CONVERSATIONS BEGIN ABOUT REOPENING THE CHURCH

We are all looking forward to the time when we can again worship God and celebrate our life as a community of faith in our church building, not just on a computer. That time is finally on the horizon. Our resident Bishop, *Thomas J. Bickerton*, has announced that **churches in the New York Annual Conference may open on June 15 provided they meet protocol requirements established by the Conference**. The requirements are extensive and will entail careful thought and hard work on our part. We must ensure (and certify to our District Superintendent) that our building is properly prepared and that our worship services are conducted in such a way as to protect the health of worshipers.

The Church Council has created a **COVID-19 Recovery Team** to guide us through the reopening process. The members are *Mark Davis* (Lay Leader), chair; *Bud Behlman* (Trustee); *Catherine Mason* (Children and Youth Ministry); *Chris Shay* (Worship); and myself. This group is charged to help us meet all the requirements for reopening, which in turn will help us determine a target date for our first Sunday to return to the sanctuary for worship. Please offer the Recovery Team your prayerful support and cooperation in the weeks and months ahead. Please let us know if you would like participate in either initial or recurring efforts to clean and/or modify the church to minimize risks of virus transmission.
