

On March 29, 1974, Vietnam Veterans Day was declared by Presidential order and the support of Congress with Public Law 93-232. Over 58,000 honorable and brave souls who fought and died during the Vietnam War, the ones who are missing and those who died since the consequences of that war, deserve the eternal gratitude and respect of this nation.
