July 12th – Our First In-Person Worship Service from Mark Davis, Lay Leader

We hope to see you soon! We just received approval for the first two phases of our reopening plan. We will begin holding inperson outdoor services on July 12th at 9:30 am. They will be held on the Woodbury North Green. We are excited to say that this venue provides sufficient social distancing that we can have a small praise band! I hope you are as excited as I am to see each other in person, even if it is with a mask and without a hug!

The primary restrictions are ones to which we have grown accustomed, while venturing out in public places and visiting health care providers. Attendees must wear a face covering/mask at all times and maintain proper social distancing. In our case, we are asking everyone to maintain 10 feet of social distancing between families and for children to remain with a parent at all times. For those that are able, we ask that attendees bring their own mask, seating, and printed copy of the bulletin. We will have limited sanitized chairs for those with limited mobility.

The area for worshipers will be roped off to allow two check-in points with greeters who will record attendance and apply obligatory admission criteria (no-touch temperature and quick confirmation that no one is sick or been in close contact with a person diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days). We will also be providing an online registration system to make the greeters' job easier.

We ask our elderly and vulnerable church family members to carefully consider whether to attend services in person at this time. While we feel our plans for in-person services provide robust protocols to protect our church family, we encourage our most vulnerable members to stay safe at home. We would love to see you, but we want you to stay safe, because we love you! **Online and audio-only worship service broadcasts will continue to be provided, but later on Sunday.**
