

FEAST OF THE HOLY TRINITY

When we reflect on the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity, we tend to succumb to the temptation to say, "There is no point in explaining it; let us simply accept it as something beyond our human comprehension." Be that as it may, we have a way we can approach the mystery of the Trinity from the role each one plays in salvation history. The self-revelation of God comes from the creation and redemption works of the Triune God. We come to know God from what God has done and is doing for us. God reveals himself as Father, Son and Holy Spirit and the Son has revealed to us that our mission of spreading the Good News springs from the Three Persons. "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you" (Mt 28:19).

The feast of the Blessed Trinity sums up the gifts we have been receiving during the liturgical year. At Christmas we receive the gift from the Father, at Easter the gift from the Son and at Pentecost the gift from the Holy Spirit.

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is a beautiful story of love which comes to us in three moments.

The Trinity, which is recognized in the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, is holy and perfect, and has no adulteration nor anything that is foreign or external. Nor is it compounded of creator and created matter but is endowed with the complete power of creating and energizing; its nature also is consistent with itself and undivided, and its energy and activity is one. For the Father makes all things through the Word in the Holy Spirit, and in that way the unity of the Holy Trinity is preserved. Thus, in the Church one God is preached, who is 'above all things and through all things and in all things.' Yes, certainly, above all things as the Father, the first principle and origin; and truly 'through all things', that is through the Word, and finally 'in all things' in the Holy Spirit.

When St. Paul was writing to the Corinthians about spiritual matters, he traced all things back to one God the Father as to the fountain head in these words; 'Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit, and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord: and there are varieties of working, but it is the same God who inspires them all in every one.'

Generally, God does not want us to be intimidated by His mystery. He wants us to know that the Holy Trinity is a perfect relationship of love. One that is informed by mutual respect and consideration. One where love flows freely and where each person delights in the others. We are so very blessed that God calls us to share in this life of grace. Let us imitate the Trinitarian love in our relationships with others and with creation.
