PRIVACY NOTICE

At Katie Watts ("we," or "us"), we value the privacy of individuals who use our websites and related services (collectively, our "Services"). This Privacy Notice explains how we collect, use, and share the personal information of users of our Services ("users," "you," or "your"). When you use our Services, we may automatically collect certain information about your device and your interactions with our website, including device information, usage information, location information, and log data. We may use cookies, pixels, web beacons, and similar technologies to collect this information.

INFORMATION FROM THIRD PARTIES

We may receive information about you from third-party sources, such as payment processors, event registration platforms, marketing partners, and social media platforms.

DATA RETENTION

We retain personal information only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes described in this Privacy Notice, unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by law.

SECURITY

We use reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to protect your personal information. However, no method of transmission over the internet or electronic storage is completely secure.

CHILDREN'S PRIVACY

Our Services are not directed to children under the age of 13, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children.

INTERNATIONAL USERS

If you access our Services from outside the United States, your information may be transferred to, stored,

and processed in the United States or other jurisdictions.
