Mustang Drivers Club Rules 2025

v. 1.0

This document is a simple outline of the series and will be revised on an ad hoc basis.

For 2025 the MDC series is an ALL run class combining both MDC Pro and MDC Club Racer.

The class will continue the name MDC Pro.

General Rules

The # of cars may be limited. This is a first come first served selection based solely on drivers who have registered for the event. Registration includes a \$50 entry fee with 100% of the proceeds going to Raceday Payouts. Payouts will now be per event (to be mailed after the event). A minimum 4 car field is required for podium payouts. No refunds will be issued.

Payouts will be as Follows:

1st \$300 // 2nd \$150 // 3rd \$75

Championship

A running total of points will be maintained after every event, and drivers' best of 6 out of 8 events will count toward the Championship. Starting in Round 7, drivers' lowest scoring event will be dropped from the total. Trophies will be awarded to the Top 3, and Championship Bonuses may also be announced throughout the year, should there be a surplus of entry fees or otherwise.

Points will be scored in the following manner:

1 st : 20	2 nd : 18	3 rd : 16	4 th : 14	5 th : 13
6 th : 12	7 th : 11	8 th : 10	9 th : 9	10 th : 8

Competition Forms

Completed competition forms are required before the first session of the event. These are made available online on the Facebook Group and at www.mdcracers.com. They may be completed and sent to info@speedventures.com. Alternatively, there will be paper copies at every event that can be submitted to Speed Ventures registration. Please note: this is an absolute requirement regardless if there are changes or not.

Competition Sessions

Sessions 1, 2, and 3 will count towards the competition. Where the event is held over 2 days, either single day will count. Should a driver drive both days, only the first day will count. Single event awards will be held in the afternoon of each event for both classes.

Track Etiquette

All rules of the track event will apply to MDC drivers. In addition, if any driver is found to be

blocking and not facilitating passing for faster cars, whether competing in MDC or not, they will be disqualified for the day.

Scrutineering

All cars are subject to ad hoc scrutineering. For driver-led inquiries, these must be raised with Speed Ventures staff before the second session of the day. Cars not found in compliance/non-matching Competition Form will forfeit all points for that event for first infraction. Second infraction will deem competitor ineligible for remainder of season and all points will be forfeited and racer will not be eligible for any end of year payout. Appeals can be made to Speed Ventures Staff in writing via email to info@speedventures.com with supporting documentation. Speed Ventures will make any and all final decisions.

The organizer may also revise rules periodically at its discretion.
