

# WUMC Response to COVID-19 (also known as Coronavirus) from Mark Davis, Lay Leader

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic and latest CDC and CT guidance, WUMC has taken several steps to do its part in slowing the spread of the virus and protecting the ones we love. As part of this effort, all 'non-essential' meetings and events will either be held remotely or rescheduled/cancelled until further notice. Committee chair persons or meeting organizers will communicate decisions regarding their respective meetings/events.

WORSHIP SERVICES will be held remotely as long as deemed necessary at the usual starting time of 10:30 AM on Sundays. Special Holy Week services will also be offered, and more specific information about them will follow in the days to come.

- **In-church attendance** is restricted to people who are needed to conduct abbreviated services to be live-streamed online via Facebook and Instagram.
- To watch live or archived recordings of worship services on Facebook, go to www.woodburyumc.net and click on the Facebook icon. No personal Facebook account is required. On Instagram go to woodburyumcct. For some reason, audio may be better when streaming to a cell phone than a PC. Instagram audio quality is better in general. Please contact Theron Kissinger via e-mail at theronk@hotmail.com if you have any issues with either method.
- Audio only also will be provided via teleconference call-in for those who do not have computers or smart phone (203-633-3808 -- no PIN required) or for those having trouble hearing on Facebook or Instagram. For those using the call-in #, please ensure your phones are placed on mute during the service.
- To enhance the livestreaming experience, a worship bulletin will be sent via e-mail before each service, so remote
  participants can better follow along. Please feel free to provide suggestions for enhancing these remote services.

A remote FELLOWSHIP HOUR is also being offered by phone 3 times per week on Sunday at 11:45 AM and Monday/Wednesday at 7:30 PM (call in #: 203-633-3808, no PIN required). This will offer WUMC members an opportunity to stay in touch, pray together, express joys/concerns, ask questions, and seek assistance.

Pastor John and Care Corps members will also be reaching out to all church members to stay in touch and ensure that everyone is receiving the support they need. Please stay in touch with fellow members, bring forward any concerns or need for support, and pray for those affected, including health care workers that put themselves at risk. Please do not hesitate to call Pastor John (845-707-5152), Mark Davis (860-882-4427) or the WUMC office (203-263-4775) to seek assistance.

#### MESSAGE FROM WUMC FINANCE COMMITTEE

Some people have asked about **how to submit pledged or non-pledged contributions** during this time of remote services. This is important since cash flow for WUMC has been a challenge and will become more so if church members defer their giving until they can resume attending services in person.

We want to make sure everyone is aware that **automated electronic transfer of donations** can be easily arranged by logging onto the Church's secure website <a href="https://woodburyumc.net/online-giving">https://woodburyumc.net/online-giving</a> and completing a registration form. The Finance Committee will be sending out a one-page letter via e-mail to provide information in the form of Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs), which may be helpful to you as you consider automated online giving. If you are finding that you are in financial difficulties due to the pandemic, please do not let your pledge commitment weigh on you as an additional stress. But please let Toby McGrath or Joann King (Stewardship Committee) know of your situation and intentions regarding your contributions, the Finance Committee can adapt as best we can. If you are able to meet or exceed your pledge commitments, we would much appreciate your efforts to stay current, allowing us to continue to work together to answer God's call, despite being unable to be together physically.

If you have not pledged this year, but still plan to provide financial support to WUMC, please consider pledging now. As Pastor John highlighted in his "Life of the Church" message in mid-February, the number of pledgers and total pledged funds are down this year. While non-pledged support is equally valuable, pledged support allows the church to have better visibility to financial status and better ability to plan and make tough decisions.
