"The Clarion Call"

There is a "Clarion Call" going throughout the earth. God is seeking our earnest most attention.

Do You Hear The Sound? Really! Do You Hear The Sound?

There have been many clarion calls in the earth. God used many of His prophets in the Holy Bible to call **His people** back to order, to repentance, and back to **His plan and purpose** for them.

There is a "Clarion Call of God" going throughout the earth! Not Just America or the Middle East, but throughout the world.

<u>A "Call like never before"!</u> Never in the history of mankind has there been such a sound!

Do You Hear The Sound!

- God is a Spirit (*John4:24*) and we must worship him in spirit and truth.
- We must "Know" (not believe) that the natural realm is "in the likeness" of the spiritual realm? (Genesis 1:26-27) God created mankind in His image and likeness.
- The deep things of God are spiritually discerned (1 Corinthians 2:14)

EVERYTHING that were prophesied in the scriptures are being fulfilled daily, even many of the things that are prophesied in Revelation are taking place right before our eyes, and it is a sign of just how easily these things can happen. Millions of acres of land are being burned by fire, the oceans, rivers, lakes, and streams are not just being polluted, but contaminated, even the skies are being destroyed (they call it the ozone).

"The Clarion Call from God" is in the Spirit and spiritually discerned".

Point I

What Is A Clarion Call?

A Clarion Call is:

- A) A divine, loud and clear sound, summons, or utterance cried out with authority prompting one to a special service or duty.
- B) It's serves as an early warning of impending danger.
- C) It's a wake-up call or call to action for believers.
- D) Is meant to be unmistakable leaving no room for doubt or hesitation.
- E) It comes from the core of one's spirit to move out of complacency, procrastination, doubt, fear, and limitations.
- F) It's a spiritual trumpet blast, demanding a response A response is required and accountability is inescapable. (*Joel 2:1*)

There are (3) types in the Bible:

- <u>Prophetic Calling</u> The prophets in the bible received clarion calls to deliver God's messages to the people and often involve warnings, instructions, and calls to repentance
- Evangelistic Calling The Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20)
- <u>Spiritual Awakening</u> Return to God, turn away from the worldly influences and distractions

Point II Why the Clarion Call and Why Now?

When we look around and see all the signs being fulfilled in the earth and specifically the things that are taking place in this country, there is unmistakable evidence that we are living in the last days.

The current climate in this country has many believers staggering and unsteady in the Faith. Everything is in an uproar which creates substantial uncertainty in the heart and mind of the people. Jeremiah 17: 9-10 instructs us that the heart is deceitful above all things and desperately wicked. In Joel

2:13 it instructs us to rip our hearts into pieces in sorrow and contrition and not our garments.

There will not be another Ark built or physical Red Sea opened for us to cross over. There are several gut wrenching warnings in the bible pertaining to the last days. Yes, I said "Gut Wrenching", there will be weeping and gnashing of the teeth.

- A) Judgment day is drawing near.
- No man knows the day or the hour that Jesus will return. Jesus will return as a thief in the night. (1Thessalonians 5:1-4) (2 Peter 3:9-13)

B) There are only 2 ways:

wide way - The way of self-indulgence, perceived ease, and popular opinion which many times leads to self-deception.

narrow way: A way of discipline, sacrifice, & surrender to God God's word instructs us to choose the narrow way. "Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad and easy to travel is the path that leads the way to destruction and eternal loss, and there are many who enter through it."

But small is the gate and narrow and difficult to travel is the path that leads the way to everlasting life, and there be few that find it. (Matthew 7:13 AMP)

The scripture speaks of the day of Judgment, a time when we will go before God to present our spiritual credentials, you can say your spiritual passport.

Either you will be given access or denied access, based on what we do while alive and breathing natural air.

We may go to church every time the doors are open and carry a title in the church assigned by man. God is not into titles, positions, or works in general. God is and will examine our hearts. (*Jeremiah 17:10*)

Matthew 7:21-23 (AMP)

Not everyone who says Lord! Lord!, will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven.

<u>Many</u> will say to me on that day (when I judge them), Lord, Lord, have not we not prophesied in Your name, and driven out demons in Your name? And then I will declare to them publically, I never knew you; DEPART FROM ME, (you are banished from my presence), YOU WHO ACT WICKEDLY disregarding my commands.

Point III

Response To The Clarion Call

- A) Trust in God with all your heart, soul strength, and might. Lean not to your own understanding. Acknowledge Him in all of your ways. (*Proverbs 3:1-23*)
- B) Obey the Word of God. Our answer must always be yes and Amen!
- C) Know that what God says He means. If God is for me who can stand against me.
- D) Do not let the foolishness and wisdom of sinful man cause you to have fear, doubt, or a lack of peace. Stand firm is the calling wherein you are called. This peace that I have the world did not give it to me and they cannot take it away, I must give it away.
- E) Repent of anything and everything that we have done and are doing contrary to the will and word of God.
- F) Stir up the gift that God has placed in you by meditating, studying, praying and praying in the spirit, and fasting. (2 Timothy 4:6-7)
- G) Rejoice in the Lord always!, and again I say Rejoice! (Philippians 4:4-9 AMP)

Let us always abound in the work of the Lord, knowing that our labor out of a pure and sincere heart is not in vain. Nobody on earth has a heaven or hell to put us in. (1 Corinthians 15:58)
