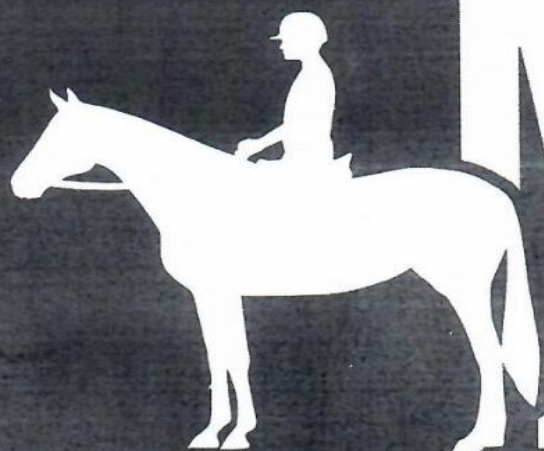

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.**

**Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes**

### **\*\*NEW\*\***

**All horses in the schooling area or warm-up area, the exercise area, or being lunged anywhere on the show grounds, must have its show number attached to the horse or the individual riding or handling. Any horse without its correct number will be asked to leave the area (HJ106 c,d,e).**

### **ENTRIES: ENTER ONLINE AT [WWW.HORSESHOWSONLINE.COM](http://WWW.HORSESHOWSONLINE.COM).**

Every Entry Blank must have the signature of the owner/authorized agent, or trainer & be accompanied by a Stall or Open Check. **NO NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED WITHOUT AN OPEN CHECK OR VALID CREDIT CARD INFORMATION. THERE WILL BE A \$60 LATE FEE FOR ENTRIES SUBMITTED AFTER NOV 28th.** COGGINS MUST BE INDICATED ON ENTRY BLANK OR PRESENTED AT SHOW. There will be an office fee of \$60.00 for every horse on the show grounds that will cover ring schooling, scratches, adds and security. It is the responsibility of the person making the entry to execute properly and complete all necessary information pertaining to each entry made in accordance with the rules of the USEF. There will be a \$100.00 fee for any non-showing horse. Each horse entered will be charged a \$7.00 USHJA Fee. All fees must be paid in 'US Funds'. Night watch fee is \$15/horse. OFFICE ISSUED NUMBERS must be worn in the competition rings.

Declarations, Adds and Scratches must be completed by 4:00pm the day prior.

**REFUNDS:** Prior to closing of entries, entry fees shall be refunded upon presentation of a written statement. After that date any refunds will require a signed veterinary statement stating that the horse is unable to perform or a doctor's statement regarding the rider's illness. In either case there will be \$50.00 processing fee.

Stall fees must be paid with entry blank and will **not** be refunded after the start of the show.

**HORSE REGISTRATIONS:** All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Proof of registration must be presented to the Show Secretary before numbers can be released. To be eligible for National Regional or Zone Horse of the Year Awards, and to enter a USEF Computer Ranking List Class horses must also be registered with the USEF. Exception for USEF Computer Ranking List: Citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation need not have USEF Registration.

**SETTLEMENT OF ACCOUNTS:** All accounts must be closed at the end of each show. Any open accounts will be closed by management and a \$50 processing fee will be added to each entry. Any questions regarding your account must be resolved within 24 hours after the show.

**NON- NEGOTIABLE ACCOUNTS:** \$50.00 or 10% of the amount (whichever is higher) will be charged for all nonnegotiable checks or credit cards. Accounts will be given 5 days to pay with certified funds or be reported to USEF (GR 913).

**CREDIT CARDS:** Will be accepted, however you **MUST** have your credit card present at check out. A convenience fee of four percent of the total invoice will be added to all invoices being paid with a credit card.

**CREDENTIALS:** ALL EXHIBITORS IN THE PONY, JUNIOR HUNTER AND ANY AMATEUR SECTION MUST PRESENT THEIR MEASUREMENT CARD AND/OR AMATEUR CERTIFICATIONS at the show office before numbers can be released. Send Photostats of cards with entry. All ponies or horses not having current meas. cards will be measured at an announced time and place. Anyone not presenting a current USEF/USHJA membership card (or copy) will be charged a Non-Member/Show Pass fee.

**STALLS:** Stalls are permanent 12 x 12 box stalls with doors. Feed, hay and bedding will be available on show grounds. Manure must be disposed of in designated areas. NO MANURE IN TRASH CONTAINERS. No stall doors or panels may be removed. A \$60 per day grounds fee will be charged for all horses not purchasing a stall. Stalls \$225. **NO OUTSIDE SHAVINGS ALLOWED.**

**DRUGS AND MEDICATIONS:** Current USEF rules relating to drugs and medications will be enforced. Each horse entered must pay \$15.00 Equine Drug/Medication Fee plus an \$8.00 USEF fee. Each horse entered will also be required to pay the USHJA Fee of \$10.00.

**Horse and pony Measurements will be on Friday at or around 1pm.**

**SHARPS DISPOSAL** Sharps containers will be provided in all barns for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments. ALL items of this nature MUST be disposed of in the provided containers. NO SHARPS are to be disposed of in any receptacle other than the provided sharps container. Any individual or entry not in compliance will be subject to a \$100 fine per USEF 1210.4.

**SCHOOLING:** Times will be posted & announced.

**CAMPERS:** Camper spaces are available for \$225.00 per show. Please reserve on entry blank!!

**DOGS:** Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Ch. 6 & 7, as well as issuance of warning cards. Loose dogs may be impounded by Animal Control. **\$200 FINE WILL BE IMPOSED.**

**CHANGES:** Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.

**ATTIRE:** It is compulsory for riders in all Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes, both open and restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when mounted anywhere on the show grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials)/SEI(Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is proper in place. See GR801.2. Riders must be properly attired. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible. See USEF GR 801.

**JUMPER:** Ties in Jumper classes jump off for first place only. Ties for all other places will be determined by the fastest time in the first round among those with equal number of faults. Ties for Champion & Reserve remain tied.

**HUNTER:** Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as brush, wall, in & out, oxer, post/rails, gates, aiken and panels. In some cases the area of the Courtesy Circle may be restricted by mandatory line. This line will be indicated on the course diagram and physically in the ring. Classes judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Sections will be combined or cancelled in accordance with USEF rules. **Champion & Reserve Championships will be awarded in all sections excluding Warm Up Classes**

**JUMP ORDER:** A rotating jumping order will be established for all classes over fences. Riders or trainers with conflicts due to having classes in both rings must see the Paddock Masters so that necessary adjustments can be made. **NO RING WILL BE HELD MORE THAN 3 MINUTES DUE TO CONFLICTS**



**FOOTING:** All competition and warm up areas have sand footing. Ring 1 = 120'X255' Indoor & Ring II = 112'X250' covered.

**OPERATION OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s) legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule

**RESPONSIBILITY:** Submission of entry to this show constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold San Antonio Rose Palace & horse show officials harmless against any claims, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fee for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or it's use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of any conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against San Antonio Rose Palace or these Horse Show Managements by reason of such claim exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action or proceeding by council acceptable to owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and the San Antonio Rose Palace or these horse shows are not responsible for accidents, fire or theft.

**RIBBONS, TROPHIES AND CHAMPIONSHIP:** All Hunter classes receive a Trophy and 8 ribbons and all Jumper Classes receive a Trophy and 6 ribbons unless otherwise noted. Each Section will receive a Champion and Reserve award based on points earned (GR808.6). Hunter Champ & Res (HU147) Jumper Cham & Res (JP110)

**PRIZES:** Prize money is indicated for each class. All prize money will be mailed to exhibitors within 2 weeks after the show. **Prize money will be withheld if Social Security number is not on file.** Prize will be payable to the owner unless written authorization stating otherwise is on file with the show secretary.

#### **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS**

1. Horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.
2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration
3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner or agent with care, custody and control of the horse; name serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.
4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested

#### **THJA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT**

THJA MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT COMPETITIONS RECOGNIZED BY THJA. A PERSON/HORSE MAY REGISTER WITH THE THJA AT A RECOGNIZED SHOW AS LONG AS THE APPLICATION(S) AND PAYMENT ACCOMPANIES THE OFFICIAL HORSE SHOW RESULTS. REGISTRATIONS MAY ALSO BE COMPLETED ONLINE WITH A CREDIT CARD AT THE THJA WEBSITE BEFORE THE END OF THE SHOW. ALL RIDERS AND TRAINERS, IN ADDITION TO OWNERS OF THJA REGISTERED HORSES MUST BE MEMBERS OF THE THJA FOR POINTS TO COUNT.

The Christmas Show is operated in accordance with the current THJA Rules and are rated "A" in 3'3" Perf Hunter, 3',3'6" and 3'9" Green Hunter, Junior, Pony, Green Pony, Child Pony, Child & Adult Hunter, Mod Ch/Adult.

"A" in Child & Adult Jumper and Jr/AO Jumper. Points for placings in Pony, Child, Adult and Jr. Equitation, Opportunity, cross rails and walk trot sections will be credited in accordance with THJA Rules.
