Our sanctuary seating capacity is now 70. To ensure a place for all worshipers to be accommodated safely, the COVID Recovery Team requests that our members and friends continue the practice of pre-registering for services. You may do this on the WUMC website or by calling the church office. Thank you for your cooperation!

Changes to WUMC COVID Safety Protocols Issued June 20, 2021

We are pleased to announce that WUMC's COVID Reopening Team recommended and Church Council approved changes to our COVID Safety Protocols, as summarized below. These changes, which will be introduced over the next several weeks, represent our next step toward normalcy. These changes are made possible by Connecticut's sustained positivity rate of well below 1%, continued drop in hospitalizations, and a vaccination participation of almost 60% fully vaccinated and almost 10% partially vaccinated. We also will ensure that each week our Pastor and worship team are fully vaccinated. However, due to the unknown vaccination status of our congregation and the fact that our children and youth under the age of 12 are not vaccinated, we ask that all members of our congregation continue to wear a mask and maintain social distancing.

- Return of Pastor greeting line (socially distanced)
- Transition to every other pew seating
- Congregation is allowed to sing while masked
- Plexiglass shields removed for vaccinated worship team members
- Allow praise band and ensemble of 3-4 singers, who are all fully vaccinated
- Return hymnals and Bibles to pews
- Return of bell choir
- Return of passing of the offering plate
- Return of candle lighting by an acolyte
- Return of more personal communion

WUMC Survey Regarding Safe Worship Protocols

The WUMC Church Council values your opinions and wants to consider everyone's input regarding the best way to continue our return to a more normal church experience.

Shortly, you will have an opportunity to complete a survey that can be completed and submitted using any one of three methods (1) online via Google Forms (2) written and submitted via U.S. mail or e-mail (3) written and dropped in offering plate on Sunday.

The vaccination and health status of our congregation will influence future decisions regarding wearing face masks and social distancing. Church Council and the CRT respect your privacy, including health and vaccination status; so, your survey responses will be kept anonymous to everyone except the persons collecting e-mail survey responses.

We are asking that each member of our church family complete the survey. A parent should answer on behalf of children under the age of 12. One member of a family can respond for the entire family by providing appropriate additional info within questions as indicated.

We hope you will take the time to thoughtfully respond to the survey questions.

MISSION & OUTREACH UPDATE Donation and Volunteer opportunities for the Woodbury Food Bank

Donations for the Woodbury Food Bank can be brought to the church at any time and left in Food Bank box in the office entryway. However, in August we will be reinstituting our special Food Bank collections on the 3rd Sunday of the month.

On Sunday, August 15th, please bring a food item from the priority list below and leave it in the donation box.

Special priority needs:

- Chicken, beef & vegetable broths
- Priority soups: Chicken combo, beef combo, minestrone, vegetable, lentil, pea, Italian wedding & chowder
- Priority canned meats/fish: Hash, chili, pork & beans, beef stew, salmon, chicken
- Juice bottles, especially apple, grape, orange, cranberry & cranberry mixes
- Assorted fruit cups, canned pears & canned pineapples
- Canned tomatoes, especially tomato sauce and whole, diced & stewed tomatoes
- · Canned cannellini beans, canned spinach, canned olives & canned mushrooms
- Pancake/waffle mixes



Can we beat that in 2021?

- · Cereals & oatmeal
- Quick bread mixes & muffin mixes
- Brownie mixes
- Canned & boxed potatoes (plain & flavored)
- Condiments including syrup, ketchup, mustard, salad dressing & mayo
- Regular, half-caf & decaf ground coffee, and regular & decaf teas
- Cooking oils including canola, vegetable, corn & olive
- Liquid dish detergent & laundry detergent (both scented and free & clear)
- Paper products including paper towels, toilet paper & napkins


