Rites of Initiation for Adults (RCIA)

Classes begin in October for Adults seeking baptism or full communion into the Catholic Christian faith. Please contact the parish office to register.

Sacrament of Baptism (Infants)

Please contact the parish office for details. A pre-baptism meeting is required.

Catechism Classes (Oct - May)

First Communion and Confirmation classes are held at the parish. Registration takes place in September.

CHRISTMAS IS GOD'S WAY!

Christmas reveals to us God's attitude and disposition toward humanity. God loves us so much and chooses to come to us even in a lovable, touchable and huggable baby. His will is for us! He sends his angel to Mary to announce the good news. And Mary turns her will to God. Then in a dream the same angel Gabriel comes to Joseph, saying: '... don't be afraid to take Mary as your wife... what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit.'

When Joseph wakes up, he does something remarkable: he abandons his way and accepts God's way, without any conditions or complaints. Just simple obedience, trust, and love. He agrees to take Mary into his home and to love her and her son.

Here, Joseph joins Mary in a song that's far more meaningful than any anthem of pride. This is the quiet harmony of those who truly trust God, and it's sung by every disciple who learns that God's way is always the road to peace and fulfilment.

As we continue to grow in conformity and uniformity of our wills to God's Will like Mary and Joseph, we will discover that 'my way' cannot save us. Only God's way can. That's what Christmas invites us to learn: to stop grasping, and to trust. To make space for God to make a difference in our lives.

To say, like Mary and Joseph, 'Not my way, Lord, but yours.' As we want to spend this time with our new borne King, Mary and Joseph and with all the people of good will, those whom God's favor rests; as we revel in the joy of Christmas, this is a good time to ask yourself: Where am I still clinging to my way? Is it holding me back? And where do I need to make room for God's way like Mary and Joseph?

When we truly let go and trust God as St Joseph did, we make space for Jesus' birth not only in Bethlehem, but also in ourselves. Bethlehem, Mary, Joseph and Jesus... they all belong to us because we can identify ourselves in them. May all of that allow us to be at peace with ourselves... and between ourselves... and with God. Christmas is God's gift of love! "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in him should not perish, but have everlasting life (Jn 3:16).
