### A WALKING STICK AND SANDALS

St. Mark is the only evangelist who mentions that Christ began to send his disciples forth in pairs. Two were considered better than one, for if one fell, the companion could lift up his fellow. This is the wisdom of God demonstrated right from the beginning of creation. God created everything in pairs and He created Adam and Eve. To succeed in life, we need the help of each other. We are not meant to go it all alone in life. Mark also makes it clear that Jesus' disciples were given specific directions on what to take with them on their journey and how to behave. Although they are given the power to drive out unclean spirits, it is quite clear that they can do this only by the authority of Jesus. In other word, it is Jesus who empowers and commissions them to participate in his ministry. Going by the instruction of Jesus gives not only the apostles but all of us the direct connection, partnership and union with God.

So, in this journey we call life, Jesus is clear on what to carry; a walking stick and a pair of sandals. But the question one may ask out of curiosity is, how will we survive with only these? Can we live on a stick or can sandals be our sandwich?

It will be a problem if we are just after the fish and not the lessons on how to fish. The walking stick may be the guideline and principles we receive from our parents, the words we live by, and the values that walk with us to keep our head and our heart in their proper places. My father reminded me as a young boy to study well. Knowledge would see me through far in life. This walking stick he handed me was true and reliable. My sandals have been the love of my mother, the faithfulness of friends, the love of the people I try to serve faithfully as a priest. They have supported me and protected me like old, comfortable sandals.

What are your walking stick and sandals? Do not count on money and the material things; they will wear thin. Look for a stick that is strong and for sandals that will last. Therefore, let the Father be your stick and his Son be your sandals so that you become what you can possibly be in life. This is all about what Jesus is telling us this week. With them you will go into eternal life!
