#### **BACKGROUND**

Several Kannata Valley residents met on June 5, 2011, to formally establish a community volunteer group called the Kannata Valley Volunteers (KVV). The mandate of this group is to promote community involvement and volunteerism among residents. This involves organizing a variety of events designed to include as many people as are interested in joining in.

Some of our events:

### **Canada Day Annual Barbeque**

- Hamburgers, hotdogs, drinks and a celebratory desert. (Minimal cost)
- Games and activities for the children.
- A local band for entertainment.
- Parade down Lakeshore Drive where families can either participate in, or watch from their residences.
- Scavenger hunt where families can participate in and win prizes.
- Residents are encouraged to 'dress up" their lawns with Canada Day themes.

### **Bake Sale**

This is our annual fund raiser which is normally held at the Sask Beach Flea Market. Residents are asked to provide baking for the sale. Volunteers work the tables.

# **Community Garage Sales**

Co-ordinate a community garage sale giving residents the opportunity to hold their own garage sale on a day specified.

### **Annual Meeting**

## Past activities include:

- Roadside Book Sale As a result a library was established at the village office, stocked with soft cover novels and children's books. The library is available during office hours. This is not a drop-off depot but is operated as 'take one-leave-one' basis for the reading enjoyment of residents.
- Roadside plant swap.
- Queen's Diamond Jubilee Celebration.
- Tailgate Party was held in the village to celebrate the 2013 Grey Cup. Rider Jersey signs were purchased by residents to display in front of their properties.

During 2020/2021, COVID restrictions on gatherings prevented outdoor events. As an alternative volunteers prepared and dropped off goody bags at the doorsteps for the children.
