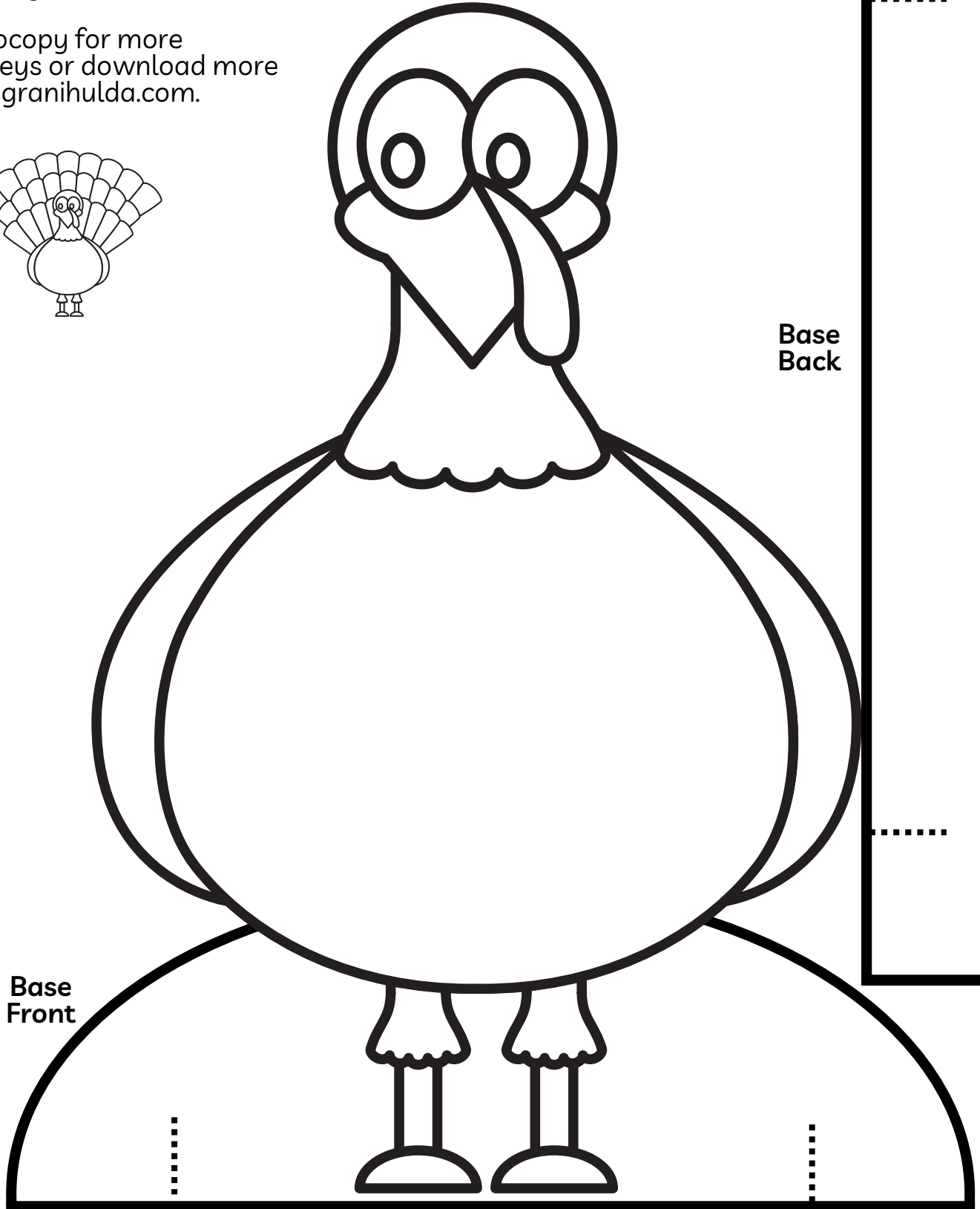
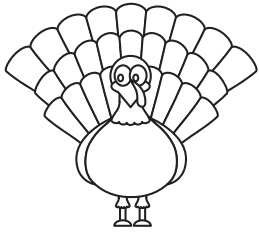


TURKEY CRAFT

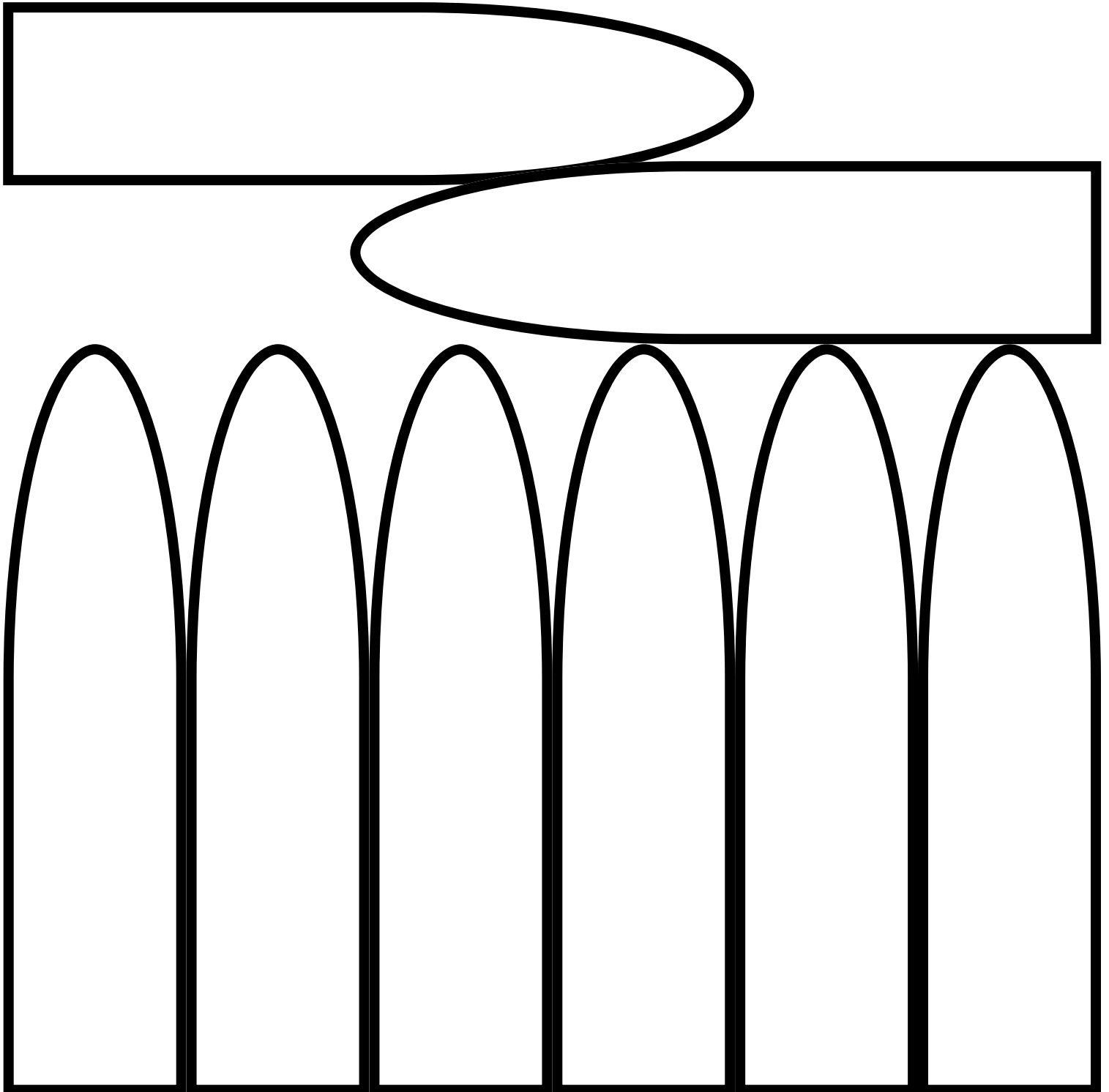
1. Color the turkey.

3. Cut out the turkey with the base front. Also cut out the base back.
4. Color the feathers on the following page.
5. Cut out the feathers.
6. Glue the feathers to the back of the turkey in rows.

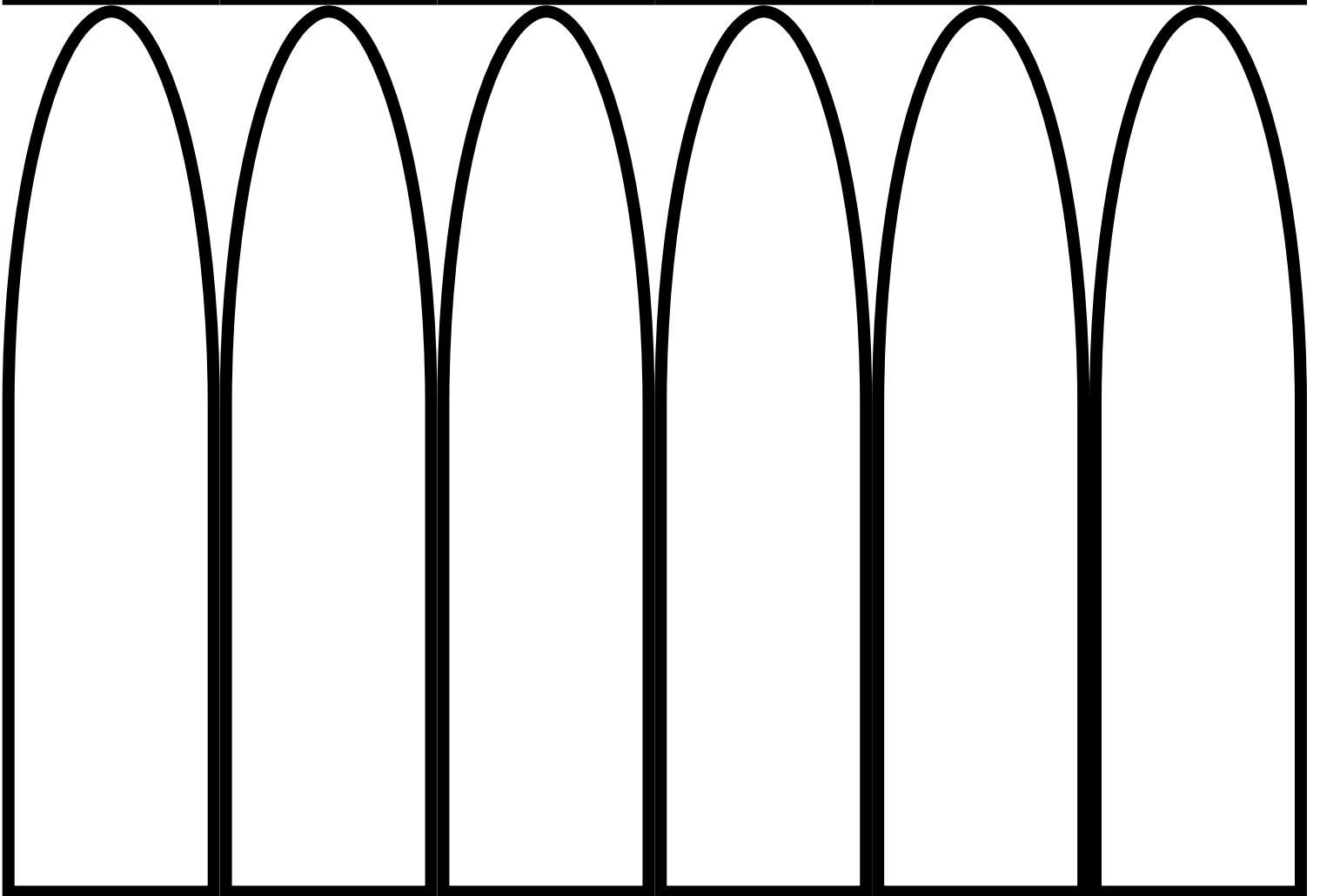
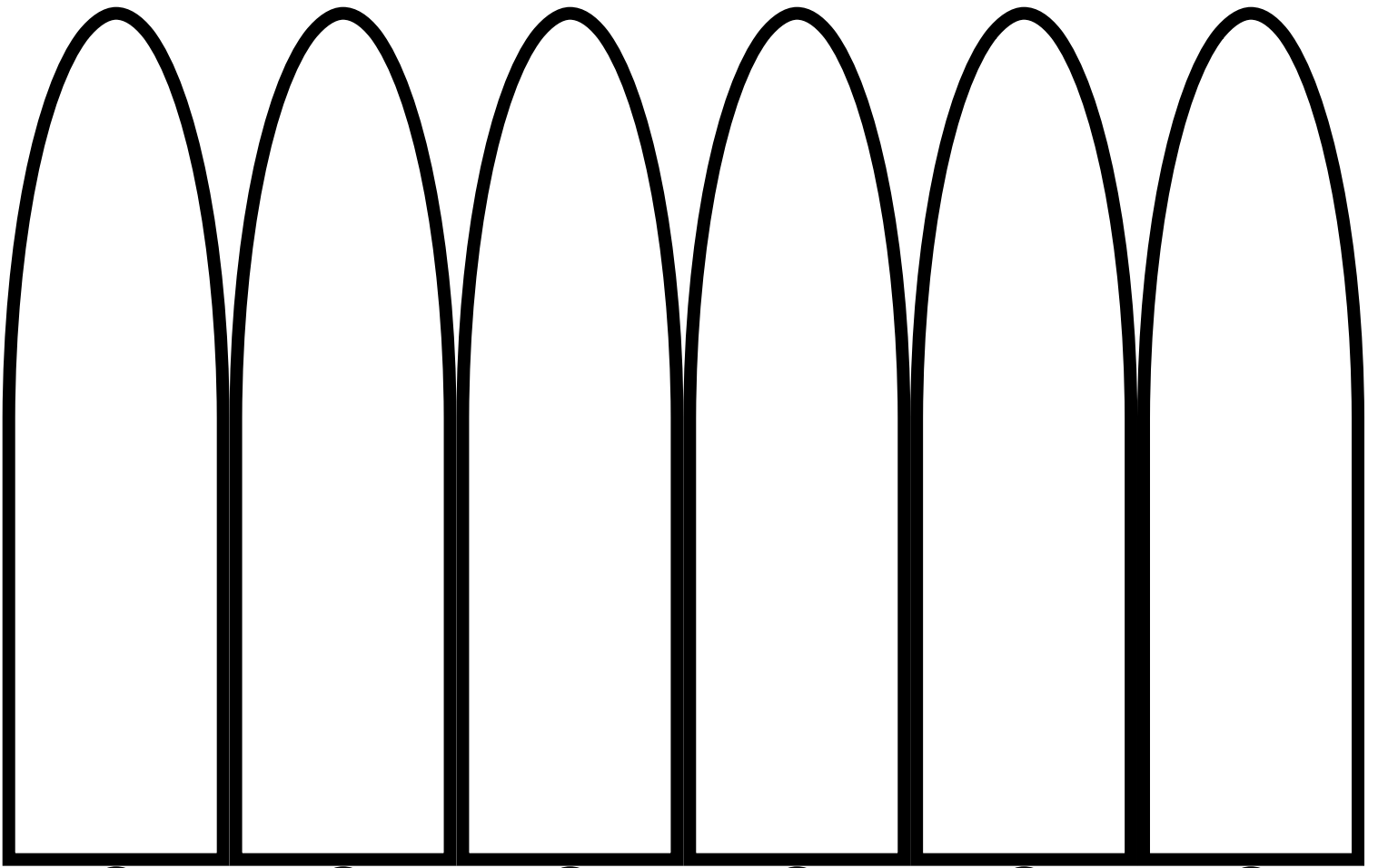
Cut slits on the dotted lines in the base front and back.

Assemble together so your turkey will stand..

You can also glue fall leaves or real feathers to the back of the turkey body.

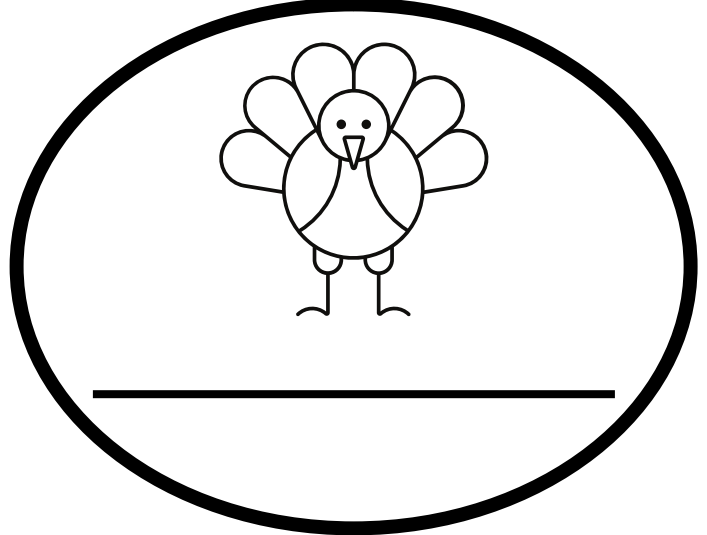
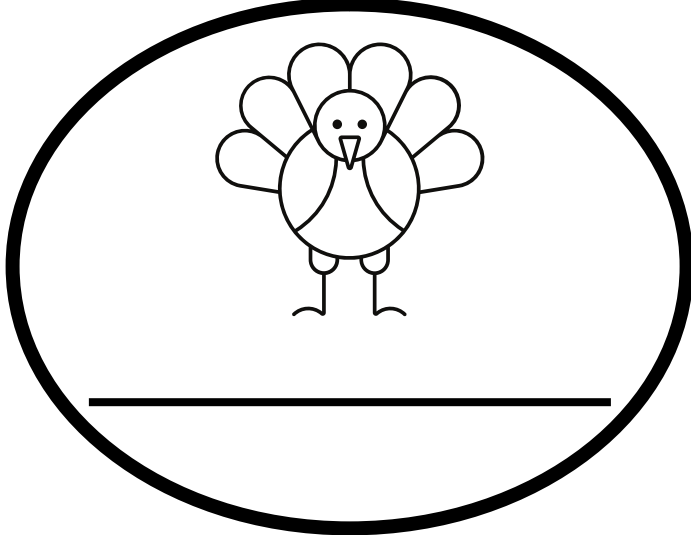
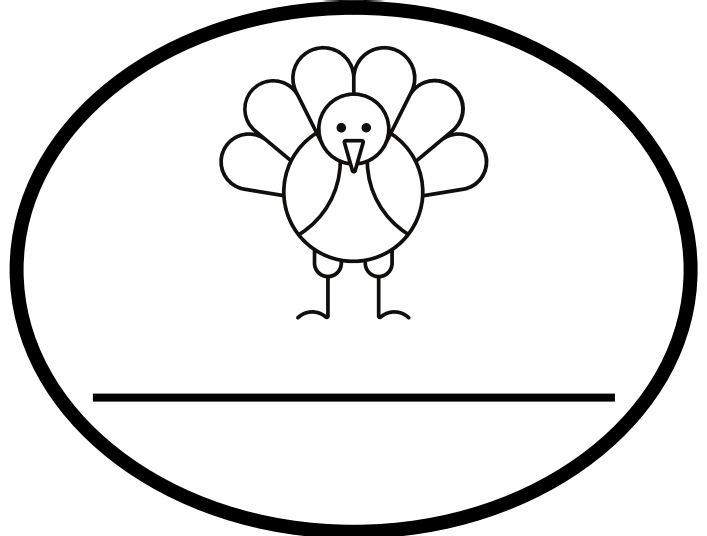
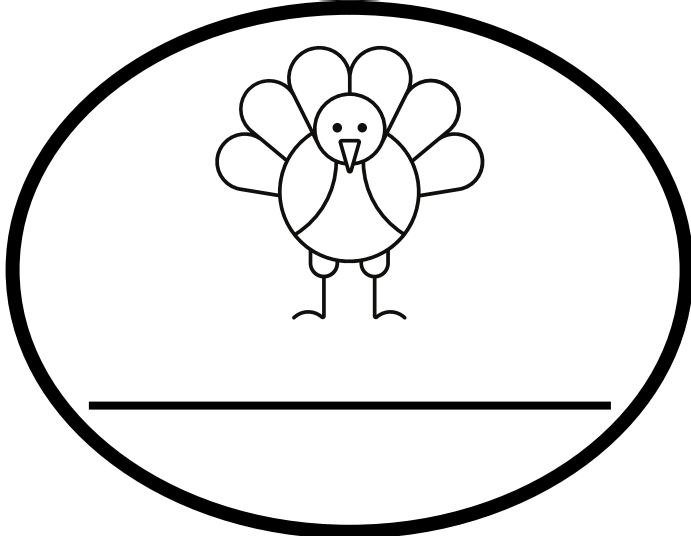
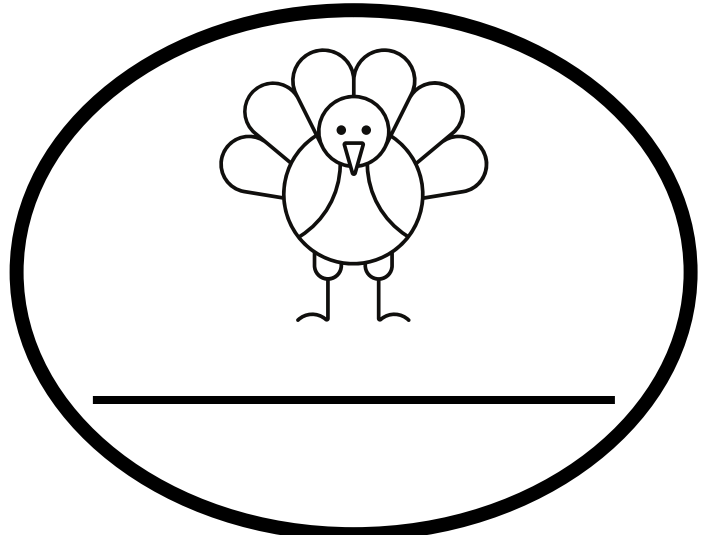
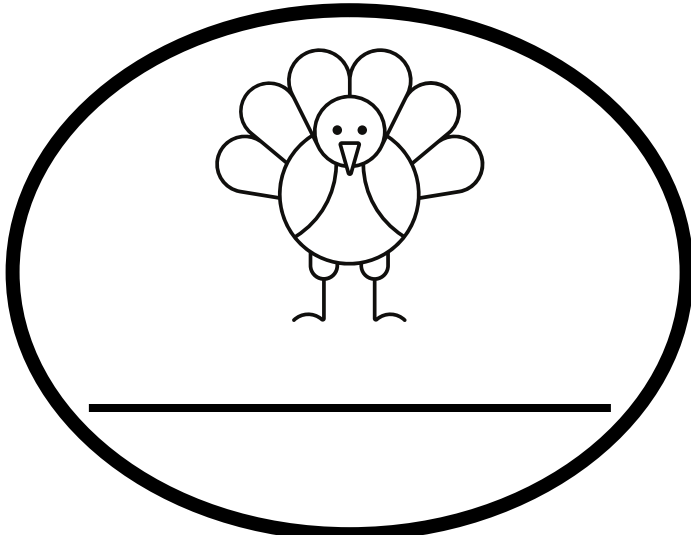
