Outdoor Worship Continues This Sunday 9:30 AM, Woodbury North Green

Last Sunday, 31 persons gathered on Woodbury's North Green for our first in-person worship service in four months. Thanks again to our COVID-19 Recovery Team, the Board of Trustees, and Music Director *Chris Shay* and his technical assistants for helping us to prepare for this landmark event. And thanks to the worshipers who cooperated beautifully with the precautions we were asked to take and for warmly participating in the service itself.



We will continue to worship on the Green through August. If and when you choose to join us, please familiarize yourself with the protocols to be followed for attending in-person worship. Detailed instructions and procedures have been outlined in a letter from Lay Leader *Mark Davis* and may also be found on the WUMC website.

The outdoor service will be canceled if there is inclement weather, and the service will take place in the sanctuary with only the worship leaders present. Every effort will be made to inform the congregation of a cancellation in a timely way.

For those who choose not to join us in-person at this time, we fully understand and support your personal caution and care for others. Services (outside or inside) will continue to be recorded and made available on our website at 1 PM on Sunday afternoon.




Dear WUMC family,
