The Hope of Eternal Life

As we go on in life we become increasingly aware of how fleeting life is, and how precarious is our hold on it. Inevitably we are forced to think about death. But this need not be a negative or morbid thing. It can be a positive thing. Thinking about death can result in a true love of life. When we are familiar with death, we accept each day as a gift.

The thing that best helps us to confront the inescapable reality of death is our Christian faith. Each Sunday we end the (Nicean) Creed with these words: 'We look forward to the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come.'

Belief in an afterlife is one of the most important beliefs as Christians. Without it, life would be a journey to nowhere. With it, life becomes a journey to the promised land of eternal life.

In today's Second Reading Paul says, 'God have given us a sure hope.' When bread does for the body, hope does for the spirit. We spend our lives hoping and longing for one thing or another. But we know that this world can never fulfil our deepest hopes and longings. Only God can do that.

Our hope rests not on anything human, but on the word and power of God. God has not made us for death but for eternal life.

St. John says: 'God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life.'

To have faith doesn't mean that we have all the answers. Faith is trust, not certainty. Faith involves absolute trust in God. We know nothing of the mystery of the beyond. But we do know that life after death is not just a continuation of this life. It utterly transcends the life we know now, as Jesus says in the Gospel.

The splendid prospect of eternal life should enable us to live out joyfully the mystery of our fragile human condition, which sees us suspended between earth and heaven, and between time and eternity.


