#### WHEN GOD SEEMS TO BE ASLEEP

When God sleeps what happens? Although, our faith tells us that God does not sleep. But when God made Adam sleep, something wonderful happened, Eve was born out of Adam's side. When Jesus slept on the Cross, the Church was born out of his side. We're brought back into the life of God. In this Gospel of Mark (Mk 4:35-41), which we reflect on this week, Jesus was in the stern of the boat, asleep on the cushion as his disciples battled with a great windstorm, and they woke him up and said to him, "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?" Jesus woke and rebuked the storm and said to the sea, "Peace! Be still!" In this way, he revealed that he is God. God's love for us is more powerful than any challenge we may face in life. Many Jews fear the sea, regarding it as a symbol of chaos and a realm of evil teeming with terrible sea monsters to which helpless human beings fall prey.

Jesus instead falls into a deep sleep while crossing the sea even as huge waves are swamping the boat. Great fear strikes the hearts of his disciples and leads them to think that Jesus does not care for them. As Jesus awakes, he rebukes the wind and calms the angry sea, demonstrating both his power over the forces of nature and his concern for the disciples.

Genesis describes the Creator God separating water from dry land, sustaining the created world, and saving Noah and his family in the midst of the great flood. Exodus presents the power of the Redeemer God who parted the Red Sea to allow Moses and his people to cross from slavery into freedom. The Creator God in Genesis and the Redeemer God in Exodus are one and the same God residing in the person of Jesus. Calming the storm at sea, Jesus assures the disciples of his presence, power, guidance, and teaching as they sail in the boat of Peter, the Church.

Our faith in Jesus is truly tested when violent waves are tossing our boat to the point of sinking and no help seems to come. We become aware of God's profound love for us, even in the face of turbulent times. When our faith is challenged, or we are distraught, we must trust that God is with us always and have complete faith that his love is more powerful than the storms of our lives.

When God seems to be asleep in the face of life's challenges, the best approach is to calm down knowing that when he awakens, wonderful things will happen. Although God never sleeps! We are the ones needing to take a nap and be still at peace. How do you deal with the Unknowns in your life?
