

GOD SO LOVED THE WORLD

The first and foremost knowledge about God's love is that God loved us first and invites us into the life of love, to respond in love. The Gospel of John as we reflect on this 4th Sunday of Lent leads us into some deeper places of understanding the nature of God's love: we will have eternal life with God; we will not be condemned if we believe in Jesus Christ the embodiment of God's love for us. This has not been so easy and simple to understand. Because we do not love the way God loves.

Despite being a teacher of Israel, Nicodemus cannot understand Jesus' explanation of God's love. Nicodemus is thinking in a human way so Jesus tries to slowly walk him through into a spiritual way of understanding God's love. Jesus cites the story of the bronze serpent lifted by Moses during the Israelites' sojourn in the desert (cf Nm 21:4-9) and then leads Nicodemus to the fact that the Son of Man, Jesus himself, is the one who truly brings the fullness of God's love and gives eternal life to those who believe in him through his death and resurrection from the dead.

The death and resurrection of Jesus eloquently tell us how serious God is in his plan to save us despite our disobedience. He made us, and so he does not want us to perish. He desires our good, for our good is his crowning glory! How comforting is the reflection of John the evangelist: "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." These are our refuge against those who would threaten us with the wrath of God or those who declare that we won't be saved unless we join their select group.

However, we have to claim for ourselves the plan of God. We have to correspond to his desire by believing in his beloved Son who alone knows the Father and who reveals him to us. "Whoever does not believe has already been condemned." God loves us so much that he respects our human freedom! Even if through that freedom we turn away from him. He will not save us without us, without our free consent, without "obedience of faith" which St. Paul says is our response to God's redeeming love through Jesus Christ. The love of God has been poured into our hearts.... When one is fully convinced of God's love, he/she cannot but begin to love God back in loving others. In the final analysis, the realization that God has loved us, makes us lovable and is a basic step in self-esteem.

God is free because he loves, we are as free as we love.
