February 17: Ash Wednesday

Ash Wednesday ushers in the holy season of Lent. This year, WUMC will faithfully observe Ash Wednesday, but do so in a slightly different ways.

- Following the pattern of our recent Prayer Vigils, an outdoor service will be offered in the fenced-in courtyard area on Main Street from 7:00 7:10 PM, followed by a full service in the sanctuary from 7:15 8:00 PM.
- Instead of the usual imposition of ashes, worshipers in both settings will be offered a small piece of burlap marked with a cross
 as a sign of penitence and mortality. Church members desiring a burlap piece to be delivered to their
