Plan for Reopening for In-Person Outdoor Worship Service

The WUMC ad hoc COVID-19 Recovery Team (CRT) has been working with several members of the Board of Trustees (BOT) to prepare a plan for reopening the 'doors' of our church for worship services, while ensuring the safety and welfare of our church family and community. We hope to have approval to reopen for in-person outdoor services on the Woodbury North Green in mid-July. I hope you are as excited as I am to see each other in person, even if it is with a mask and without a hug!

A four-phased plan has been developed that ultimately leads to conducting the life of the church in a new way. Based on responses to the recent survey, our phased plan has changed to focus on holding outdoor services until the fall. Plan A (outdoor services) and Plan B (indoor services) have been detailed out and combined into a request for approval by the Connecticut District Superintendent (CDS) of the New York Annual Conference (NYAC).

This week, the Church Council voted to approve the two plans, which will be finalized and submitted to the CDS by the end of this week. We expect to receive approval of the Phase A (outdoor service) plan within two weeks, allowing our first service to be held as early as mid-July. The Phase B plan may require an iteration before final approval. We anticipate being able to hold indoor services in the case of bad weather as early as mid-August. The proposed reopening plan will be posted on our website next week.

I would like to thank the 40+ respondents to our survey, which provided extremely valuable insights, allowing the CRT to make some difficult decisions in finalizing our plans. I would like to thank the following CRT and BOT members who have worked diligently to prepare a plan for allowing us to reopen and see each other soon: *Bud Behlman, Rae Ann Hockenberry, Catherine Mason, Chris Shay, Pastor John Thomason* (CRT); and *Jeff Hunt and Alan Rego* (BOT). It has been a pleasure leading this team to define a thoughtful approach for holding meaningful services in compliance with NYAC guidelines and restrictions. Thanks also to Church Council Chair *Rick Richardson* for his leadership contributions and legal counsel.

Recognition and Thanks for Our Ongoing Ministry

A number of people have worked hard to continue the ministries of our church during these difficult times, including broadcast of a quality worship service each week. Even more have worked hard to figure out how to safely reopen for in-person worship services. I would like to thank *Pastor John*, who has adapted to an entirely new way of preparing for a worship service and providing pastoral care, while participating in numerous conference calls with the Naugatuck Valley Cooperative Parish and NYAC to adapt to the evolving COVID crisis on a week to week basis.

I would also like to thank *Chris Shay* for his innovation and flexibility in bringing us inspirational musical arrangements each week; *Theron Kissinger* for his tireless efforts in conducting multiple recording sessions and editing them into a seamless service; all the liturgists, singers, bell ringers, and others that have prepared special messages for our children each week; *Catherine Mason* for

coordinating weekly children's moments and providing resource materials for at-home Sunday school; *Bill Wilhelms* for his efforts in providing inspirational graphics for inclusion in the worship video.

I would also like to thank *our children* for creating inspirational signs for our church yard, thanking our 'COVID Warriors' and expressing our support for the recent groundswell of protestors seeking social justice for all; *Catherine Mason* and *Leeah Beavers* for coordinating this youth ministry project; *the Hibbard family* for their behind the scenes support of the Woodbury Food Bank; *Paul Hibbard* and *Mike Boisseau* for their nightly ringing of the church bells; *Diane Hibbard*, *Rae Ann Hockenberry*, *Catherine Mason*, *Barb Rego*, *Caroline Shay*, *Christine Shupenis*, and I am sure others for behind the scene calls on behalf of the church to our extended church family to ensure we stay connected and offer support; *Christine* and *Anna Shupenis* for making cloth masks for those in need when such things were in short supply; and *Catherine Mason* for making sure our high school graduates were properly recognized.


Pastor's Sermon: *Freedom From and Freedom For*
