The results from the "Our Way Forward Together Survey" have been tabulated and reviewed. The Ad Hoc Committee was impressed with the number of persons who responded and the careful thought everyone put into taking the survey.

The survey findings will be presented to the congregation on Tuesday, January 14, at 7:00 PM in Fellowship Hall. There will be time for questions and discussion. Child care will be provided. Our hope is that many of you will be able to attend.

For those unable to be present on the 14th, an identical presentation will be made on Sunday, January 19, after morning worship.

A summary of the survey findings will be attached in a future edition of *The Messenger* for those unable to attend either of the two meetings.

PLEASE NOTE: Last week, the national media announced that 16 UMC leaders have proposed a denominational split. The group represents the full spectrum of Methodist views on the participation of LGBGTQ persons in the life of the church. Their proposal will be voted on at the next General Conference this May. More information about this development will be provided at our January 14 and 19 meetings.
