be of inspiration and hope to others. Do we listen attentively to the authoritative teaching of Jesus, especially as given through his Church, and do we bear witness to it in our words and in our deeds?
