RELIEF FOOD KIT DISTRIBUTION

From April to May 2020 during the lockdown in India Muheem has done relief food kit distribution to the poor and needy families and also migrant workers. Through which 3100 families and 9200 migrant workers get benefited.

NUTRITIOUS AND SANITATION KIT DISTRIBUTION FOR WOMEN

Under the relief work Muheem has distributed nutritious food kit and sanitation kit (which include sanitary pad, panty, mask and soap) to 112 pregnant women and 180 girls.

We have organised Corona testing camp with the collaboration of government primary health centre. It was one day free testing camp for all. In which more than 50 people has participated.

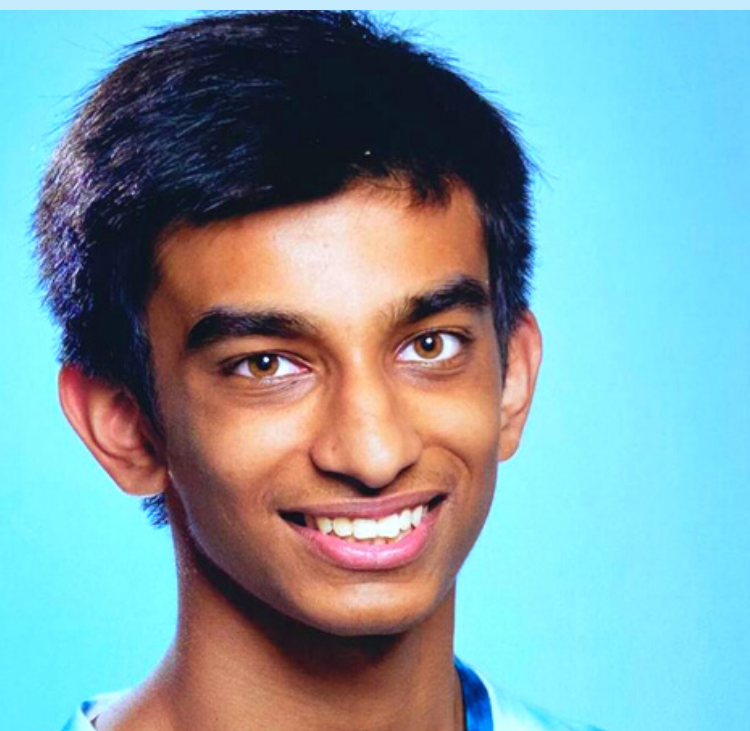


Pathshala
