Catholic Funeral Rites

Please call the parish office to arrange funeral Masses. We work closely with the funeral homes and will assist you with the liturgical arrangement to honour the departed family member.

Rites of Initiation for Adults (RCIA)

Classes begin in October for Adults seeking baptism or full communion into the Catholic Christian faith Please contact the parish office to register.

Sacrament of Baptism (Infants)

Please contact the parish office for details. A pre-baptism meeting is required.

Catechism Classes (Oct - May)

First Communion and Confirmation classes are held at the parish. Registration takes place in September.

Sacrament of Marriage

Kindly contact the parish office at least six months prior to desired date of marriage. A Marriage Preparation Course is essential as are several meetings with the priest.

Anointing of the Sick

If you have a family member sick or know of someone near death please call the parish and request the sacrament of the sick.

Sick and Homebound

Please contact the parish office if you know someone confined to home or in hospital, so sacramental and pastoral care may be arranged.

The Beatitudes

The beatitudes reflect on how we should live our lives as children of God and to be of help to our fellow human beings.

In effect, the beatitudes reflect God’s action in our lives in such a way that we see ourselves humbly reaching out to others, to share with them the good of God’s love. Humility comes at the center of the entire beatitudes.

When I was younger, I thought humility and humiliation were the same concept. I reasoned the only way to be humble was to allow others to humiliate me. I had to be a doormat on which people wiped their dirty feet. Yes, both words come from the Latin word humus that means “earth,” “dirt,” or “ground.” But that does not mean we think of ourselves as “just dirt,” that is, think less of ourselves, but that we think of ourselves less often. It means to be “grounded” in the Lord Jesus Christ and realize that who we are is what GOD has empowered us to be.

True humility is not being passive and let other people do things to us. Rather, it means being active and serving others because we realize how GOD has graced us.

To me, Mary is a good example of one who is holy and humble. Her prayer, the Magnificat is a great example of humility. Read it over and see how she is able to give thanks to God (Luke 1: 46-55).

The Magnificat

My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord,
my spirit rejoices in God my Savior,
for he has looked with favor on his lowly servant.
From this day all generations will call me blessed:
the Almighty has done great things for me,
and holy is his Name.

He has mercy on those who fear him
in every generation.

He has shown the strength of his arm,
he has scattered the proud in their conceit.

He has cast down the mighty from their thrones,
and has lifted up the lowly.

He has filled the hungry with good things,
and the rich he has sent away empty.

He has come to the help of his servant Israel
for he has remembered his promise of mercy,
the promise he made to our fathers,
to Abraham and his children forever.

Glory to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit,
as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be forever. Amen.


