

Come Away to a Deserted Place and Rest Awhile

This is summertime when everything in us itches for a get away and to enjoy! This time every year the streets in Huntsville are flooded with tourists. People want to go out and bask in the beauty of the summer. In the Gospel reading this Sunday, we hear Jesus say to the apostles: "Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while." This might surprise some Christians who are always too busy to take a rest. But these Christians forget the importance of leisure for the spiritual life. This idea is well expressed by one spiritual writer, Wilkie Au, in his fascinating book titled By Way of the Heart. Toward a Holistic Christian Spirituality. He writes:

"Leisure is a difficult thing for some people to legitimize in a society like ours that is so oriented towards work and productivity. At the same time, we are paradoxically a society that works at and spends a large amount of time and money for leisure, more than many other societies. In any case, any spirituality that leaves out leisure will lack depth and balance because leisure lies at the heart of prayer, solitude and interpersonal sharing. Without leisure we not only jeopardize our humanity but also endanger the Spirit's work in our lives" (p.39). The truth of the matter is that a deserted place represents a place of communion with God, friends and family. Spending some time in a quiet place helps us find strength and direction in our earthly pilgrimage; it leads us to the source of our life and wisdom.

So, what is your idea of rest? Sitting lazily on a swivel chair with your feet up on the desk, smoking a cigar, and giving out orders? Or is it sleeping and snoring all day?

So, what is rest for you?

For me, rest is doing what I love and enjoy doing. Take for example some mothers who enjoy cooking for their kids and will never be tired of it. Some fathers are re-energized watching their kids after work. It is the love and joy we put into our work that makes work look like rest.

For me, to rest is to pray. Only after we have done our work can we lay ourselves down and then tell the Lord to do his share.

For me, to rest is to let others rest. Watching a sleeping child breathe or listening to a peaceful snore is rest for those who care.

The world will turn without you. So, come and rest a while in the Lord. Work, pray and play. Go out and enjoy the sunshine! Let yourself out and go and have Fr. Dominick
