#### **Financial Report**

- \$250,000.00 Approximate 2020 funds.
- \$51,000 presently in the bank.
- Setting aside \$30,000 for a new NFASI location. NFASI needs a new location that is more suited to the business.
- Have raised \$33,000 so far this year.

#### Executive Director's Update:

- NFASI brought in 145 animals; have adopted out 215 this year to date. Lowest inventory that we have had since we opened our doors.
