CALL TO DISCIPLESHIP

Last Sunday, the church celebrated the Solemnity of Peter and Paul, Apostles. While tradition holds both to have found their fate as martyrs, Christians continue to see in them famous and steadfast models of the faith. This Sunday's readings highlight another group of loyal followers, the anonymous seventy-two disciples who Jesus sent out on mission. Like Peter and Paul, their fate was not contingent on worldly measurements of success or failure, but on faithfulness to the will of God.

The seventy-two the Lord appointed, he sent them ahead of him in pairs to every town and place he intended to visit" (Lk 10:1). Jesus emphasizes the many failures that they will face, promising them hunger, poverty, conflict and rejection. In a previous chapter, Jesus calls the twelve apostles by name and sends them out on mission. In this episode, the seventy-two remain anonymous. By sending out such a large second group, Jesus indicates the way that the burden of evangelization ought to be borne by all.

The most encouraging thing that Jesus says to the seventy – two disciples is that even when people do not accept their message, they should stay strong in faith and remember the greater joy of having their names written in heaven.

When the seventy-two return to Jesus they boast how powers and spirits fall to them or subject to them. By contrast, they recount no stories of rejection but that of success. Gently but firmly correcting their perception of "success," Jesus invites them to remember what is truly important. "Do not rejoice because the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice because your names are written in heaven" (Lk 10:20).

The underlying truth is that if we share in Christ's suffering, we will share his joy. At our baptism, we were marked for Christ with the sign of the cross. This indelible seal sets us apart to share in Christ's mission, but also in his suffering. We have hope that we who have died with Christ will also rise with him to live in the new Jerusalem, comforted in the arms of our loving God. In our endeavor to the mission, we have to ask the Lord to be with us at all times, in both friendly and hostile territory to be part of building his Kingdom.
