### THE TEMPTATION OF JESUS

Since Lent is about organizing our Christian life and focusing on the will of our heavenly Father which gives us true happiness and meaning in life, Jesus is our guide par excellence. The temptation of Jesus is our blueprint in fighting our own temptations in life. Jesus is our model as Christians, in all of life and especially during the season of Lent.

Temptations are part of our human condition. At certain points in our lives, we have been enticed or lured into committing sin. The Gospel proclamation for the First Sunday of Lent tells us that Christ himself was tempted not once, but three times. In all these instances, Christ came out triumphant.

**Seeming Delight.** The object of temptation is usually something that appears and seems to be delightful. It is for this reason that temptations are able to entice or to lure people into committing sin.

Temptations **seem** to be good and easy to accomplish: Command this stone to become bread, and you will have food for your hungry stomach! Worship me, and you will have all the power and glory of the kingdoms of this world! Throw yourself down from this parapet, and you will prove to everybody that you are the Son of God!

Temptations present themselves to us as something delightful and desirable to do: Cheat, and you don't have to study hard. Steal, and you don't have to toil. Forget about the poor and the needy, and you will have more resources for your own pleasure and satisfaction. Don't tell the truth but lie, and you get out of a difficult situation unscathed. Blame other people, and your own failings will be overlooked. Be unfaithful to your partner, and you will have the fun and thrill of your life. Entertain impure thoughts, and you end up being enter-

The fact that Christ himself is tempted indicates to us that there is no moral fault in being tempted. The problem is the willful consent to temptation. Jesus is able to overcome the temptation by remaining steadfast in his resistance.

Unmask temptation's lie. Jesus also shows us further the way on how to undermine and remove the appeal of temptation, namely, unmask temptation's lie. That is what Jesus does at every turn that Satan tempts him. The Catechism of the Catholic Church stresses the need for discernment that unmasks the lie of temptation "whose object appears to be good, a 'delight to the eyes' and desirable, when in reality its fruit of death" (no. 2847).
