## THE MYSTERY OF THE HOLY TRINITY

The revelation of the Trinitarian mystery stands out in what God has done for us. Right from creation, God reveals himself as love, goodness, mercy and compassion. The passage from Exodus reveals the unity of God and the Father's heart "of tenderness and compassion, slow to anger, rich in kindness and faithfulness."

In supplication of Moses: "Let my Lord come with us," we can glimpse a first step toward the incarnation and revelation of the Son, "Emanuel," God with us. This mystery of the incarnation is solemnly revealed in the Gospel: "God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son." At the end of the Second Letter to the Corinthians, Paul takes up a Trinitarian formula of the early Christian liturgy: "the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all."

Trinity Sunday, shows us of a God who reveals himself as a God of tenderness and compassion. Speaking with God, Moses is assured, that however unfaithful and headstrong the chosen people have shown themselves to be, God remains the God of faithful love, a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness.

Scriptures reveal a 'God of Love who created the universe and generated a people, became flesh, died and rose for us, and, as the Holy Spirit, transforms everything and brings it to fullness.' This is the God who is Father, Son and Spirit... God does not want so much to reveal to us that he exists, but rather that he is the 'God with us,' that he loves us, is interested in our personal story and cares for each person, from the smallest to the greatest.

In one of his Angelus reflections on the Trinity Sunday, Pope Benedict XVI has this to say: "In the world there is evil, there is selfishness, there is wickedness, and God could come to judge this world, to destroy evil, to punish those who work in darkness. Instead, he shows his love for the world and for men and women, despite their sin, and sends what is most precious to him: his Only-Begotten Son... Responding to the love that comes from the Father, the Son gave his own life for us: on the cross God's merciful love reaches its highest expression. And it is on the cross that the Son of God obtains for us participation in eternal life that is communicated to us with the gift of the Holy Spirit." (Angelus, 2005). This is how we come to know God, the Trinitarian Family from whom every family in heaven and on earth takes its origin. Happy Trinity Sunday!!!
